ON and after February 15, 1909, a harbour buoy, painted black and white in chequers, will be placed on the site of the proposed head of the extension breakwater works now in progress. Vessels intending to enter Colombo Harbour by the southern entrance should not pass south of this buoy.

2. It is recommended that during the period these works are in progress vessels should make use of the northern entrance, and masters are requested to place their ships in such a position as to allow of the pilot turning them to come through that entrance.

3. These works will be in progress probably until April, 1911.

4. As at present the practicability of retaining this buoy in position during the south-west monsoon is uncertain, the buoy will be removed about April 15 and replaced about October 15. A further notice will be published if the buoy should not be removed.

5. The skeleton steel leading light mast on the south-east shore of the Harbour near the Patent Slip and the Pier head lighthouse on the south-west breakwater when in line bearing from the ship S. 14° E. magnetic leads directly over the site of this buoy, and to enter passing clear of the works in progress the Pier head lighthouse must be kept open to the south of the skeleton mast, and at night the red light must be kept open to the south of the occulting light on this skeleton steel mast (*vide* Notice to Mariners dated December 23, 1908).

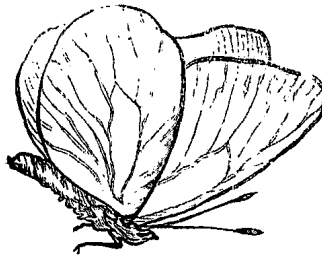
