RULES and REGULATIONS made by the Governor under the Ordinance No. 23 of 1891, intituled “An Ordinance to amend the Ordinance No. 16 of 1865.”

23 (a). The officers and constables of the division of police in each Province shall, as a rule, be employed in that Province; but should any emergency arise, or should it be likely that justice would be otherwise defeated or wrong suffered, police officers must, without hesitation, act outside their own Province, especially in cases connected with such Province. They shall, when so doing, take the earliest opportunity which they may find of communicating with the police officer in charge of that part of the Province into which they have gone. The fact that a police officer has acted outside his own Province shall be recorded by an entry in the Information Book of the station to which he belongs, and a copy of the entry shall be sent to the Superintendent of Police of the district into which the police officer went.

23 (b). In urgent matters connected with the detection and prevention of crime or the arrest of criminals, the police officer in charge of one station must communicate direct with the police officers in charge of other stations, whether they are in the same Province or not. Every police officer of any rank will be held responsible should there be a failure of justice owing to his want of promptitude in properly communicating with other police officers, either by telegraph or otherwise, in connection with the pursuit of a criminal or the prevention or detection of crime.

ABSTRACT OF SEASON REPORTS FOR THE MONTH ENDED SEPTEMBER 30, 1894.

WESTERN PROVINCE.

COLOMBO DISTRICT.

Owing to the continued severe drought the yala crop is generally poor, while in some divisions the greater portion of the crop is much damaged by the excessive dry weather, though it has greatly facilitated harvesting operations.

The "muttes" crop in Alutkuru kóralé south is greatly affected by the unfavourable weather.

The maha cultivations in Siyane and Héwágam kóralés have also been damaged by the drought.

No jakfruit and breadfruit are now procurable. Plantains are scarce and dear. Vegetables, such as cucumber, brinjal, snake-gourd, and sweetpotato, are in fair supply, and can be had at reasonable prices. Sugarcane is plentiful and cheap. The extensive yam cultivations in Salpiti kóralé are unfavourably affected by the dry weather.

The cocoanuts have also been adversely affected by the unfavourable weather, and prices vary from Rs. 30 to Rs. 40 a thousand nuts.

NEGOMBO DISTRICT.

Alutkúru kóralé north: the fields sown for yala are partly damaged by the drought, those that are not damaged are being reaped; and fields for maha are being prepared and sown. Vegetables are plentiful; breadfruit and plantains are scarce and dear; cocoanut crops poor, prices good.

Hápitigam kóralé: most of the fields sown for yala have been reaped and the crops threshed; crops middling; weather unfavourable during the early part of the month. Some fields cultivated for maha; crops not thriving. Some fields are being got ready for the second maha for inferior paddy. Jak and breadfruit out of season; plantains scarce and dear; mannokka and sweetpotatoes not abundant; cocoanut crops fair, prices high.

KALUTARA DISTRICT.

The yala crop was harvested all throughout the district during the month. The dry weather was very favourable for the harvesting work. The crop generally is considered fair. Preparations for the maha harvest are going on.

In the Pasdun korale vegetables are reported to be scarce; in the Rayigam korale they are cheap; and in the Totamunes they are plentiful.

The price of cocoanuts ranges from Rs. 30 to Rs. 35 a thousand.

CENTRAL PROVINCE.

KANDY DISTRICT.

Yala paddy and kurakkan ripening, and being reaped; prospects generally good to fair, except in Harispattu, where poor; maha cultivation in progress; fields dependent on rain water have suffered.

MÁTALÉ DISTRICT.

Rainfall poor in Matale south; severe drought in north and east. Maha harvest is being reaped; crop is fair where there was any cultivation in spite of drought. Matale east produced a good crop on account of rivers.

NUWARA ELIYA DISTRICT.

Kotmale: paddy plants one to three months old being weeded and transplanted; kurakkan in ear; prospects good.

Uda Hewaheta and Walapane: paddy, young plants; clearing and burning of chenas for kurakkan commenced.

NORTHERN PROVINCE.

JAFFNA DISTRICT.

Heavy rain on the 6th, 18th, 20th, and 21st; light and partial showers on the 1st, 4th, 5th, 12th, 13th, 17th, 19th, 22nd, and 24th. Sowing of paddy briskly carried on throughout district. Dry grains, varaku, kurakkan, karutta sami, and mondi also sown; plants reported to be thriving. Ellu and payaru in blossom; prospects good.

MANNAR DISTRICT.

Fencing of fields is progressing in most of the villages on the mainland. Paddy for dry soil cultivation is being sown in the maritime villages, where there was a good shower of rain in September; dry grain cultivation in Mannar island has been commenced. Rain not sufficient, and no pasture for cattle.

