## PROCLAMATIONS BY THE GOVERNOR.

In the Name of Her Majesty VICTORIA, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland Queen, Defender of the Faith.

### PROCLAMATION.

By His Excellency Sir ARTHUR ELIBANK HAVELOCK, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Island of Ceylon, with the Dependencies thereof.

WHEREAS by the 4th section of the Ordinance No. 9 of 1882, intituled "An Ordinance to amend 'The Medical Wants Ordinance, 1880,' and to repeal 'The Medical Wants Ordinance, 1880, Amendment Ordinance, 1881,'" it is enacted that for the purposes of providing a special fund to defray the cost of the medical care of labourers on estates under the said Ordinance and "The Medical Wants Ordinance, 1880," it shall be lawful for the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, from time to time by Proclamation in the *Gazette* to impose a duty, and the same from time to time to increase or reduce, not exceeding ten cents per cwt. on coffee, tea, and cacao and twenty cents per cwt. on cinchona, which duty shall be levied at the Customs on the entry for exportation of all coffee, tea, cacao, and cinchona, and shall be payable to, and shall

be collected and received by, the proper officers of the Customs Department; and the payment thereof shall be enforced under the provisions of the Ordinance No. 17 of 1869, intituled "An Ordinance for the General regulation of Customs in the Island of Ceylon":

And whereas by a Proclamation dated the 12th day of January, 1884, for the purpose of the said "Medical Wants Ordinance, 1880, Amendment Ordinance, 1882," His Excellency the then Governor of this Island, with the advice of the Executive Council, imposed a duty of twenty cents per cwt. upon all cinchona entered for exportation at any port in this Colony:

And whereas it is expedient for the purposes of the said Ordinance to decrease the export duty leviable on cinchona from a duty of twenty cents per cwt. to a duty of five cents per cwt.:

Now know Ye that We, the said Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, by this Our Proclamation do, for the purposes of the said Ordinance, reduce the aforesaid duty upon cinchona of twenty cents per cwt. to a duty of five cents per cwt., which last-mentioned duty We hereby impose as the duty upon all cinchona entered for exportation at any port in this Colony as from and after the First day of September, 1891.

Given at Colombo, in the said Island of Ceylon, this Twenty-fifth day of August, in the year of our Lord One thousand Eight hundred and Ninety-one.

## DRAFT ORDINANCES.

### MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information :—

**An Ordinance to amend “The Colombo Waterworks’ Ordinance, 1886.”**

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend “The Colombo Waterworks’ Ordinance, 1886,” hereinafter referred to as the principal Ordinance: Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :—

To be read as one with the Ordinance No. 7 of 1886.  
Short title.

1 This Ordinance shall be read as one with the principal Ordinance, and may be cited as “The Colombo Waterworks’ Ordinance, 1891,” and this Ordinance and the principal Ordinance may be cited collectively as “The Colombo Waterworks’ Ordinances, 1886 and 1891.”

Amendment of section 16 of Ordinance No. 7 of 1886.

2 For section 16 of the principal Ordinance the following section shall be substituted, namely :—

Water may be supplied for other than domestic purposes subject to conditions made by the Governor in Executive Council.

“16 Independently of the water or consolidated rate leviable under section 12 and the expenses payable under section 5, the waterworks engineer, on behalf of the Ceylon Government, may agree with any person to supply water for other than domestic purposes, in such manner, on such terms, and subject to such conditions and regulations as may from time to time be determined and made by the Governor in Executive Council.”

Amendment of section 17.

3 In section 17 of the principal Ordinance the words “by meter” shall be omitted.

Amendment of section 34.

4 For sub-section (f) of section 34 of the principal Ordinance the following sub-section shall be substituted, namely :—

“(f) For regulating the supply of water under section 16, and the materials and fittings to be used therefor, and the use of water meters when required.”

AUSTRALIA, NORTH COAST.—APPROACHES TO PORT  
DARWIN, NORTHERN TERRITORY.

Masters of ships and others are hereby informed that the following lights are now in course of construction and will be exhibited about June, 1892 :—

*Charles Point.*—Position (approx.) : lat. 12° 23' 20" S. ; long. 130° 37' E. The tower to be built of iron and painted red and white in horizontal bands. The focal plane of the light to be 121 ft. above high water, and the light will be visible from a vessel's deck, in ordinary weather, 18 miles. The light will be of the first order, revolving every thirty seconds, and will show over an arc of 257°, viz. :—A green sector of 60° over the Great Fish Reef and adjacent dangers, from N. 22° E. to N. 82° E. ; bright 155° from N. 82° E. to S. 57° W. ; and a red sector of 42° showing over the shoals to the west of Port Darwin entrance, from S. 57° W. to N. 81° W. ; the remaining arc of 103° to be obscure.

