SEASON REPORTS FOR THE MONTH OF JULY, 1909.

WESTERN PROVINCE.

COLOMBO DISTRICT.

Paddy: yala plants are generally thriving, and are here and there already in ear. Sowing for maha has commenced in some villages.

Dry grain: no cultivation worth reporting.

Other products: the supply of vegetables and fruit was good, and prices were fair. The flowering and prospects of coconuts were good in consequence of the favourable rain. The crop for the month is reported at 10,436,899 coconuts approximately.

Prices of staple products: rice, Rs. 4 to Rs. 6.25 a bushel; coconuts, Rs. 35 to Rs. 50 a 1,000.

Rainfall: the rainfall during the month was sufficient for the purposes of cultivation, though it was below the average.

Remarks on harvest prospects generally: a good yala harvest may be generally expected.

Observations on the health of the inhabitants: there were in some villages a few cases of malarial fever, typhoid fever, chickenpox, measles, dysentery, and one case of smallpox in Pita Kotte, otherwise the health of the inhabitants was generally good.

KALUTARA DISTRICT.

Paddy: the paddy plants of the yala cultivation are now earing.

Dry grain: nothing worth reporting.

Other products: the supply of vegetables has been scanty, and fruits have been scarce; (b) there has been a slight improvement in the flowering of coconuts during the month; (c) the crop for the month is estimated at 2,875,000.

Prices of staple products: rice, Rs. 5 to Rs. 7 per bushel; coconuts, Rs. 35 to Rs. 70 per 1,000.

Remarks on harvest prospects generally: a fairly good crop may be expected.

Rainfall at Kalutara: total, 8.90 in.; mean, .29 in.

Health of the people: satisfactory on the whole. There were only a few cases of contagious fever, chickenpox, dysentery, measles, and one case of smallpox in the district. Smallpox has now been completely stamped out.

Health of cattle: rinderpest and hoof-and-mouth diseases still exist in some villages of Kalutara totamune and Rayigam korale. Vigorous measures are being taken to stamp out the diseases.

CENTRAL PROVINCE.

KANDY DISTRICT.

Paddy, maha : ploughing in progress. Yala : transplanting in progress.

Dry grain, maha : sowing in progress.

Rainfall : sufficient.

Prospect of coconut crop : flowering good. Estimated produce for July, 1909 : Yatinuwara 15,000, Tumpane 18,000, Harispattuwa 1,200, Uda Dumbera 1,000, Pata Hewahata 74,000. In other divisions crop not ascertainable.

Prices of staple articles : paddy, Rs. 2 per bushel ; kurakkan, Re. 1.50 per bushel ; rice, Rs. 5.50 per bushel ; salt, Rs. 3 per bushel ; coconuts, Rs. 6 per 100.

Health of people : good.

Health of cattle : rinderpest prevailed in Arattane, Hurikaduwa, Wattedgama, Alutwela, Teldeniya, Nattarampota, and Wewegama in Pata Dumbera ; Watuliyadda, Doraliyadda, and Moragahamulla in Uda Dumbera ; Mailapitiya in Pata Hewaheta.

MATALE DISTRICT.

Rainfall : 6.29 in.

Paddy : yala fields in ear and in plant.

Dry grain : menderia chenas are ripening. Kurakkan chenas are being cleared.

Coconut : (a) flowering, promising ; (b) 119,500 nuts approximate crop.

Tanks in Matale North are half full.

Health of people : good.

Health of cattle : good.

Prices : moderate.

NUWARA ELIYA DISTRICT.

NORTHERN PROVINCE.

JAFFNA DISTRICT.

Paddy : nil.

Dry grains : tinaichamy and panichamy harvest in progress ; crop moderate.

Other products.—Coconuts : condition of flowers and nuts good. Palmyras : condition of nuts good.

Tobacco : crops have been harvested. The average price per 1,000 leaves is Rs. 10.

Prices of staple articles : paddy, Rs. 2.12 per bushel ; rice, Rs. 5.75 per bushel ; varaku, Re. 1.87 per bushel ; kurakkan, Rs. 2 per bushel ; pairu, Rs. 4.50 per bushel ; ellu, Rs. 6 per bushel ; salt, 4 cents per pound and 9 cents per measure.

