The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information:—

An Ordinance to amend "The Ceylon Post Office Ordinance, 1908."

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend "The Ceylon Post Office Ordinance, 1908," in certain particulars: Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Ceylon Post Office Amendment Ordinance, 1909," and shall be read and construed as one with "The Ceylon Post Office Ordinance, 1908," hereinafter called "the principal Ordinance."

Amendment of sub-section.

2 In line 1 of sub-section (1) of section 6 of the principal Ordinance for the word "whenever" the word "wherever" shall be substituted.

Amendment of sub-section.

3 In lines 1 and 2 of sub-section (1) (a) of section 12 of the principal Ordinance for the words "For the establishment of mail communication and the transmission of mails" the words "For the transmission by post of postal articles" shall be substituted.

Addition of new sub-section (d).

4 After sub-section (c) of section 22 of the principal Ordinance the following sub-section shall be added and shall be numbered (d):

- (d) Any circular or advertisement regarding drugs or medicines purporting to be remedies for diseases of the sexual organs or sexual stimulants.
- Amendment of section. 5 (1) In lines 3 and 4 of section 78 of the principal Ordinance for the words "the mails or any postal article in course of transmission by post" the words "any postal article in course of transmission by post or any officer of the post office or vehicle carrying mail bags or postal articles" shall be substituted.
- (2) In line 10 of section 78 of the principal Ordinance for the words "the mails" the words "any mail bag" shall be substituted.
- Amendment of sub-section. 6 In line 1 of sub-section (1) (a) of section 83 for the word "alter" the word "utter" shall be substituted.
- Amendment of section. 7 In line 3 of section 91 of the principal Ordinance for the word "mails" the words "mail bags or postal articles" shall be substituted.
- Addition of new sub-section (3) (f). 8 After sub-section (3) (e) of section 53 of the principal Ordinance the following sub-section shall be added and shall be numbered (3) (f) :
- (f) Authorize the Postmaster-General to enter into an arrangement with any Government Savings Bank authority in the United Kingdom or any British Possession or foreign country for the transfer of sums standing to the credit of depositors from such a Government Savings Bank to the Post Office Savings Bank or from the Post Office Savings Bank to such a Government Savings Bank, and prescribe conditions for such transfers.

Statement of Objects and Reasons.

THE object of this Ordinance is to introduce into "The Ceylon Post Office Ordinance, 1908," certain amendments, most of which have been suggested by the authorities of the London General Post Office.

2. The only two amendments which require notice are section 4, which strengthens the powers of the Postmaster-General as regards objectionable advertisements passing through the post, and section 8, which enables arrangements to be made for the transfer of deposits between the Ceylon Post Office Savings Bank and similar Savings Banks in the United Kingdom or in any British Possession or foreign country.

An Ordinance to amend "The Destitute Immigrants' Regulation Ordinance, 1907."

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend "The Destitute Immigrants' Regulation Ordinance, 1907" (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Ordinance"): Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Destitute Immigrants' Regulation (Amendment) Ordinance, 1909," and shall be read and construed as one with the principal Ordinance.

Amendment of section 12.

Liability of master of vessel to repay costs and charges in respect of immigrants unlawfully landed.

2 For section 12 of the principal Ordinance the following section shall be substituted, namely :

12. If any destitute immigrant lands in Ceylon contrary to the provisions of this Ordinance, the master of the vessel, British or foreign, from which such immigrant is landed shall be liable to repay to the Government of Ceylon all costs and charges incurred by the Government in behalf of such immigrant during a period of two months from the date of his landing.

Provided that such master shall incur no liability to repay the said costs and charges in respect of any destitute immigrant so landed where he proves that the destitute immigrant so landed was at the time of landing under an engagement of service or in possession of a sum of money of not less than fifty rupees.

Statement of Objects and Reasons.

THE object of the Draft Ordinance is to amend "The Destitute Immigrants' Regulation Ordinance, 1907," with respect to the provision there made for dealing with stowaways landed in the Island.

2. Under this Ordinance masters of ships are responsible for the costs and charges of maintaining destitute immigrants who have landed in contravention of the Ordinance; but this responsibility is subject to an exception as regards stowaways. If the stowaway is promptly handed over to the police, the master of the vessel is relieved from his liability to pay for the stowaway's maintenance.

3. The practical effect of this exception is that the provisions of the Ordinance, so far as they relate to stowaways, have proved almost inoperative.

4. The Draft Ordinance re-enacts section 12 of the principal Ordinance with the omission of the clause which exempts ship masters, in cases where stowaways are handed over to the police, from liability for their maintenance. The direct effect of this amendment will be that the liability of ship masters will be the same for stowaways as for other destitute immigrants.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend "The Notaries' Ordinance, 1907" (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Ordinance"): Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :

Short title.
Construction.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Notaries' (Amendment) Ordinance, 190," and shall be read and construed as one with the principal Ordinance.

Addition of proviso to section 29.

2 At the end of section 29 of the principal Ordinance there shall be added the following proviso :

Provided further that when the Registrar-General has reasonable grounds for believing that any notary has committed a breach of any of the rules and regulations in this section contained, the Registrar-General may, if he thinks fit, instead of instituting criminal proceedings against such

notary, except from him such sum of money as he may consider proper in composition of the offence. When the Registrar-General has accepted any sum of money from any notary in composition of any alleged offence—

- (a) Criminal proceedings shall not be taken, or if already taken, shall not be continued in respect of such offence; and
- (b) Such composition shall not have the effect of discharging any surety or sureties from any liability incurred under any bond executed under section 12.
