MUNICIPALITY OF KANDY.

Minutes of Proceedings of a Meeting of the Municipal Council of Kandy held in the Town Hall, Kandy, on February 27, 1909, at 8.30 a.m., in accordance with notice dated February 23, 1909.

Present :—The Hon. Mr. J. P. Lewis, Chairman; Mr. E. Beven; Mr. W. D. Gibbon; Dr. G. P. Schokman; Mr. E. L. Wijegoonewardene; Mr. S. A. Owen; Mr. W. C. Price; Mr. R. W. Jonklaas; and Mr. V. M. Saravanamuttu.

1. The Minutes of Proceedings of the Meeting held on January 23 having been previously submitted to the Chairman for his approval, and a copy thereof furnished to each Member, were taken as read, and confirmed by the Chairman.

2. The following documents were submitted :—

(a) Statements of Receipts and Expenditure from close of 1908 to January 31, 1909, on account of the Municipal fund, comprising the (No. 1) General Revenue and Consolidated Rate (Police and Lighting) and (No. 2) Water Rate Accounts.

(b) Progress Report of Works brought up to the same date.

(c) Health Officer's Report for January.

(d) Statement of Cases instituted by the several Inspectors and of Work done by the Municipal Magistrate, during the month of January.

(e) The Reservoir Readings for January.

Resolved—That the several statements, together with the Minutes of Proceedings of this Meeting, as required by section 90 of the Municipal Council's Ordinance, No. 7 of 1887, and the Health Officer's report, be forwarded to the Colonial Secretary for publication in the *Government Gazette*.

3. The following papers were laid on the table :—Reports by the several inspectors on laundries, bakeries, standpipes, and house-service taps inspected during January.

4. Correspondence :—

(a) Circular No. 14 of January 30, 1909, from the Hon. the Colonial Secretary, *re* liability of Municipal and other local authorities to stamp receipts.—Read.

(b) Endorsement No. 3 of February 5, 1909, from the Hon. the Colonial Secretary, *re* report of the Special Committee on the Draft Ordinance amending Municipal Council's Ordinance, 1887.—Read.

(c) Letter No. 2 of February 9, 1909, from the Hon. the Colonial Secretary, *re* additional by-laws, Municipal Council, Kandy.—Read.

(d) Copy of letter No. 79 from the Hon. the Colonial Secretary to the Hon. the Treasurer, *re* Government moiety of the cost of (1) paving stream at the back of the public offices, Kandy, and (2) drain from Kandy hospital to the stream at Deyannewela for the information of the Municipal Council, Kandy.—Read.

(e) Letter No. 6,022 of January 4, 1909, from the Postmaster, Kandy, *re* telephone service for the Municipal Office for re-consideration.

The Chairman moved—That the Council do sign the agreement to have the telephone service at the Municipal Office for a term of one year at Rs. 125 per annum.

Mr. Wijegoonewardene seconded—Carried.

(f) Letter of January 28, 1909, from the Hon. Secretary, Kandy Tennis Club, asking for permission to have certain trees near the Tennis Court cut down.

Moved by the Chairman, seconded by Mr. Beven, that the permission applied for be given.—Carried.

(g) Letter of February 2, 1909, from Messrs. Walker & Sons, applying for permission to carry out extensions to the "Firs" Hotel, Kandy.

Moved by the Chairman, seconded by Mr. Wijegoonewardene, that the necessary permission be given.—Carried, Mr. Owen dissenting.

5. Petition from Messrs. C. D. S. Wijeysekera and D. Weerasinghe, proprietors of dairies Nos. 5, 8, and 21, praying that the regulations to ensure a pure and wholesome supply of milk to the town be strictly enforced together with the Health Officer's report thereon.

Moved by Mr. Beven—That the inspectors be directed to inspect all dairies monthly and to pay surprise visits, and to send in reports stating the number of cattle in each dairy daily.

Seconded by Mr. Owen—Carried.

6. Pursuant to notice the Chairman moved—That Chapter XXII. (Construction of Drains and Buildings) of the By-laws of the Colombo Municipal Council be substituted *en bloc* for Chapter IV. of the Kandy Municipal By-laws.

Seconded by Mr. Wijegoonewardene.—Carried.

Health Officer's Report for January, 1909.

Scavenging.—There was considerable improvement in the scavenging this month.

Water Supply.—Good, but not sufficient.

Drainage.—All the drains were regularly flushed and cleaned.

Alleys.—These were kept in as sanitary a state as possible.

Bakeries.—Clean and well kept.