Prices of food stuff : rice, Rs. 6 per bushel ; paddy, Rs. 2 per bushel ; coconuts, Rs. 5.50 per 100.

Paddy, yala cultivation : prospects fair.

Other grains : chenas are being cleared for maha cultivation.

Weather : rainfall at Hambantota, 2.63 in. ; maximum temperature, 86.2° ; minimum temperature, 75.3°.

Health of people : fair.

Health of cattle : rinderpest prevails in the district. There were 9,558 cases, 9,000 deaths, and 376 recoveries up to July 27, 1909.

Coconut crop for the month was about 275,000 nuts.

Prices : Coast rice, Rs. 6 per bushel ; country rice, Rs. 5.75 per bushel ; paddy, Rs. 2 per bushel ; kurakkan, Re. 1.75 per bushel ; coconuts, Rs. 8 per 100 ; plantain, Rs. 40 per 100 bunches ; Indian corn, 75 cents per 100 ; pumpkins, Rs. 20 per 100 ; sweet potatoes Re. 1 per cwt. ; salt, Rs. 4.48 per cwt.

BATTICALOA AND TRINCOMALEE DISTRICTS.

NORTH-WESTERN PROVINCE.

KURUNEGALA DISTRICT.

Paddy crops : in some fields are young, and others are maturing and earing ; prospects : good for southern, poor for northern, part of district. Fields for maha being sown. Village tanks not full.

Fine grain : crops have been taken in, and partly being reaped in Wannī hatpattu ; prospects : not favourable. Crops getting ripe in Katugampola hatpattu ; prospects : fair. Maha being sown. Crops partly young and partly earing in Weudawillī hatpattu ; prospects : fair. Crops being matured in Dambadeni hatpattu ; prospects : good. Crops matured and is being gathered in Hiriyala hatpattu ; prospects : fair.

Prospects of coconut flowering : fair.

Weather : nine days' rain in Wannī hatpattu ; several good showers in Katugampola hatpattu ; good rain in Weudawillī hatpattu ; 22 days' rain in Dambadeni hatpattu.

Health of people : fair.

Health of cattle : cattle murrain is prevailing in few palatas in Wannī, Hiriyala, Katugampola, and Weudawillī hatpattus.

PUTTALAM AND CHILAW DISTRICTS.

Prospects of maha and yala harvests : the maha cultivation has commenced in some places, the yala crop is fair. In Kalpitiya division the yala crops are being reaped. The prospects of the crop in Chilaw District are good.

Dry grain : crops are fair, and are being reaped in Puttalam District. Dry grain sown in Chilaw District is in good condition.

Other products, including statements regarding the flowering and prospects of coconut : vegetables are grown in some villages in Demala hatpattu, and galas are being prepared for tobacco cultivation. Hemp cultivation in Pitigal Korale South is good. Flowering and prospects of coconuts : fair in Puttalam District and good in Chilaw District. The actual crop for the month for which the report is made : the crop for the month is 14,091,680.

Price of staple products : rice, Rs. 5 to Rs. 6.50 per bushel ; paddy, Re. 1.75 to Rs. 3 per bushel ; kurakkan, Re. 1.50 to Rs. 2 per bushel ; coconuts, 4½ cents to 5 cents per nut ; fish and vegetables : dear.

Rainfall of the month : 0.16 in. at Puttalam. There were some few showers of rain in the Chilaw District.

Harvest prospects generally : prospects are not very satisfactory owing to insufficient rain.

Health of inhabitants : generally fair.

Health of cattle : the recent outbreak of rinderpest has been stamped out.

NORTH-CENTRAL PROVINCE.

ANURADHAPURA DISTRICT.

Weather : dry.

Rainfall : there was no rain throughout the Province during the month.

Cultivation—paddy : the crops on the fields cultivated for the yala harvest are reaching maturity. No chena or tavalu cultivation was carried on in the Province during the month.

Other products : coconut trees flowered satisfactorily during the month. The estimated crop gathered during the month is 8,000 nuts.

