## ABSTRACTS OF SEASON REPORTS.

### SEASON REPORTS FOR THE MONTH OF FEBRUARY, 1909.

#### WESTERN PROVINCE.

##### COLOMBO DISTRICT.

Paddy : the maha harvest is being reaped and threshed. Preparations for the yala are in progress.

Dry grain : no cultivation worth reporting.

Other products : the supply of vegetables was good and prices were reasonable, but fruit was scarce and dear. The flowering and prospects of coconuts were not satisfactory during the month. The crop for the month is reported at 9,880,875 coconuts approximately.

Prices of staple products : rice, Rs. 4.50 to Rs. 6 a bushel ; coconuts, Rs. 40 to Rs. 50 a thousand.

Rainfall : there was very little rain during the month.

Remarks on harvest prospects generally : the maha crop gathered is considered to be fairly good.

Observations on the health of the inhabitants : there were cases of malarial fever, measles, dysentery, chickenpox, and smallpox in some villages, otherwise the health of the inhabitants was generally good.

##### KALUTARA DISTRICT.

Paddy : the maha harvest is being gathered in, and preparations for the yala sowing are in progress.

Dry grain : nothing worth reporting.

Other products : (a) the supply of vegetables and fruits has been limited during the month. There was a fair supply of jak and breadfruit in the totamunes and Rayigam korale. An increased supply of cassava bulb was noticeable throughout the whole district. (b) The flowering of coconut has not been satisfactory owing to the severe drought that prevailed during the month ; the crop for the month is estimated at 1,876,000 nuts.

Prices of staple products : rice, Rs. 4.25 to Rs. 6.50 per bushel ; coconuts, Rs. 35 to Rs. 70 per thousand.

Remarks on harvest prospects generally : a fairly good crop may be expected.

Rainfall at Kalutara : total .49 in. ; mean .01 in.

Health of people : six cases of smallpox were reported during the month, five from Beruwalbadda and one from the Panadurebadda. The disease was introduced from Colombo by two members of the Moorish community, who came down to Maligahena in Beruwalabadda and Sarikkamulla in Panadurebadda, and died of the disease. Prompt and stringent measures have been adopted for stamping out the disease. A few cases of chickenpox, dysentery, and fever were also reported during the month.

Health of cattle : there is no disease at present among cattle. Rinderpest, which prevailed in Rayigam korale during the past few months, has been completely stamped out.

#### CENTRAL PROVINCE.

##### KANDY DISTRICT.

Paddy, maha : reaping in progress ; prospect of crop, good. Yala : nil.

Dry grain, maha : hill paddy is being harvested.

Rainfall : good.

Health of people: malarial fever prevalent.

## MULLAITTIVU DISTRICT.

The crops in high level fields in many villages in the Maritime pattus have died for want of water.
