Ordinance enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

No. 18 of 1909.

An Ordinance to amend "The Joint Stock Companies' Ordinance, 1861."

HENRY McCALLUM.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend "The Joint Stock Companies' Ordinance, 1861" (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Ordinance"): Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Joint Stock Companies' (Amendment) Ordinance, 1909," and the principal Ordinance and this Ordinance shall be read and construed as one Ordinance, and may be cited collectively as "The Joint Stock Companies' Ordinances, 1861 to 1909."

Amendment of section 20.

2 The following words shall be added at the end of section 20 of the principal Ordinance:

The Registrar shall, on receipt of the list and summary, make a record of the receipt thereof, and a fee of two rupees and fifty cents shall be payable in respect of such record.

Substitution of
new section 41.

Transmission of
balance sheets
to Registrar.

3 For section 41 of the principal Ordinance the following section shall be substituted :

41. A balance sheet shall be made out and forwarded to the Registrar of Joint Stock Companies within twelve months after the incorporation of the company. Thereafter a balance sheet shall be prepared and forwarded in each year to the Registrar, together with the list of shareholders and summary required by section 20 to be so forwarded. Such balance sheet shall contain a summary of the property and liabilities of the company arranged under the heads appearing in the form annexed to table C in the schedule hereto, or as near thereto as circumstances shall admit. The Registrar shall on receipt of the balance sheet make a record of the receipt thereof, and a fee of two rupees and fifty cents shall be payable in respect of such record.
