1. The highest bidder shall be the purchaser.
2. The purchaser shall deposit on the day of sale a sum equal to one month's rent as security.
3. The lease money shall be paid monthly in advance.
4. The lessee shall give up possession within twenty-four hours' notice without compensation.

5. No permanent building shall be erected at all, and no temporary building without sanction of the Government Agent, Western Province, previously obtained.

6. If the land has to be vacated before expiry of the term for which rent has been paid, a refund proportionate to the unexpired term will be allowed. The lessee shall have the option of removing the temporary buildings, if any, erected by him.

7. The lessee shall keep the land clean and in good order, and have it fenced at his expense. The trenches shall also be maintained. No permanent cultivation shall be made on the land.
