

Order under Section 4, Sub-section (1), of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."

In the matter of the land commonly called or known as Datchagedarawatta (being a portion of lot 1 referred to in Notice No. 2,881), situate in the village of Diyapola, in the Medagam pattu korale of the Wellassa division, in the Province of Uva, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899-1900, and 1903."

WHEREAS in pursuance of section 1 of the said Ordinances it was duly declared and notified on October 25, 1907, that if no claim to the land commonly called or known as Datchagedarawatta, situate in the village of Diyapola, in the Medagam pattu korale of the Wellassa division, in the Province of Uva, containing in extent 2 acres 1 rood and 20 perches (being a portion of the lands to the extent of 231 acres 1 rood and 4 perches referred to in the said notice), and shown as lot 1b in preliminary plan No. 146 and in the annexed tracing therefrom, was made to John George Fraser, Special Officer appointed under section 28 of the said Ordinances, within the period of three months from the date specified in the said notice, such land would be deemed the property of the Crown and dealt with on account of the Crown (vide Notice No. 2,881):

And whereas (1) Pallewattage Don David Pieris Appuhamy, (2) Alutgedara Ratnayakemudiyanselage Sudu Banda, (3) Siddarta Terunnanse, (4) Diyapola Gamagedara Ratnayakemudiyanselage Banda Gamarala (for himself and on behalf of the minor 5th claimant), (5) Diyapola Gamagedara Ratnayakemudiyanselage Punchi Banda, (6) Diyapola Gamagedara Ratnayakemudiyanselage Ukku Banda, (7) Diyapola Gamagedara Ratnayakemudiyanselage Mutu Banda, (8) Patabendigedara Dissanayakemudiyanselage Mutumenika, (9) Timbirigahawattegedara Dissanayakemudiyanselage Punchirala, (10) Tanemegedara Heen Appu, (11) Gamagedara Ratnayakemudiyanselage Ganeti, (12) Gamegedara Ratnayakemudiyanselage Tambu, (13) Gamagedara Ratnayakemudiyanselage Ukku Banda, (14) Patabendigedara Dissanayakemudiyanselage Gamandi, (15) Landegedara Dissanayakemudiyanselage Appuhamy, (16) Patabendigedara Pahalawatte Tissahamy, (17) Patabendigedara Pahalawatta Appuhamy, (18) Timbirigahawattegedara Banda, (19) Andurugahawelagedara Konaramudiyanselage Appuhamy, (20) Andurugahawelagedara Konaramudiyanselage Sudu Banda, Ela-Vidane, made claim thereto, and I, John George Fraser, Special Officer appointed under section 28 of the said Ordinances, made due inquiry into such claim; and whereas the said 1st, 2nd, 5th, 7th to 20th claimants have withdrawn their claims to the said land, and whereas the said 3rd claimant having been called upon to appear before me by a notice in writing under section 4, sub-section (1), of the said Ordinances, duly served upon him to produce the evidence or documents on which he may rely in proof of his claim, did not so appear or produce such evidence or documents; and whereas I and the said 4th and 6th claimants, with consent of His Excellency the Governor, came to an agreement in writing concerning the said land, under section 4, sub-section (1), of the said Ordinances; whereby it was agreed that the said 4th and 6th claimants should be sub-section (1), or the said Ordinances, whereby it was agreed that the following the continuous should be declared the purchasers of the said land upon the payment to the Government Agent of Uva, at Badulla, of a sum of Twenty Rupess only (Rs. 20) as the purchase amount for the said land on or before July 28, 1908; and whereas the said purchase amount has been paid by the said 4th and 6th claimants, the said 4th and 6th claimants are hereby in pursuance of the agreement afore-mentioned, declared to be the purchasers of the said claimants are neredy in pursuance of the agreement that the village of Diyapola, in the Medagam pattu korale of the Wellassa division, in the Province of Uva; containing in extent 2 acres 1 rood and 20 perches, and shown as lot 1b in preliminary plan 146 and in the annexed tracing therefrom; and bounded as follows: on the north by Polgahalandehenyaya belonging to the Crown; on the east by Landegedarawatta claimed by Landegedara Appulamy and others; on the south by the road from Nannepurawa to Kongalla; and on the west by Datchagedarawatta belonging to Gamagedara Ratnayakemudiyanselage Ukku Banda.