Cooly Lines.—These were clean; the premises attached to them were thoroughly cleaned and swept daily.

Night Soil Depot.—Clean and well kept.

Laundries.—In good order.

Eating Houses.—All fairly well kept.

Dairies.—Well kept.

Public Latrines.—In good order.

Public Market.—Clean and well kept.

Boutiques.—These were frequently inspected by me. I found the articles exposed for sale of good quality and fit for food.

Food Supply.—Ample, and of good quality. 579 cattle, 105 buffaloes, 92 sheep, and 258 goats were slaughtered during the month.

The salt and dry fish exposed for sale were of good quality, and fit for food.

Fresh fish and vegetables were good and always in stock.

Public Health.—The health of the Town during the month was satisfactory. Two cases of chickenpox and three cases of enteric fever were reported; of these, last one case was brought into Hospital from outside Municipal limits. There were five cases of smallpox; these patients all lived together in one house. The house is in Mulgampola, close to the house in which the first case of smallpox occurred. In my opinion there has either been a case of concealed smallpox or the inspection has been spread by clothing.

All the contacts were discharged on February 2, after a period of twenty days' segregation.

All sanitary precautions were taken to prevent any further spread of the disease.

George Cameron Douglas.—"Tea leaf drying and withering machine."

Abstract.—A cylinder of gauze or perforated plate is mounted on a horizontal axle and so that it is caused to rotate. The arms attaching the ends of the cylinder to the axle are flat, but are set at an angle of about 45° to a diametral plane passing through the cylinder and an arm, and so that air is induced to flow into the cylinder from both ends when the cylinder and arms are rotated. The tea is placed in the cylinder, and, by centrifugal action, is spread over the inside curved surface of the cylinder. It is intended that the air and moisture shall pass off and through the tea and the gauze or perforated plate.

That method of drying or withering tea, as described and illustrated by the drawings is claimed as the invention.

Waller Frederic Perman.—"An improved joint for chimneys and the like on corrugated iron roofs."

Abstract.—The invention is for a means of forming a watertight joint between a chimney, or the like, and a corrugated iron roof; and comprises a sheet corrugated to correspond with the corrugations of the roof, and an adaptor or collar forming a flanged connection between the roof and the chimney; the whole being bolted together with a rubber or like sheet between them.

Sydney Julius.—"Improvements in and relating to carburettors."

Abstract.—The invention is intended to cover generally the use in carburettors of a rotating spirally wound surface, or the like, for the deposition and distribution of the volatile liquid thereon.

When the carburettor is to have a more or less horizontal axis the spirally wound surface is a true spiral with all straight lines that can be drawn on its surface parallel to the axle about which it is wound. The volatile liquid is admitted at one end of and at the outer edge of the spiral. As the spiral is kept rotated and is inclined, the volatile liquid will tend to flow longitudinally and towards the centre of the spiral, if the direction of rotation is appropriate. Air is conducted through the casing containing the spiral and volatilization will occur.

When the carburettor is to have a vertical axis the spirally wound surface is the development of a screw thread, and it is intended that the liquid shall spread over one surface of such a thread as it flows from above downwards. The direction of rotation is not then defined.

It is specified that the spiral or the screw thread may be formed of gauze and it may be corrugated or fluted.

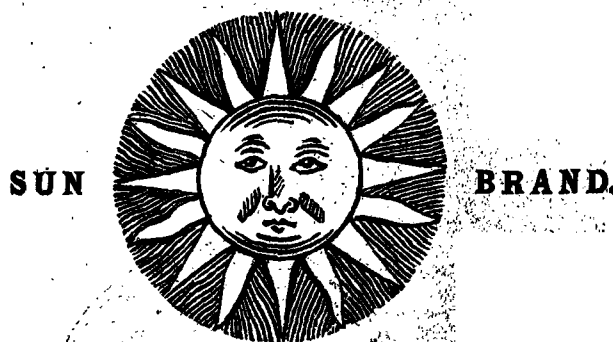

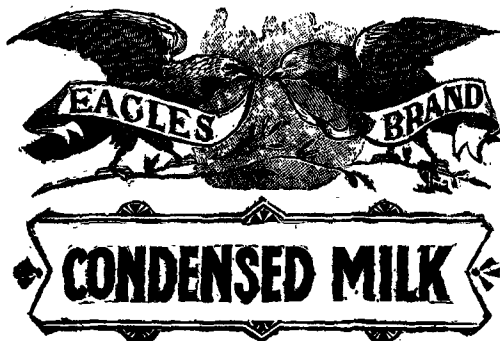