MULLAITTIVU DISTRICT.

Heavy rain in third week; Olumadu tank spilled; ploughing and sowing in maritime pattus and Mulliavalai; general health good.

VAVUNIYA DISTRICT.

Some rain in latter part of month; many tank beds sown with paddy, and last year's chenas with kurakkan; five deaths in Metkumulai from fever, supposed to be typhoid; fever rather prevalent.

SOUTHERN PROVINCE.

GALLE DISTRICT.

Yala, already reaped, fair. Tillings for maha have begun in all the districts.

MÁTARA DISTRICT.

Yala harvest good throughout the district, except Morawak korale, where crops were light; preparations for maha going on extensively throughout the district, except in Kandaboda pattu, where there has been a deficient rainfall.

HAMBANTOTA DISTRICT.

Second yala harvest of paddy average ; maha sowing proceeding ; chenas, chiefly private, being cleared. Cattle : hoof-and-mouth disease in different places ; pasture bad owing to unusual drought. Weather : showery towards end of month.

EASTERN PROVINCE.**BATTICALOA DISTRICT.**

Ettala and second crops on 1,000 acres are being reaped ; sowing of munmari lands is in progress ; occasional showers of rain ; water in wells still insufficient.

TRINCOMALEE DISTRICT.

Munmari cultivation at Koddiyar, Kadukulam, and Kinniyai commenced ; pinmari crop at Koddiyar and Tamblegam is being reaped and stacked ; condition of crop good.

NORTH-WESTERN PROVINCE.**KURUNÉGALA DISTRICT.**

Wanni hatpattu : slight shower on the 18th ; chena sowing ; maha has commenced ; talvalu crops partially reaped ; distress is prevalent in the Katuwanna, Pahalawisideke, and the Hatalispaha korales ; people are selling cattle in large numbers to procure food.

Hiriya hatpattu : yala crops tolerably good ; reaping proceeding ; young maha crops prospering ; a few showers of rain having fallen ; sowing for kekulam cultivation progressing ; chena area small.

Wéudawili : yala crops being reaped ; about 800 acres of paddy lands and about 100 acres of chena land sown during the month.

Dewamedi hatpattu : grain prospects are bad ; kekulam cultivation in portions of Walgampattu and Udukara korales only. No paddy sown in any other korale owing to want of rain. Ratemahatmaya reports that owing to failure of crops during the last four years great scarcity prevails, and people are leaving the district.

CHILAW DISTRICT.

Northern division : sowing elankali paddy for maha ; chenas being cleared. Central division : yala crop poor, being harvested, produce 3,884 bushels ; fine grain crop poor, harvested 1,498 bushels paddy ; 4,258 bushels sown for maha ; sowing continues. Southern division : no paddy or fine grain sown during month for want of rain ; standing crops thriving.

PUTTALAM DISTRICT.

Yala paddy matured in Demala hatpattu ; extent small ; crop middling ; nothing done to paddy cultivation in other pattus owing to want of rain ; chenas cleared in all pattus.

NORTH-CENTRAL PROVINCE.

Continued drought, but local and restricted rainfall in middle of month ; yala crops being harvested ; few tanks only have water, most are dried up.

PROVINCE OF UVA.

The average paddy crop being harvested in Udukinda, Yatikinda, Wiyaluwa, and Buttala divisions ; in Wellawayaya the harvest is a failure owing to drought ; chenas are being cleared in all the divisions, but sowing has not yet been commenced.

PROVINCE OF SABARAGAMUWA.**RATNAPURA DISTRICT.**

Paddy : yala harvest gathered in almost completely throughout the district ; crops of few fields of Kolonná Meda, and Kadawatu kóralés damaged by late drought ; sowing for maha harvest has begun ; prospects favourable. Chenas : yala crops good in Kolonná kóralé ; some withered by drought. No murrain.

KÉGALLA DISTRICT.

Paddy : yala partly harvested. Crops : Galboda and Kinigoda kóralés and Paranakuru kóralé poor owing to want of water ; Beligal kóralé middling ; Three Kóralés and Lower Bulatgama fair ; sowing for maha nearly over ; prospects fair. Hill paddy, iringu prospects : Galboda and Kinigoda kóralés and Paranakuru kóralé fair ; Beligal kóralé, Three Korales, and Lower Bulatgama good. Kurakkan : partly harvested. Crops : Galboda and Kinigoda korales and Paranakuru korale, middling ; Beligal kóralé, Three Korales, and Lower Bulatgama good. Mun harvested in Four Kóralés ; yield middling. Amu sowing in progress throughout the district. Meneri chenas being prepared for sowing in Beligal kóralé. Tana being reaped in Beligal kóralé ; crop good. Foot-and-mouth disease in parts of district.