Health of people : satisfactory.

Health of cattle : rinderpest has broken out in Unduruwa korale of Kalagam palata. There were four cases reported during the last week of the month, and all the animals were shot.

Village tanks : the village tanks are either half full or quarter full.

PROVINCE OF UVA.

BADULLA DISTRICT.

Weather : hot and dry with occasional showers in some parts of the Province.

Paddy : the harvesting of maha crop is finished, except in a few places, where it is still being gathered.

Chenas : chenas are being cleared for 1909 cultivation.

Fruits : fruits are scarce and dear.

Vegetables : vegetables are scarce and dear.

Other products : the flowering and prospects of coconuts are not satisfactory ; estimated produce for the month about 31,675 nuts.

Health of people : satisfactory, although there are cases of fever in almost all the divisions.

Health of cattle : rinderpest still exists in all the Chief Headmen's divisions, but shows signs of decline.

Prices of staple products : rice varies from Rs. 5.50 to Rs. 8 per bushel ; kurakkan, Re. 1.75 to Rs. 2 per bushel ; coconuts, Rs. 6 to Rs. 10 per 100.

Rainfall : 0.29 in. as registered at the observatory.

PROVINCE OF SABARAGAMUWA.

RATNAPURA DISTRICT.

Paddy : fields for maha harvest are being prepared ; prospects are favourable. Fields for the yala harvest are ripening or in blossom.

Crops on high lands : in Kuruwiti korale perayal chenas are ripening. In Nawadun and Kukul korales the crop is blossoming. In Meda, Kadawata, and Kolonna korales chenas are being cleared for fine grain. In Kuruwiti korale paddy plants in owiti lands are three months old.

Other products—coconuts : in Kuruwiti korale flowering prospects are good, and the crop has been estimated at 35,000 nuts. In Nawadun and Atakalan korales there is no particular season for flowering, and the actual crop is not ascertainable. In Kukul korale flowering prospects are good, and the crop is estimated at 250 nuts. In Kolonna korale flowering is not very favourable. In Meda and Kadawata korales flowering prospects are good.

The health of the people generally is satisfactory. There were a few cases of chickenpox in Meda and Kadawata korales.

Rinderpest is prevailing in some villages in Kolonna and Kuruwiti korales.

Prices of food products are : rice, Rs. 5 to Rs. 7 per bushel ; paddy, Re. 1.50 to Rs. 2.50 per bushel ; kurakkan, Re. 1 to Rs. 2.25 per bushel ; amu, 75 cents to Re. 1 per bushel ; coconuts, Rs. 4 to Rs. 10 per 100 ; salt, 10 cents to 25 cents per measure.

KEGALLA DISTRICT.

Paddy : fields are being sown for maha cultivation ; yala prospects are good.

Dry grain : chenas have been sown, and the prospects are satisfactory.

Prices : paddy, Re. 1.50 to Rs. 2 per bushel ; el-wi, Re. 1.25 per bushel ; kurakkan, Re. 1 per bushel ; amu, 75 cents per bushel.

Rainfall : Kegalla, 11.63 inches.

Cattle disease : foot-and-mouth disease is prevailing in some parts of the district.

Health of people : normal.

Other products : (a) the flowering and prospects of coconuts good ; (b) the actual crop of coconuts for the month, 881,300 nuts.

Conditions subject to which Retail Licenses are issued.

(1) The purchaser of a license to sell opium by retail shall, immediately on his being declared by the proper authority to be the purchaser, pay in cash one-third of his bid, which sum shall be held by the proper authority as security, but cannot be used for payment of any of the instalments of the amount of the bid, except those for the last two months. He shall pay the amount of the bid in six equal monthly instalments, on the last day of every month during the currency of his rent, the first instalment to be paid on January 31, 1910, and shall pay interest at 9 per cent. per annum for every day for which an instalment is in arrear. The security money may be at the request of the purchaser placed in fixed deposit at any bank to be selected by him, and shall be at the risk of the purchaser. Should any instalment not be paid on the due date, the proper authority may re-sell the license, or so much of the term thereof as may be unexpired, at the risk of the purchaser.

