MUNICIPAL COUNCIL NOTICES.

MUNICIPALITY OF COLOMBO.

Minutes of Proceedings of a Meeting of the Municipal Council of Colombo held in the Town Hall on Friday, September 14, 1894.

The Council met this day at 3 P.M., pursuant to notice dated September 8, 1894.

Present:—Mr. C. E. D. Pennycuik, Mayor and Chairman; Hon. Sir John J. Grinlinton, K.T.; Hon. W. R. Kynsey, C.M.G.; Major L. F. Knollys, C.M.G.; Captain F. Bayley; Hon. A. de A. Seneviratna; Mr. C. Perera; Mr. C. P. Dias; Mr. Walter Pereira; Mr. R. H. Morgan; Mr. C. M. Fernando; and Mr. A. Alwis.

The Minutes of August 10, 1894, having been printed and a copy sent to each Member of the Council, were taken as read.

Resolved,—That the Minutes of August 10, 1894, be confirmed.

1. A Statement of Receipts and Disbursements from January 1 to August 31, 1894, and Progress Reports of work done during July and August, 1894, were laid on the table.

2. Eight tenders for the lease of the Floral Hall for twelve months from October 1 next (after consideration by the Standing Committee) were laid before the Council, and a letter from the present lessee raising his offer from Rs. 750 to Rs. 1,000.

Mr. C. Perera moved "that Mr. N. Sankaralingampilley's offer of Rs. 1,500 be accepted."

Mr. C. M. Fernando seconded.—Carried.

3. A letter No. 130 of August 20, 1894, from the Hon. the Colonial Secretary, intimating that it will be necessary, in connection with the construction of the new Breakwater, to remove the public latrine near St. John's market, and connected correspondence, were laid before the Council.

Resolved,—That the offer by the Government conveyed in Colonial Secretary's letter No. 140 of September 12, 1894, of a new site for the latrine and for its construction there be accepted, and that their suggestion that the piece of land between the new latrine and Seabeach road be acquired by the Council for the improvement of the road, be adopted.

4. A letter No. 135 of August 30, 1894, from the Hon. the Colonial Secretary, requesting that the road between Rock House and the Battery be closed while certain blasting operations are in progress, was laid before the Council, with connected papers, after previous circulation.

Resolved,—That the carriage road between Rock House and the Battery be closed temporarily while blasting is going on in its immediate neighbourhood—a constable being placed at each end of the road to warn off passengers; and that the footpath used by the fishermen be closed during the hours in which it is intended to carry on blasting operations, details being arranged by the Chairman, after consultation with the Resident Engineer, Harbour Works.

5. A letter No. 123 of August 9, 1894, and a letter No. 128 of August 15, 1894, from the Hon. the Colonial Secretary, were laid before the Council, with connected papers, after circulation amongst Members, with reference to the by-laws framed by the Council on July 13, under clause 5 of Ordinance 2 of 1894.

Resolved,—That by-law No. 6 be amended so as to provide for daily instead of weekly returns.

Resolved further,—That the Council see no reason at present to alter by-law No. 3, as the keeper of a burial or cremation ground is not necessarily its owner, but that if the Government thinks otherwise, the Council will be prepared to reconsider the matter.

6. A memorandum dated August 20, 1894, from the Chairman on the subject of the Municipal fire engines, was laid before the Council, having been previously printed and circulated.

7. A letter dated August 27, 1894, from Mr. J. Forrest Brunton was laid before the Council, intimating his intention to be in Colombo on the 10th or 11th instant, in connection with the final settlement of the tramway agreement, with connected papers, after previous circulation.

Resolved,—That the concession approved by the Municipal Council on July 13, 1894, with such minor alterations as to matters of detail in clauses 5 and 7, and such amplifications of clause 22 as may be necessary to its clear understanding, as may be agreed upon between the lawyers of the Council and those of Mr. Mathews, be now signed.

The Chairman here withdrew, and Hon. W. R. Kynsey moved that Hon. Sir John J. Grinlinton do take the Chair.

Captain Bayley seconded.—Carried.

8. A letter No. 131 of August 24, 1894, from the Hon. the Colonial Secretary, was laid before the Council with reference to the question of compensation to the Chairman as a member of the Civil Service for fall in exchange after previous circulation amongst members.

Hon. Sir John J. Grinlinton moved "that the Council do go into Committee on the letter."

Mr. C. Perera seconded.—Carried.

The Council having resumed, Hon. A. de A. Seneviratna moved "that the Council regret they have not the power to grant the compensation suggested in the letter, but that they would be glad if the Governor in Executive Council would exercise the powers vested in him by the 48th clause of the Ordinance 7 of 1887 and fix the salary of the present Chairman at such rate and in such manner that he may be placed on the same footing as regards compensation, as other members of the Civil Service."

Captain Bayley seconded.—Carried unanimously.

9. The Auditor-General's remarks on the accounts for April and May, 1894, received with letters Nos. 79 and 87 of August 6 and 29, were laid on the table.

10. The City Analyst's report dated August 20, 1894, on the town water for August, 1894, was laid on the table, having been previously printed and circulated.

11. Reports of Inspectors on licensed carriages, and kerosine, poison, and gunpowder shops for September 1894, were laid on the table.

12. The report of the Sub-Committee appointed at the meeting of May 25, 1894, under clause 115 of Ordinance 7 of 1887, on the Chairman's Administration Report for 1893, was laid before the Council.

Hon. W. R. Kynsey moved "that the report be printed and circulated and considered at a future Meeting, either General or Special."

Captain Bayley seconded.—Carried.

RULES under Section 23 of Ordinance No. 9 of 1893 for the management of the Public Slaughter-house established at Nuwara Eliya.

1. No cattle shall be slaughtered at the slaughter-house unless the same shall have been previously exposed to public view at the Local Board pound erected at the slaughter-house for a period of twenty-four hours immediately preceding the time of slaughter.

2. It shall be lawful for the Inspector of the Local Board to seize or cause to be seized all unhealthy and diseased animals so exposed, and to have the same destroyed or otherwise disposed of upon the authority of the Chairman of the Local Board or of the Medical Officer, or, in their absence, of two members of the Board.

3. No animal shall be slaughtered at the slaughter-house except between the hours of 7 A.M. and 10 A.M.

4. Before 4.30 P.M. on each day the persons who have used the slaughter-house on that day shall thoroughly cleanse the slaughter-house and premises, and shall deposit all blood, refuse, and offal in such place at or near the slaughter-house premises as may be appointed by the Local Board. The said blood, refuse, and offal to be at the disposal of and for the Local Board. These duties shall be carried out according to the directions of the Inspector of the Local Board or other officer placed by the Local Board in charge of the slaughter-house.

5. The Local Board shall have the power to give such orders as they may think fit to the person in charge of the slaughter-house for the due carrying out of these rules.

6. The following fees shall be recoverable by the Local Board for the use of the slaughter-house and exposing shed:—

For permit to slaughter cattle, each animal ...	Rs.	c.
