## ABSTRACTS OF SEASON REPORTS.

### SEASON REPORTS FOR THE MONTH OF MARCH, 1909.

#### WESTERN PROVINCE.

##### COLOMBO DISTRICT.

Paddy : preparations are being made for yala cultivation.

Dry grain : no cultivation worth reporting.

Other products : the supply of vegetables was fair and prices were reasonable, but fruit was scarce and dear. The flowering and prospects of coconuts appear to be slightly better than during the past few months. The crop for the month is reported at 10,416,420 coconuts approximately.

Prices of staple products : rice, Rs. 4 to Rs. 6 a bushel ; coconuts, Rs. 35 to Rs. 47 a thousand.

Rainfall : there were a few showers of rain during the latter part of the month.

Remarks on harvest prospects generally : the dry weather has, to some extent, hindered preparation for the yala.

Observations on the health of the inhabitants : there were, in some villages, cases of malarial fever, measles, chickenpox, smallpox, and dysentery ; otherwise the health of the inhabitants was generally good.

##### KALUTARA DISTRICT.

Paddy : the reaping of the maha harvest, which was a fairly good one, was over during the month. The yala cultivation is in progress.

Dry grain : no cultivation worth reporting.

Other products : (a) There was a fair supply of vegetables and fruits ; (b) no change was noticeable in the flowering of coconuts during the month, but the few showers of rain that fell during the last week is likely to have a bad effect on young nuts ; (c) the crop for the month is estimated at 1,805,700 nuts.

Prices of staple products : (a) rice, Rs. 5 to Rs. 7 per bushel ; (b) coconuts, Rs. 35 to Rs. 70 per thousand.

Remarks on harvest prospects generally : no opinion can be expressed as yet.

Rainfall at Kalutara : total 9·68 ; mean, ·31.

Health of people : there were a few cases of smallpox, chickenpox, fever, dysentery, and measles in some villages ; otherwise the health of the inhabitants was generally good.

Health of cattle : good.

In Kolonna korale flowering prospects are good, the crop is estimated at 485 nuts. In Kadawata and Meda korales coconut crops are fair during the month, and weather is favourable. The price of coconuts is still high. In Kukul korale flowering prospects are good, and the crop is estimated at 500 nuts.

The health of the people on the whole is satisfactory, and cattle enjoy immunity from murrain.
