Paddy : maha paddy plants are from 3 to 4 months old, and are generally thriving.  
 Dry grain : no cultivation worth reporting.  
 Other products : the supply of vegetables was good and prices were fair, but fruit was scarce and dear.  
 The flowering and prospects of coconuts were not good. The crop for the month is reported at 9,214,236 coconuts approximately.  
 Prices of staple products : rice, Rs. 4 to Rs. 6.50 a bushel ; coconuts, Rs. 40 to Rs. 60 a thousand.  
 Rainfall : there was sufficient rain during the month.  
 Remarks on harvest prospects generally : a fairly good maha crop may be generally expected.  
 Observations on the health of the inhabitants : there were in some villages cases of malarial fever, typhoid fever, chickenpox, and dysentery, otherwise the health of the inhabitants was generally good.  
 Health of cattle : there are a few cases of rinderpest and hoof-and-mouth disease in some villages. Measures were promptly taken to prevent the diseases spreading.

##### KALUTARA DISTRICT.

Paddy : the maha cultivation is thriving well.

 Prices of staple food : rice, Rs. 13 to Rs. 15 per bag ; paddy, Rs. 2.50 per bushel ; fine grain, Rs. 2.50 per bushel.  
 Health of people : satisfactory.  
 Health of cattle : there were ten cases of rinderpest in Tunduwa in Bentota-Walallawiti korale. No fresh cases occurred since November 25.  
 Other products : crop of coconuts below the average.  
 Rainfall : 10.11 in.

## HAMBANTOTA DISTRICT.

Paddy, maha cultivation : prospects fair.  
 Other grains : chenas in West Giruwa pattu and East Giruwa pattu are doing well.  
 Weather : rainfall at Hambantota, 40 in. ; maximum temperature, 87.8° ; minimum temperature, 73.4°.  
 Health of people : fair.  
 Health of cattle : rinderpest is still prevailing in a few villages. There were 14,819 cases ; 14,008 deaths and 800 recoveries in the district up to November 30, 1909.  
 Coconut crop for the month was about 335,000 nuts.  
 Prices : Coast rice, Rs. 6 per bushel ; country rice, Rs. 5.75 per bushel ; paddy, Rs. 2 per bushel ; kurakkan, Re. 1.75 per bushel ; coconuts, Rs. 6 per 100 ; plantain bunches, Rs. 55 per 100 ; Indian corn, 75 cents per 100 ; salt, Rs. 4.48 per cwt. ; sweet potatoes, Rs. 2 per cwt. ; pumpkins Rs. 20 per 100.

## EASTERN PROVINCE.

## BATTICALOA DISTRICT.

Paddy : munmari cultivation in the plant stage ; suffers for want of rain.

Other grains and products : chena produce not available as yet. Flowering and prospects of coconut trees fair.

Public health : fever and sore-eyes prevail in some places.

Cattle disease : rinderpest has been stamped out in the Batticaloa District, but the Trincomalee District is still infected.

Paddy : Re. 1.80 per bushel.

Rainfall : 1908, 10.02 in. ; 1909, 6.06 in.

## TRINCOMALEE DISTRICT.

Rainfall : defective.

Paddy : munmari cultivation in plants.

Tobacco : nil.

Coconuts : (1) condition of crop, medium ; (2) actual crop, 170,040. Price ranges from Rs. 70 to Rs. 80 per 1,000.

Health of people : normal.

Health of cattle : rinderpest in Koddigar and Tamblegam pattus.

Prices of staple articles : paddy, Rs. 2.10 per bushel ; rice (country), Rs. 4.48 per bushel ; rice (imported), Rs. 5.60 per bushel.

## NORTH-WESTERN PROVINCE.

## KURUNEGALA DISTRICT.

Paddy, maha : in some fields crops in heen-bandi ; in some fields crops young ; ploughing and sowing in some fields ; prospects good.

Fine grain : maha crops in ears in some chenas ; crops young in some chenas ; sowing just over in some chenas ; prospects good.

Weather : twenty-three days' rain in Wannu hatpattu ; eighteen days' rain in Dambadeni hatpattu ; there had been few showers in Hiriyala hatpattu ; rainfall very good in Katugampola hatpattu ; plenty of rain in Weudawili hatpattu.

