ABSTRACTS OF SEASON REPORTS.

SEASON REPORTS FOR THE MONTH OF DECEMBER, 1908.

WESTERN PROVINCE.

COLOMBO DISTRICT.

Paddy: maha paddy plants are here and there already in ear.

Dry grain: no cultivation worth reporting.

Other products: the supply of vegetables was good and prices were reasonable, but fruit was scarce and dear. The flowering and prospects of coconuts were not satisfactory during the month. The crop for the month is reported at 9,201,015 coconuts approximately.

Prices of staple products: rice, Rs. 4.50 to Rs. 6.50 a bushel; coconuts, Rs. 40 to Rs. 47 a 1,000.

Rainfall: there were a few showers of rain during the month.

Remarks on harvest prospects generally: a fairly good maha crop may be generally expected.

Observations on the health of the inhabitants: there were cases of malarial fever, typhoid fever, measles, dysentery, and several cases of chickenpox and of smallpox in some villages, otherwise the health of the inhabitants was generally good.

KALUTARA DISTRICT.

Paddy: the maha cultivation is thriving well. Caterpillars appeared in the fields in some parts of the district and did some damage to the paddy plants. The pest has now disappeared.

Dry grain: nothing worth reporting.

Other products: (a) the supply of vegetables and fruits was scanty, but there was a large supply of cassava bulbs in the totamunes; (b) there was an apparent improvement in the flowering of coconuts, and the estimated crop for the month is 1,496,800 nuts.

Prices of staple products: rice, Rs. 5 to Rs. 7 per bushel; coconuts, Rs. 35 to Rs. 80 per 1,000 nuts. Remarks on harvest prospects generally: nothing can at present be said of the coming harvest. Rainfall: at Kalutara, mean 41 in; total, 12.73 in.

Health of people: there have been a few cases of contagious fever, dysentery, and chickenpox mostly

Health of cattle: rinderpest still prevails in Rayigam korale, and steps are being taken to stamp out the disease.

CENTRAL PROVINCE.

KANDY DISTRICT.

Paddy, maha: paddy in crop: Yala: nil.

Dry grain, maha: hill paddy in crop. Yala: nil.

Rainfall: fair.

Prospect of ecconut crop: flowering good. Estimated produce for the month of December, 1908: Yatinuwara, 14,000, Tumpane 17,000, Harispattu 2,300, Uda Dumbara 1,000. Pata Hewaheta 71,600. In other divisions crop not ascertainable.

Weather: maximum temperature, 85 7°; minimum tempetature, 66°. Direction of wind: from the

Remarks on harvest prospects generally: owing to scarcity of rain the paddy has withered in some places, and is in general stunted in growth; prospects poor, except in the Karaichchi and Punaryn divisions. where moderate crop is probable.

Health of people: generally good.

Health of cattle: good. Supply of grass and drinking water plentiful.

MANNAR DISTRICT.

Weather: rainfall registered at Mannar 6.96 in. Wind was variable. There was a strong gale on the 30th and 31st.

Agriculture: paddy in plant; dry grains in ear; tobacco being planted; coconuts flowering satisfactorily

Health of people: normal. Health of cattle: normal.

Price of food stuffs: rice, Rs. 6.50 per bushel; paddy, Rs. 2.25 per bushel; coconut, Rs. 4.50 per 100

MULLAITTIVU DISTRICT.

Weather: there was slight rain during the middle part of the month, and heavy showers on the 29th, 30th, and 31st. On the night of the 30th a cyclonic storm, attended with heavy showers of rain, broke out from the north-east, and lasted till 9 A.M. on the 31st. Some coconut, jak, mango, and other fruit trees in private compounds were thrown down.

Trees fell across the roads interrupting the coach service and telegraphic communication for a few days.

Trains ceased running north of Vavuniya.

There was no loss to life.

Agriculture: there is enough water at the manavari cultivation, in the Maritime pattus, and a little rain at the commencement of February is all what is wanted to ensure a successful kalapokam crop. In the interior almost all the tanks are full, and several have spilled. There is every prospect of a good harvest under them throughout the district. A few tanks have breached on account of the heavy rain.

State of crops: cultivation has been carried on under almost every village, and the paddy plants are coming up well. Tobacco is being planted in some of the villages in the Maritime pattus and Vavuniya North. The number of coconuts plucked is estimated at 75,000.

Health of people: fair. A few cases of malarial fever, pneumonia, and sore-eyes occurred here and there villages. Quinine is being distributed to the villagers by the headmen. Health of cattle: good. They have enough forage, and no disease.

