MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information:

> An Ordinance to amend "The Cacao Thefts Prevention Ordinance, 1904."

Preamble.

HEREAS it is expedient to amend "The Cacao Thefts Prevention Ordinance, 1904," hereinafter referred to as "the principal Ordinance" in certain particulars: Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Cacao Thefts Prevention (Amendment) Ordinance, 190," and shall be read and construed as one with the principal Ordinance; and this Ordinance and the principal Ordinance may be cited together as "The Cacao Thefts Prevention Ordinances, 1904 and 190 ."

Addition of new section.

2 After section 19 of the principal Ordinance the following section shall be added and shall be numbered 19 A:

Jurisdiction of Police Courts. Every offence under this Ordinance shall be triable by a Police Court, and such court shall have power to inflict the full penalty prescribed for such offence by the said Ordinance, any provision of "The Criminal Procedure Code, 1898," or of any other enactment to the contrary notwithstanding.

The object of this Ordinance is to give Police Magistrates jurisdiction to try all offences under "The Cacao Thefts Ordinance, 1904," including the offence of buying cacao without a license, which at present is triable only by a District Court.