Tanks : full in Katugampola and Weudawili hatpattus ; not full in Wannu and Hiriyala hatpattus.

Prospects of coconut flowering : good.

Health of people : good.

Health of cattle : cattle murrain prevails in few villages in Hiriyala and Katugampola hatpattus.

## PUTTALAM AND CHILAW DISTRICTS.

Paddy : the young paddy plants of the maha cultivation in both the districts are thriving well.

Dry grain : the cultivation for maha is in a satisfactory condition.

Other products, including coconuts : tobacco plants are growing well. Preparations are being made for planting vegetables. Flowering and prospects of coconut bad to fair in Puttalam District and good in Chilaw District. The crop for the month in the two districts is estimated at 13,515,991. Vegetables scarce. The fishing season in the sea has commenced ; fishing up to date is not very good.

Prices of staple products : rice, Rs. 5 to Rs. 6.50 per bushel ; paddy, Rs. 2 to Rs. 2.25 per bushel ; kurakkan, Re. 1 to Rs. 2 per bushel ; cassava, 62½ cents per cwt. ; coconuts, 3 to 6 cents per nut.

Rainfall of the month : at Puttalam, 5.11 in. Rainfall in Chilaw District is very satisfactory ; satisfactory in Puttalam pattu ; fair in parts of Demala hatpattu, but the Kirimetiya pattu of Demala hatpattu has had very little rain, and tanks are empty there.

Harvest prospects generally : prospects varied ; fair on the whole.

Health of inhabitants and cattle : of inhabitants, generally good. Of cattle, rinderpest still exists in some villages near Battulu-oya. The losses have been small in the affected villages with two or three exceptions, but up to date it has proved impossible to eradicate the disease.

## NORTH-CENTRAL PROVINCE.

## ANURADHAPURA DISTRICT.

Weather : dry, but heavy dew at night and mornings are chilly.

Rainfall : the registered rainfall at Anuradhapura during the month was 2.59 in. There were a few showers of rain in the early part of the month.

Cultivation—paddy : cultivation for maha harvest has commenced in some villages. Cultivation has not commenced in other villages as the tanks are not sufficiently full. Kurakkan chenas are under growing crop. Tavalu (tank-bed) chenas have young crops.

Other products : coconut trees flowered satisfactorily. The estimated crop gathered during the month is 10,000 nuts.

Health of people : satisfactory. A few cases of measles and chickenpox were reported during the month.

Health of cattle : rinderpest still prevails in Egoda and Meda pattus of Tamankaduwa district and in a few villages in Nuwaragam palata. The epidemic in the town of Anuradhapura is dying out. Cases of hoof-and-mouth disease are reported from several villages in Hurulu and Kalagam palatas. The mortality from rinderpest in Tamankaduwa has been very high.

Village tanks : the tanks are fairly full. Some tanks have not yet a sufficient head of water for cultivation for the maha harvest.

## PROVINCE OF UVA.

## BADULLA DISTRICT.

Weather : generally wet.  
 Paddy : fields are still being ploughed for yala sowing.  
 Chenas : chenas are being sown.  
 Fruits and vegetables : a moderate supply of fruits and vegetables is available.  
 Other products : the flowering and prospects of coconuts are fair.  
 Health of people : satisfactory, except a few cases of fever, dysentery, and sore-eyes.  
 Cattle disease : rinderpest still exists in Buttala and Wellawaya divisions.  
 Prices of staple products : rice, varies from Rs. 5 to Rs. 8.40 per bushel; kurakkan, Re. 1.75 to Rs. 2 per bushel; coconuts, Rs. 6 to Rs. 10 per 100.  
 Rainfall : 5.60 in. as registered at the observatory.

## PROVINCE OF SABARAGAMUWA.

## RATNAPURA DISTRICT.

Paddy : in Kuruwiti and Nawadun korales the maha crops are three months old. In Kadawata and Meda korales maha fields are being prepared for cultivation. In Kukul korale maha crops are sown; prospects are favourable. In Nawadun korale second maha crops have been sown. In Atakalan korale pera-maha crops have been sown. In Kolonna korale the harvesting of yala crops is over.