*Point Emery.*—Tower to be of masonry. The focal plane of the light to be 56 ft. above high water, and the light to be visible from a vessel's deck, in ordinary weather 14 miles. The light will be of the third order, fixed, and will show over an arc of 118°, viz. :—Red from N. 82° E. to S. 53° E. ; a bright sector of 8° (showing the deep water channel between the shoals at the entrance of Port Darwin) from S. 53° E. to S. 45° E. and red from S. 45° E. to S. 10° W.

*Port Darwin Jetty.*—A small bright jetty light, visible about 4 miles, to show mainly in the direction of the channel.

Usuka Bay.

According to the reports of the Navigating Lieut. Y. Tanaka, of H.M.S. Nisshin, a sunken reef called Mebarusone reef, lying about 2½ cables north-eastward of Kajikake rock in Usuka Bay, Hiradoshima, or marked "5 fathoms" on the charts, is ½ cable in extent, and has depths less than 7 fathoms on it.

The position of least depth (4½ fathoms) on this reef is as follows :—

4 ⅓ cables N.E. by E. from the top of Gionze.

About ⅔ cable north-westward of "5 fathoms spot" marked on the chart.

Honshu, North-West Coast—Iwami District—Sunken  
Reefs at the Approaches of Hamada (Tono-ura) and  
Nagahama Harbours.

Commander Y. Tomono, I.J.N., in charge of Iwami coast survey, reports that three sunken rocks as follows exist at the approaches of Hamada and Nagahama harbours :—

Shakuri, with a depth of 1½ fathom on it at lower water springs, is situated with the pine tree of Sangaiyama nearly in line with Kurose, bearing S.E. by E. ¼ E., and the western extreme of Umashima N.N.E. ¼ E.

Kushinoguri, with a depth of 3½ fathoms on it at low water springs, is situated with the eastern extreme of Yan-shima in line with the centre of Tenjinjima, bearing S.S.W., and the northern extreme of Umashima W. by N. ¾ N.

Kuchirose, with a depth of 3½ fathoms on it at low water springs, is situated with the north-western extreme of Setogashima nearly in line with the centre of Kasurajima, bearing S.W. by S ¼ W., and the western extreme of Umashima W. by S. ¾ S.

The bearings are magnetic. Variation of 4° 45' westerly in 1891.

*Nippon Naikai (Inland Sea)—Bungo Channel—  
Existence of two Sunken Rocks in Saiki Bay.*

Osaka shosen Ka'isha's steamer Ujigawa Maru has informed as follows:—The two sunken rocks exist at the channel between the north coast of Orjima, and Hirihoishi Mura, in Saiki Bay, Bungo Channel.

Uwatarobai.—This rock, with 1½ fathoms of water on it at low water springs, is oval in shape, about 2 ken (6 yards) in extent, and lies with the north end of Kitagaudojima, bearing S.S.E, distant 1 cable.

Sokobai.—This rock lies 6 ken (18 yards) N.E. by E. from the rock described above, and has 2½ fathoms of water on it at low water springs, but its shape is yet unknown.

The bearings are magnetic. Variation of 3° 40' westerly in 1882.

*Great Sandy Strait.—Alteration in Position of  
Leading Lights for Stewart Island Cutting.*

Notice is hereby given that on and after July 23, two white lights for leading through Stewart Island Cutting will be exhibited from triangular beacons on Stewart Island to the southward of the cutting; and the lights (red and white) hitherto shown from beacons north of the cutting will be discontinued.

## NOTICES CALLING FOR TENDERS.

**S**EALD Tenders (in duplicate), marked on the envelopes "Tender for construction of a Bathing Ghaut," will be received at the Colonial Secretary's Office up to noon on Monday, August 31, 1891, from persons willing to contract for the under-mentioned service:—

For construction of a bathing ghaut.

The tenders are to be made on forms which will be supplied upon application at the office of the Director of Public Works, and no tender will be considered unless it is furnished on the recognised form.

A deposit of Rs. 100 will be required before any form of tender is issued; and should any person decline to enter into the contract and bond after he has tendered, or fail to furnish approved security, such deposit will be forfeited to the Crown. All other deposits will be returned upon signature of a contract.

The deposit should be made at the Treasury or the Kachcheri, and the receipt of the Treasurer or the Government Agent produced when applying for forms.

Sufficient sureties will be required to join in a bond for the due fulfilment of the contract.

The amount of the bond, and all other necessary information in respect of plans, specification, &c., can be ascertained upon application at the office of the Provincial Engineer, Western Province, Colombo.

The Government reserves to itself the right, without question, of rejecting any or all tenders, and the right of accepting any portion of a tender.

Time required for the completion of the work should be stated in the tender.

Persons whose tenders are accepted by Government will be required to bear the expense of having security bonds prepared for the due performance of their contracts, which bonds will be subject to the approval of the Attorney-General, but may be drawn by the tenderers' own lawyers. Minutes of Proceeding of a Meeting of the Municipal Council of Kandy held in the Town Hall, Kandy, on Saturday, June 27, 1891, at 3 o'clock p.m.

