# FINAL ORDERS.

Order under Section 4, Sub-section (1), of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903," declaring Land to be Crown Property.



Whereas in pursuance of section 1 of the said Ordinances it was duly notified on February 7, 1908, that if no claim to the land commonly called or known as Galpothegedarawattehena, situate in the village of Hinnarangahakumbura, in the Soronatota korale of the Wiyaluwa division, in the Province of Uva, containing in extent 3 roods and 26 perches, and shown as lot 6k in preliminary plan 86 and in the annexed diagram, was made to John George Fraser, Special Officer appointed under section 28 of the said Ordinances, within the period of three months from the date specified in such notice, such land would be declared the property of Crown, and dealt with on account of the Crown (vide Notice No. 2,948):


And whereas (1) Kudugalegedara Dingiri, (2) Kitularawegedara Rankiriya, (3) Kudugalegedara Siripina Balitianna made claim thereto, and I, the aforesaid John George Fraser, Special Officer appointed under section 28 of the said Ordinances, made due inquiry into such claim; and whereas the said 2nd and 3rd claimants have withdrawn their claims to the said land, I, with the consent of His Excellency the Governor, do hereby admit the claim of the said 1st claimant to the said land, as more fully described herein below, under section 4, sub-section (1), of the said Ordinances.
