- (b) For the next six months of the year, 1910.
- (c) For the first six months of the year, 1911.

The licenses will be sold for six months only, with option of renewal for six months more at the will of the Chairman.

3. Forms of tender may be obtained at the Municipal Office, Colombo.

4. No tender will be considered unless the tenderer is present in person, or by his agent duly authorized in writing, at the Colombo Kachcheri at 12 noon on

October 14, 1909, and is prepared to deposit forthwith one-third of the amount of his tender, either in cash or by cheque marked for payment.

5. In the event of two or more tenders being for an equal amount, the Chairman shall have the option of forthwith offering the license for sale by public auction, the bidding to be restricted to the tenderers in question, or of calling for fresh tenders, or otherwise disposing of the license in accordance with the provisions of the Opium Ordinances, Nos. 5 of 1899, 14 of 1903, 4 of 1904, and 9 of 1905.

6. Every tender must contain the full name and address of the person tendering.

7. The Chairman does not bind himself to accept the highest or any tender.

8. The person whose tender or bid is accepted will become the purchaser of the license, and shall forthwith make payment of one-third of the amount of his tender or bid, and comply with the conditions.

9. For conditions see *Government Gazette* of September 10, 1909, No. 6,327, Part V.

10. Copies of conditions may be obtained on application at this office.

11. The sale of opium by retail means that the quantity to be sold at any one time to any individual, except to a licensed retail vendor, shall not exceed 180 grains.

MUNICIPALITY OF GALLE.

Minutes of Proceedings of a Meeting of the Municipal Council of Galle, held at the Municipal Office on August 14, 1909, at 2 p.m.

Present :—Mr. C. M. Lushington, Chairman; Mr. D. G. Goonewardena; Dr. E. Ludovici; Mr. F. Abey-sundara; Mr. H. F. Tomalin; Mr. A. C. Hayley; Dr. J. H. Ebell, and Mr. D. W. Subasinha.

1. The Minutes of the Meeting held on July 10, 1909, were read and confirmed.

2. Pursuant to notice, Dr. E. Ludovici asked what progress had been made with the new water supply scheme.

The Chairman replied that in accordance with the instructions received from Government the question was referred to the Provincial Engineer who states in reply that an estimate has been framed and submitted to the Director of Public Works.

Dr. E. Ludovici thereupon gave notice of the following motion for the next Meeting of Council :—

That with reference to the Hon. the Colonial Secretary's letter No. 8 of June 4, 1909, and on considering the replies received both orally and by letter from the Provincial Engineer, it is resolved that this Council do place on record its feeling of great disappointment at the loss of time which has already occurred in making a commencement with this important work.

The lands were acquired by the Government Agent on February 16 and 17, 1909, and on receipt of the Government authority to take possession of the lands the Provincial Engineer was on March 15, 1909, asked to take charge of the lands, with the buildings and plantations, &c., thereon, on the 22nd of that month.

Between April and August labour has been cheap and plentiful, and this Council hoped to have seen material progress made in the work, but apparently nothing whatever has yet been done.

The Council has already paid the cost of acquiring the land, Rs. 20,623.56, and has remitted a sum of Rs. 40,000 to the Director of Public Works and is ready to remit further sums as soon as they may be required, and every month wasted means a loss of interest on the Council's money.

Owing to deficiency of rainfall, the existing reservoir at Bikke has never once been filled since the year 1906, and at present the level of the water is very low. The consequence is that the present supply of water has been much curtailed, and the Analyst has lately reported that the water is unfit for drinking purposes.

It is therefore a matter of great urgency that the new water supply scheme be pushed on to completion with as little delay as possible.

(2) That a copy of the above resolution be forwarded to Government and to the Director of Public Works.

3. Pursuant to notice, the Chairman moved that Messrs. M. Makan Marcar and Francis Perera, who have forfeited their seats by failure to attend three consecutive General Meetings, be restored to the office of Councillors.

Mr. D. G. Goonewardene seconded.—Carried.

4. Report of Special Committee appointed on April 24, 1909, to report on a petition submitted by the Sub-Inspectors *re* insufficiency of the commission paid to them for the recovery, &c., of rates and taxes.

Resolved—That the report be adopted and that the payment of the allowances of Rs. 10 per mensem to the Sub-Inspectors of Wards Nos. 2, 3, and 5 do come into force from August 1, 1909.

(2) That in future these officers be called collectors instead of sub-inspectors.

5. Papers *re* costs incurred by the Council in connection with the appeals to the Supreme Court by a number of voters of Ward No. 5 to revise the Chairman's decision refusing to insert their names in the triennial list of voters for 1908.

Resolved—That the sum of Rs. 152.50 offered be accepted in full satisfaction of the amount due.

6. Application to build on the land called Pettawatta next to the Infectious Diseases Hospital, Dadalla.

Resolved—That the application be allowed.

7. The Chairman's Administration Report for 1908.—Mr. D. G. Goonewardene moved that the report be adopted.

Dr. E. Ludovici seconded.—Carried.

8. Papers *re* new footbridge over the Keppu-ela canal to connect the esplanade and the Victoria park. Resolved—That the Council regrets its inability to incur any expenditure in connection with the proposed footbridge, but will have no objection to the Golf Club erecting the bridge on the plan submitted or any other plan approved by the Council at their own expense, and provided it is made available for the use of the public.

(2) During the discussion on the above subject Mr. A. C. Hayley gave notice of the following motion for the next Meeting of Council :—

That the Council do raise the low-lying strip of the esplanade bordering the Keppu-ela from the wooden bridge to the bridge on the main road and places in Victoria park to such a level and in such a manner as shall prevent the crabs from coming to the surface as at present.

9. Papers *re* fees payable for encroachments, temporary erections, &c., and for inspection of premises for licenses with the Hon. the Colonial Secretary's letter No. 12/08708 of August 4, 1909, on the subject of reduction of the fee for metal quarries from Rs. 100 to Rs. 50.—Read.

10. Colonial Auditor's report for the month of April, 1909.—Laid on the table.

11. Papers *re* extension of water supply to the new Segregation Camp and Infectious Diseases Hospital at Dadalla with letter No. 1,368 dated July 5, 1909, from the Hon. the Director of Public Works stating that the probable cost of extending the water main will be Rs. 6,000.

Resolved—That the extension be approved and that the cost be provided in instalments of Rs. 3,000 each in the budgets for 1910 and 1911.

12. The Hon. the Colonial Secretary's letter No. 10 dated July 9, 1909, *re* proposed gratuity to the widow and children of the late slaughter-house keeper, K. B. Jeremias de Silva.—Read.

13. With the leave of the Council the Chairman submitted the Provincial Surgeon's letter No. 318, dated August 11, 1909, *re* the mosquito brigade.

Resolved—That the recommendations contained in Dr. Ebell's letter be approved, and that the Chairman be authorized to employ an overseer (temporarily) on a salary of Rs. 50 per mensem with an adequate staff of coolies for the work.