Dry grain : in Kuruwiti, Nawadun, and Atakalan korales the maha crops are approaching maturity. In Kukul korale maha chenas are being sown. In Kuruwiti korale pera-yala chenas are being reaped and threshed; weather is unfavourable. In Atakalan, Kolonna, Kadawata, and Meda korales kurakkan have been sown. In Kuruwiti korale pera-yal crops have been reaped and threshed. In Atakalan, Kolonna, Kadawata, and Meda korales kurakkan crops have been sown, and are progressing favourably.

Other products—coconuts : in Kuruwiti korale flowering prospects are satisfactory; the crop is estimated at 40,000 nuts. In Nawadun and Atakalan korales there is no particular season for flowering; the actual crop is not ascertainable. In Kolonna korale flowering prospects are favourable; the crop is estimated at 480 nuts. In Kadawata and Meda korales flowering prospects are fair; the crop was not very satisfactory; the price is Rs. 7 to Rs. 10 per 100 nuts. In Kukul korale flowering prospects are good; crop is estimated at 200 nuts.

The health of the people generally is satisfactory. Dysentery and sore-eyes are reported to be prevailing in Kadawata and Meda korales. The health of cattle generally is good. Cattle murrain and hoof-and-mouth disease are reported to have broken out in some parts of the district.

The prices of food products are : rice, Rs. 5 to Rs. 7 per bushel; paddy, Re. 1.50 to Rs. 2.50 per bushel; kurakkan, Re. 1 to Rs. 2.50 per bushel; amu, 75 cents to Re. 1 per bushel; coconuts, Rs. 4 to Rs. 12 per 100 nuts; salt, 10 cents to 25 cents per measure.

## KEGALLA DISTRICT.

Paddy : maha prospects are good.

Dry grain : hill paddy, iringu, and amu prospects are good; kurakkan chenas have been harvested. The yield is good.

Prices : paddy, Re. 1.50 to Rs. 2 per bushel; hill paddy, Re. 1.25 per bushel; kurakkan, Re. 1 per bushel; amu, 75 cents per bushel.

Rainfall : Kegalla, 16.79 in.

Cattle disease : cattle murrain is still prevailing at Karawanella, but there are no fresh cases since November 22, 1909.

Health of people : satisfactory.

Other products : (a) the flowering and prospects of coconuts, good; (b) the actual crop for the month, 984,200 nuts.

2. Tenders will be received by the Chairman, Local Board, Anuradhapura, for the sale of the said license at the Kachcheri, Anuradhapura, at 12 noon, on Wednesday, December 22, 1909.

3. No tender will be considered unless the tenderer is present in person or by his agent duly authorized in writing at the Anuradhapura Kachcheri at 12 noon on Saturday, December 4, 1909, and is prepared to deposit one-third of the amount of his tender.

4. In the event of tenders being not satisfactory, the Chairman, Local Board, Anuradhapura, shall have the option of calling for fresh tenders, or forthwith putting up the rent for sale by public auction, or otherwise disposing of the rent in accordance with the provisions of "The Opium Ordinances, 1899 to 1905."