Health of people: 334 cases of ordinary fever have been reported.

Health of cattle: good.

Pitigal Korale South .- Paddy: about 16 bushels have been sown. The standing crop is fair.

Fruits and vegetables are scarce.

Coconuts: about 4½ million nuts gathered.

Fish: the supply of fish continues to be good.

Health of people: fair, but dysentery and fever prevail to some extent in several villages,

Health of cattle: good.

NORTH-CENTRAL PROVINCE.

ANTIRADRAPURA DISTRICT.

Weather: variable.

Rainfall: the registered rainfall at Anuradhapura during the month was 9.50 inches. There was satisfactory rain throughout the Province during the month.

Paddy: in some villages the maha fields are in plant, whilst in others cultivation for the maha has just commenced. Kurakkan chenas show young crops. In Kalagam palata the crops on some chenas are reported to have died. Tavalu (tank bed) chenas have young crops. Other products: coconut trees flowered satisfactorily during the month. The estimated crop gathered

during the month was 13,000 nuts.

Health of people: a few cases of fever, chickenpox, and diarrhoa were reported from a few villages. The town of Anuradhapura is now free from the epidemic of smallpox which prevailed since September last There were several cases of acute diarrheea at Alinchipotana in Tamankaduwa district, resulting in a few deaths Health of cattle: satisfactory.

Village tanks: some tanks are spilling, and the rest are either full or half full.

PROVINCE OF UVA.

BADULLA DISTRICT.

Weather: generally wet.

Paddy: fields are being ploughed for maha harvest.

Chenas: sowing is over. Fruits: scarce and dear.

Vegetables: scarce, except in Udukinda, where they are cheap and plentiful.

Other products: (a) the flowering of coconuts is good; (b) estimated produce for the month: Weliassa 20,000, Buttala 6,500, Viyaluwa 9,000, Yatikinda 3,988, Bintenna 1,450, Wellawaya 200.

Health of people: fair. Malarial fever prevailed throughout the Province. Dysentery has been

reported from different parts of the Province.

Health of cattle: rinderpest is still raging in Yatikinda, Udukinda, Wellassa, and Wellawaya.

Prices of staple products: rice, Rs. 5 to Rs. 7 per bushel; kurakkan, Re. 1.50 to Re. 1.75 per bushel; paddy Re. 1.75 to Rs. 2.50 per bushel; coconuts, Rs. 6 to Rs. 10 per 100.

Rainfall: 15.24 in. as registered at the observatory.

PROVINCE OF SABARAGAMUWA.

RATNAPURA DISTRICT.

Paddy: in Kuruwiti, Nawadun, Atakalan, Kadawata, Meda, and Kukul korales maha crops are ripening, and some are being harvested. In Kuruwiti korale muttehe corps have been sown. In Kolonna,

Kadawata, and Meda korales yala fields are being prepared for sowing; prospects are favourable.

Dry grain: in Kuruwiti korale yala chenas are ripening. In Kuruwiti and Nawadun korales owiti crops are blossoming. In Nawadun, Atakalan, Kolonna, Kadawata, Meda, and Kukul korales maha crops are

in blossom, and some are ripening.

Other products, coconuts: in Kuruwiti korale flowering prospects are good; crop is estimated at 35,000 nuts. In Nawadun and Atakalan korales there is no particular season for flowering. In Kolonna korale flowering prospects are favourable; crop is estimated at 425 nuts. In Kadawata and Meda korales flowering prospects are good; the crops gathered were fairly large. In Kukul korale flowering prospects are good; crop is estimated at 500 nuts.

The health of people on the whole is satisfactory. In some villages in Nawadun, Kadawata, and Meda

korales fever, chickenpox, and dysentery prevailed.

The health of the cattle is satisfactory.

The prices of food products are rice, Rs. 5 to Rs. 7 per bushel; paddy, Rs. 2 to Rs. 2.25 per bushel; kurakkan, Re. 1 to Rs. 2 per bushel; amu, 75 cents to Re. 1 per bushel; coconuts, Rs. 3 to Rs. 9 per 100 nuts; salt, 10 cents to 25 cents per measure.

KEGALLA DISTRICT.

Paddy: maha prospects are good.

Dry grain: hill paddy, iringu, and amu prospects are good. Kurakkan chenas are being sown. Prices: paddy, Re. 1:50 to Rs. 2 per bushel; hill paddy, Re. 1:50 per bushel; kurakkan, Re. 1 per bushel; amu, 75 cents per bushel. Rainfall: Kegalla, 9 41 in.

Cattle disease: nil.

Health of people: chickenpox and dysentery are prevalent.
