PASSED ORDINANCES.

Ordinance enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

No. 10 of 1909.

An Ordinance to amend "The Ceylon Penal Code, 1883."

HENRY MCCALLUM.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend "The Ceylon Penal Code, 1883," hereinafter called "the principal Ordinance," in certain particulars: Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Penal Code Amendment Ordinance, 1909," and shall be read and construed as one with the principal Ordinance.

Addition of a new section 101 A.

Abetment in Ceylon of offences outside it.

Addition of a new soction 256Λ .

Definition of "Government" in sections 248 to 256.

Addition of new section 220 A.

Resistance, obstruction, escape, or rescue in cases not otherwise provided for.

Addition of a new section 291 A.

Uttering words, &c., with deliberate intent to wound religious feelings.

Addition of a new section 296 A.

Persons under sixteen found guilty of murder.

Amendment of section 302.

2 The following section shall be inserted immediately after section 101 of the principal Ordinance and shall be numbered 101 A :

101 A. A person abets an offence within the meaning of this Code who in Ceylon abets the commission of any act without and beyond Ceylon which would constitute an offence if committed in Ceylon.

8 The following section shall be inserted immediately after section 256 of the principal Ordinance and shall be numbered 256 A:

256 A. In sections 248 to 256, both inclusive, the word "Government" when used in connection with, or in reference to, any stamp issued for the purpose of denoting a rate of postage shall, notwithstanding anything in section 14, be deemed to include the person or persons authorized by law to administer Executive Government in this Colony, and also in any part of His Majesty's dominions or in any foreign country.

4 The following section shall be inserted immediately after section 220 of the principal Ordinance and shall be numbered 220 A:

220 A. Whoever, in any case not provided for in section 219 or section 220 or in any other law for the time being in force, intentionally offers any resistance or illegal obstruction to the lawful apprehension of himself or of any other person, or escapes or attempts to escape from any custody in which he is lawfully detained, 'or rescues or attempts to rescue any other person from any custody in which that person is lawfully detained, shall be punished with imprisonment of either description for a term which may extend to six months, or with fine, or with both.

5 The following section shall be added immediately after section 291 of the principal Ordinance and shall be numbered 291 \triangle :

291 A. Whoever, with the deliberate intention of wounding the religious feelings of any person, utters any word or makes any sound in the hearing of that person, or makes any gesture in the sight of that person, or places any object in the sight of that person, shall be punished with imprisonment of either description for a term which may extend to one year, or with fine, or with both.

6 The following section shall be inserted after section 296 of the principal Ordinance, and shall be numbered 296 \blacktriangle :

296 A. Provided that sentence of death shall not be pronounced on or recorded against a person under the age of sixteen years, but in lieu thereof the court shall sentence such person to be detained during the Governor's pleasure.

7 In section 302 of the principal Ordinance the words "imprisonment of either description" shall be substituted for the words "simple imprisonment."

No. 11 of 1909.

An Ordinance to amend "The Ceylon Paper Currency Ordinance, 1884."

Preamble.

HENRY MCCALLUM.

WHEREAS it is expedient to abolish the "depreciation fund" created by section 18 of "The Ceylon Paper Currency Ordinance, 1884," and to amend the said Ordinance in certain other particulars : Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :

Short title.

Transfer of depreciation

fund to reserve.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Ceylon Paper Currency (Amendment) Ordinance, 1909," and shall be read and construed as one with "The Ceylon Paper Currency Ordinance, 1884," hereinafter called "the principal Ordinance."

2 From and after the commencement of this Ordinance all moneys and securities standing to the credit of the fund created by section 18 of the principal Ordinance (and therein termed a "depreciation fund") shall be transferred to and shall be deemed to have become part of the reserve in coin and securities appropriated and set apart by section 14 of the said Ordinance to provide for the satisfaction and discharge of currency notes.

Abolition of depreciation.

Addition of a new section.

Revenue from investments.

Investments under section 18 not counted for purposes of section 13. 3 From and after the said date the said "depreciation fund" shall cease to exist as a separate fund.

4 For section 18 of the principal Ordinance the following section shall be substituted :

18. All dividends, interest, or other revenue to be derived from the said investments shall be paid to such person as shall be nominated in that behalf, and the said dividends, interest, or revenue shall form part of the ordinary revenues of the Colony, excepting the sum of one per centum which shall be appropriated annually on the whole amount of such investments, and shall be paid to the trustees referred to in section 15, to be by them invested in such manner as the Governor, with the sanction of the Secretary of State, shall approve. Provided always that the Governor may, with the sanction of the said Secretary of State, direct that the annual appropriations of one per centum aforesaid shall be wholly or partially discontinued at any time, or so long as it shall appear that the reason for such annual appropriation no longer exists. Investments made in pursuance of this section shall be deemed to form part of the reserve mentioned in section 14, and shall be held and dealt with in the manner prescribed by sections 15, 16, and 17 of this Ordinance.

5 In computing the investments to be made under section 13 of the principal Ordinance, account shall not be taken of the moneys and securities transferred to the reserve by section 2 of this Ordinance, nor of the future investments under section 18 of the principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance.

An Ordinance to legalize certain acts performed by Senanayake Mudiyanselage Charles Henry Senanayake after the expiration of his appointment as Registrar under "The Amended Kandyan Marriage Ordinance, 1870," and under "The Births and Deaths Registration Ordinance, 1895."

Preamble.

W HEREAS Senanayake Mudiyanselage Charles Henry Senanayake was appointed to be a registrar under "The Amended Kandyan Marriage Ordinance, 1870," for the Three Korales and Lower Bulatgama district in the Province of Sabaragamuwa, for six months from January 5, 1908:

And whereas the said Senanayake Mudiyanselage Charles Henry Senanayake was also appointed for the period aforesaid to be a registrar under "The Births and Deaths Registration Ordinance, 1895," for the Kitulgalapalata division of the Kegalla District of the said Province of Sabaragamuwa:

And whereas the said Senanayake Mudiyanselage Charles Henry Senanayake continued to act in the offices aforesaid after the expiration of the period for which he was appointed as aforesaid; and it is expedient that the registrations and other acts performed by the said Senanayake Mundiyanselage Charles Henry Senanayake in the said offices after the expiration of the period of his appointment should be declared to be valid: Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Legalization of <u>k</u> registrations, z &c., performed after expiration of registrar's appointment. Kx

Extent of legalization.

1 All registrations, acts, and deeds made or performed, or purporting to be made or performed, by the said Senanayake Mudiyanselage Charles Henry Senanayake from July 5 to and including December 7, 1908, as registrar under "The Amended Kandyan Marriage Ordinance, 1870," for the Three Korales and Lower Bulatgama district, in the Province of Sabaragamuwa, and as registrar under "The Births and Deaths Registration Ordinance, 1895," for the Kitulgalapalata division of the Kegalla District of the said Province, are hereby declared to be as valid and effectual for all purposes as if the said Senanayake Mudiyanselage Charles Henry Senanayake, at the time when the said registrations, acts, and deeds were made and performed, had been duly appointed under the said Ordinances to act as registrar for the said district and division.

2 Nothing herein shall give any validity to the registration of any marriage, birth, or death, or to any act or deed done by the said Senanayake Mudiyanselage Charles Henry Senanayake during the said period, except so far as relates to the defect therein caused by the non-appointment of the said Senanayake Mudiyanselage Charles Henry Senanayake to act during the said period.