*Present*:—Hon. R. W. D. Moir, Chairman; F. Vine, Esq.; J. B. Siebel, Esq.; J. H. Sproule, Esq.; J. N. d'Estre, Esq.; E. Beven, Esq.; B. de Alwis, Esq.

1. The Minutes of Proceedings of the Meeting held on May 30 were read and confirmed.

2. The following documents were laid on the table:—General Statement of Receipts and Disbursements from close of 1890 to May 31; Separate Statement of Receipts and Disbursements in respect of the General Revenue, Police Assessment, and Water Rate; Progress Report of Work done brought up to the same date; Work done by the Municipal Magistrate, and of Cases instituted by the several Inspectors during the month of May; also Health Officer's report for the same month.

Resolved,—That the General Statement of Receipts and Disbursements and Progress Report be forwarded to Government, together with the Minutes of Proceedings of the Meeting, for publication, as required by section 90 of the Municipal Councils' Ordinance; and also the Health Officer's Report.

3. Read letter No. 15 dated June 17, from the Colonial Secretary, forwarding for any observations or remarks an extract from a report by Acting Solicitor-General, suggesting the introduction of one General Ordinance with respect to the By-laws of the three Municipalities. The papers had been circulated and seen by seven out of the nine Members of the Council. After a short discussion, in which the Chairman, and Messrs. Siebel, Sproule, and Beven took part, it was resolved that further consideration of the matter be deferred until the next Meeting, and in the meantime that the papers be sent to the Members who, owing to absence, have not seen them.

4. Read letter No. 13 dated June 18, from the Colonial Secretary, forwarding for consideration and report copy of a Despatch from the Secretary of State and of its enclosures in respect of a petition from Saka Lebbe Mohideen, asking that water may be supplied free of charge to the Meera Makan Mosque in Kandy.

After full consideration of the subject it was unanimously resolved—That the Municipal Council adheres to the charge for water supplied to the mosque, no sufficient ground having been shown why such charge should not be made.

5. Read letter dated Port Said, May 31, from Mr. F. H. M. Corbet, offering to the Municipal Council a portrait of the late Hon. James van Langenberg, which he hoped would be placed in a prominent position in the Town Hall of Kandy, where he (the late Hon. van Langenberg) began the public career in which he so distinguished himself. Resolved,—That the offer be accepted, and that the thanks of the Municipal Council be conveyed to Mr. F. Corbet for his gift; that the Secretary be instructed to write to Messrs. H. W. Cave & Co. and obtain the portrait.

6. In pursuance of notice Mr. J. B. Siebel moved that a statement be laid on the table, with reference to the resolution of the Council authorising the seizure of stray dogs, showing (1) the number of dogs seized; (2) general description, if possible, of such dogs; (3) the number of dogs claimed; (4) the names of claimants; (5) the number of dogs destroyed; and (6) the sum expended in carrying out the Council's resolution.

The statement called for was submitted, excepting the description of dogs seized, of which no record has been kept.

Resolved,—That the statement be circulated.

7. Read letter No. 14 of June 11 from the Colonial Secretary, acknowledging receipt of the Annual Administration Report for 1890; and stating, in reply to the application for twenty printed copies, that it may be a couple of months before copies can be sent.

In reply to a question by the Chairman, whether the Council would desire the manuscript to be returned in order that it may be printed, it was determined that the Council await the printing by Government of the report.

### Sanitary Report for May, 1891.

*General Health.*—The general health of the town during this month was satisfactory. Only three cases of chickenpox and one of measles were reported by the Police, and there were a few cases of ophthalmia. Though there was an outbreak of smallpox in a village a few miles from Katugastota, I am glad to say that the disease did not spread to the town, though there was daily communication with it, the villagers bringing poultry, &c., for sale. There was one case of smallpox, however, at Katukele, which was traced to this village. The patient was a Moorman who had lived in the village, and had to come into Kandy a few days before he took ill. The man was at once removed to the hospital and his house well disinfected, and the inmates kept under observation.

**Vaccination.**—There were 122 persons vaccinated during the month, of whom 88 were found successfully vaccinated, 3 were unsuccessful, and 31 were absent on the days of inspection. Of 22 re-vaccinated, 3 were successful, 3 failed, and 16 did not appear again for inspection.

**Drainage, &c.**—There is nothing new to report on the subject of the drains and scavenging in the town. I would again urge the necessity of increasing the number of public latrines and the regular clearing out of the drains and frequent flushings. Also, the clearing away of all filth and fecal deposits not only from the sides of the principal streets in the town, which is partially done now, but also from the lanes and alleys of the crowded parts, and the various walks and drives.

**Slaughter-house, &c.**—The cattle which were daily inspected before slaughter were found satisfactory. The exposing shed has been put in order and properly concreted.
