*E. I. Archipelago—Kleine Soenda Islands—Less Water on the Four-fathoms Reef lying about in the Middle of Komal Bay.—Lombok N. W. Coast.*

Information has been received from H. M. Ironclad Prins-Hendrik der Nederlanden, that the least depth on the Four-fathoms reef, about 150 yards long in a N.E. and S.W. direction and 40 yards broad, lying about in the middle of Komal bay, is  $1\frac{1}{4}$  fathom at low-water.

Approximate position: lat.  $8^{\circ} 23' S.$ , long.  $116^{\circ} 5' E.$

*Japan—Simonoseki Strait.—Shoals found near Kanabuse.*

The British Admiralty has given notice (No. 493 of 1894) that on a Japanese chart recently received the

*Australia, East Coast—Port Jackson.—Amended Sounding in East Channel.*