*Conditions subject to which Retail Licenses are issued.*

- (1) The purchaser of a license to sell opium by retail shall, immediately on his being declared by the proper authority to be the purchaser, pay in cash one-third of his bid or tender, which sum shall be held by the proper authority as security, but cannot be used for payment of any of the instalments of the amount of the bid or tender, except those for the last four months. He shall pay the amount of the bid or tender in six equal monthly instalments on the last day of every month during the currency of his rent, the first instalment to be paid on January 31, 1910, and shall pay interest at 9 per cent. per annum for every day for which an instalment is in arrear. The security money may be, at the request of the purchaser, placed in fixed deposit at any bank to be selected by him, and shall be at the risk of the purchaser. Should any instalment not be paid on the due date, the proper authority may re-sell the license, or so much of the term thereof as may be unexpired, at the risk of the purchaser.
- (2) The store or premises hereby licensed must be fully described in the body of this license, which shall apply to the premises so described and nothing more.
- (3) The premises hereby licensed shall not have internal communication with any other buildings or premises.
- (4) The premises hereby licensed shall be kept clean and in good sanitary condition.
- (5) It shall be the duty of the person in charge of the premises hereby licensed to open them for inspection on the demand of any person appointed an Inspector by the proper authority in writing, or of any Police Officer not below the rank of Inspector. The person in charge shall also be bound to produce all books, documents, or accounts with reference to the receipt or disposal of opium which he has in his possession, and to weigh, if specially called on to do so, in the presence of the Inspector or Police Officer, all opium in stock or on the premises at the time of the inspection; he shall also explain to the best of his ability any discrepancy that may be found to exist between the quantity of opium in stock and the quantity which, according to the books, ought to be in stock at the time of inspection.
- (6) No opium shall be consumed on the premises hereby licensed.
- (7) No opium kept on the premises hereby licensed shall be adulterated or deteriorated in any way.
- (8) No disorderly conduct shall be permitted on the premises hereby licensed.
- (9) No opium shall be delivered on the premises hereby licensed to any person who is under the influence of liquor or opium, or who is apparently under the age of fifteen years.
- (10) No opium shall be delivered on, or from, or received into, the premises hereby licensed between the hours of eight at night and six in the morning.
- (11) There shall be kept on the premises hereby licensed a bound Stock Book with numbered pages. A copy of such book for the premises hereby licensed will be delivered free by the proper authority to the licensee when he takes out his license. If a new book is required it must be purchased by the licensee from the proper authority, to whom the previous book must be delivered.
- (12) It shall be the duty of the licensee to see that all receipts and disposals of opium are regularly entered in the Stock Book immediately the transaction takes place, all the columns in the book being correctly filled in, and the quantity in stock at the beginning and end of the day being clearly shown.
- (13) It shall also be the duty of licensee to see that on or before the second of each month there is transmitted to the Inspector-General of Police a correct copy of the Stock Book and a correct copy of the book required to be kept under condition No. 20.
- (14) It shall be the duty of the Inspector-General of Police to issue to the licensee a receipt for such correct copies when they have been received. In the event of the licensee not receiving such receipt within a week of his posting the correct copies, it shall be his duty to communicate with the Inspector-General of Police and ascertain whether such correct copies have been received, and if they have miscarried to supply duplicates.
- (15) It shall be the duty of the licensee before he receives his license to submit to the proper authority a list giving the names of the persons whom he proposes to employ on the premises hereby licensed. Such statement shall contain the full name and description of each employé, and specify the nature of the work which he is to perform. All such persons must be over the age of twenty-one years, and the proper authority must be satisfied that they are of good character. No person whose name has not been endorsed on this license by the proper authority shall be employed by the licensee to take charge of, receive, or sell opium on his account, and the licensee shall not permit any one whose name is not so endorsed to perform any of the above duties.
- (16) The licensee may from time to time apply to the proper authority to make such alterations as seem desirable in the list of persons employed; such alterations shall be endorsed on this license, and the licensee on receiving a notice from the proper authority to remove any person employed on the premises hereby licensed shall, within one week of his receiving such notice, produce this license to the proper authority, so that the name of such employé may be erased from this license. Such person shall then be disqualified for employment in the premises hereby licensed.
- (17) It shall be the duty of the licensee to see that a board having the number of this license, the name of the licensee, and the words "Licensed to sell Opium by Retail," legibly painted upon it, is kept affixed to some conspicuous part of the premises hereby licensed.
- (18) No business or occupation except the sale of opium or cigars shall be carried on in the premises hereby licensed.
- (19) No opium shall be sold except for cash paid on the spot.

(20) It shall be the duty of the licensee to make an entry in a book to be kept for that purpose, giving the full name and address of the purchaser, and giving the quantity sold to him, and the date of sale, whenever opium exceeding 4 drams in weight is sold at any one time.

(21) The licensee shall keep on the premises hereby licensed and have available for use at all times a true set of scales and the following standard weights:—

*Avoirdupois* :  $\frac{1}{4}$  oz.,  $\frac{1}{2}$  oz., 1 oz., 2 oz., 4 oz., 8 oz., 1 lb., 2 lb., 4 lb., 7 lb.

(22) The licensee shall observe the rules hereinafter mentioned for keeping his books.
