SEASON REPORTS FOR THE MONTH OF MARCH, 1909.

WESTERN PROVINCE.

COLOMBO DISTRICT.

Paddy: preparations are being made for yala cultivation. Sowing has begun in some villages.

Dry grain: no cultivation worth reporting.

Other products: the supply of vegetables and fruit was good, and prices were moderate. The flowering and prospects of coconuts appear to be better than during the past three or four months. The crop for the month is reported at 8,959,313 coconuts approximately.

Prices of staple products: rice, Rs. 4 to Rs. 6 per bushel; coconuts, Rs. 35 to Rs. 46 per thousand.

Rainfall: the rainfall was below the average during the month.

Remarks on harvest prospects generally: a good yala harvest may be generally expected.

Observations on the health of the inhabitants: there were in some villages cases of malarial fever, four cases of smallpox, a few cases of measles and of chickenpox, otherwise the health of the inhabitants was generally good.