(2) The store or premises hereby licensed must be fully described in the body of this license, which shall apply to the premises so described and nothing more.

(3) The premises hereby licensed shall not have internal communication with any other buildings or premises.

(4) The premises hereby licensed shall be kept clean and in good sanitary condition.

(5) It shall be the duty of the person in charge of the premises hereby licensed to open them for inspection on the demand of any person appointed an Inspector by the proper authority in writing, or of any Police Officer not below the rank of Inspector. The person in charge shall also be bound to produce all books, documents, or accounts with reference to the receipt or disposal of opium which he has in his possession, and to weigh, if especially called on to do so, in the presence of the Inspector or Police Officer, all opium in stock or on the premises at the time of the inspection; he shall also explain to the best of his ability any discrepancy that may be found to exist between the quantity of opium in stock, and the quantity which, according to the books, ought to be in stock at the time of inspection.

(6) No opium shall be consumed on the premises hereby licensed.

(7) No opium kept on the premises hereby licensed shall be adulterated or deteriorated in any way.

(8) No disorderly conduct shall be permitted on the premises hereby licensed.

(9) No opium shall be delivered on the premises hereby licensed to any person who is under the influence of liquor or opium, or who is apparently under the age of fifteen years.

(10) No opium shall be delivered on, or from, or received into, the premises hereby licensed between the hours of eight at night and six in the morning.

(11) There shall be kept on the premises hereby licensed a bound Stock Book with numbered pages. A copy of such book for the premises hereby licensed will be delivered free by the proper authority to the licensee when he takes out his license. If a new book is required it must be purchased by the licensee from the proper authority, to whom the previous book must be delivered.

(12) It shall be the duty of the licensee to see that all receipts and disposals of opium are regularly entered in the Stock Book immediately the transaction takes place, all the columns in the book being correctly filled in and the quantity in stock at the beginning and end of the day being clearly shown.

(13) It shall also be the duty of licensee to see that on or before the second of each month there is transmitted to the Inspector-General of Police a correct copy of the Stock Book and a correct copy of the book required to be kept under condition No. 20.

(14) It shall be the duty of the Inspector-General of Police to issue to the licensee a receipt for such correct copies when they have been received. In the event of the licensee not receiving such receipts within a week of his posting the correct copies, it shall be his duty to communicate with the Inspector-General of Police and ascertain whether such correct copies have been received, and if they have miscarried to supply duplicates.

(15) It shall be the duty of the licensee before he receives his license to submit to the proper authority a list giving the names of the persons whom he proposes to employ on the premises hereby licensed. Such statement shall contain the full name and description of each employé, and specify the nature of the work which he is to perform. All such persons must be over the age of twenty-one years, and the proper authority must be satisfied that they are of good character. No person whose name has not been endorsed on this license by the proper authority shall be employed by the licensee to take charge of, receive, or sell opium on his account, and the licensee shall not permit any one whose name is not so endorsed to perform any of the above duties.

(16) The licensee may from time to time apply to the proper authority to make such alterations as seem desirable in the list of persons employed; such alterations shall be endorsed on this license, and the licensee on receiving a notice from the proper authority to remove any person employed on the premises hereby licensed, shall within one week of his receiving such notice produce this license to the proper authority, so that the name of such employé may be erased from this license. Such person shall then be disqualified for employment in the premises hereby licensed.

(17) It shall be the duty of the licensee to see that a board having the number of this license, the name of the licensee, and the words "Licensed to sell Opium by Retail," legibly painted upon it, is kept affixed to some conspicuous part of the premises hereby licensed.

(18) No business or occupation except the sale of opium or cigars shall be carried on in the premises hereby licensed.

(19) No opium shall be sold except for cash paid on the spot.

(20) It shall be the duty of the licensee to make an entry in a book to be kept for that purpose, giving the full name and address of the purchaser and giving the quantity sold to him, and the date of sale, whenever opium exceeding 4 drams in weight is sold at any one time.

(21) The licensee shall keep on the premises hereby licensed and have available for use at all times a true set of scales and the following standard weights:—
