THE following by-laws made by the Government Agent, Central Province, under section 1 of Ordinance No. 25 of 1901, with a view to prevent rabies and cruelty to dogs in the villages referred to in Proclamation dated December 9, 1909, are hereby published for general information.

BY-LAWS REFERRED TO.

1. A registration fee of twenty-five cents per annum shall be paid upon each dog kept within the limits of the villages referred to in Proclamation dated December 9, 1909.
2. Such registration fee shall be due on and after July 1 and shall be paid in advance before August 1 in each year.
3. To facilitate the recovery of such registration fee, the occupier of every house within these villages shall, on or before June 1 in each year, furnish to an officer authorized by the Government Agent to demand the same a list (in the form in schedule annexed) of dog or dogs kept in such house and the names of the owners thereof.
4. Every dog within the limits of these villages shall at all times wear a collar stamped with a number by the Government Agent. On payment of the registration fee on any dog the Government Agent shall, unless the owner provides his own collar to be stamped, furnish the owner with a stamped collar to be worn by such dog on payment of a fee of twenty-five cents.
5. Every inhabitant within the limits of these villages becoming possessed of any dog or dogs after the furnishing of the list referred to in by-law No. 3 shall furnish the officer appointed by the Government Agent mentioned in the said by-law with an additional list of such dog or dogs within one month after acquiring the same, and the owner of such dog or dogs shall become liable to the registration fee for the current year within fifteen days after the list required by this by-law becomes due.
6. It shall be lawful for the officer appointed by the Government Agent to require the production of any dog for which registration is applied for, and to decline to issue a certificate of registration until it is produced.
7. It shall be lawful for the Government Agent to refuse to issue a certificate of registration or to cancel a certificate already issued for any dog which, in his opinion, is unwell or diseased as to be unfit to live, or which is habitually ill-treated or continually neglected by its owner.

8. The owner of every dog for which a certificate has been refused or cancelled shall, on being noticed to do so, produce the dog at the house of the officer appointed by the Government Agent at a time to be stated in the notice and deliver it to the said officer, and every such dog may be destroyed or otherwise disposed of as the Government Agent shall think fit.

BY-LAWS REFERRED TO.

1. A registration fee of twenty-five cents per annum shall be paid upon each dog kept within the said villages.
2. Such registration fee shall be due on and after March 31, 1910, and shall be paid in advance before June 1 in each year.
3. To facilitate the recovery of such registration fee, the occupier of every house within the said villages shall, on or before June 1 in each year, furnish to an officer authorized by the Government Agent, Ratnapura, to demand the same a list in the form in schedule annexed of the dog or dogs kept in such house and the names of the owners thereof.
4. On payment of the registration fee on any dog the Government Agent shall, unless the owner provides his own collar to be stamped, furnish the owner with a stamped collar to be worn by such dog on payment of a fee of twenty-five cents.
5. Every inhabitant within the said villages becoming possessed of any dog or dogs after the furnishing of the list referred to in by-law 3 shall furnish the officer appointed by the Government Agent mentioned in the said by-law with an additional list of such dog or dogs which shall become liable to the registration fee for the current year within fifteen days after the list required by this by-law becomes due.
6. It shall be lawful for the officer appointed by the Government Agent to require the production of any dog for which registration is applied for, and to decline to issue a certificate of registration until it is produced.
7. It shall be lawful for the Government Agent to refuse to issue a certificate of registration or to cancel a certificate already issued for any dog which, in his opinion, is so maimed or diseased as to be unfit to live, or which is habitually ill-treated or continually neglected by its owner.

8. The owner of every dog for which a certificate has been refused or cancelled shall, on being noticed to do so, produce the dog at the house of the officer appointed by the Government Agent at a time to be stated in the notice and deliver it to the said officer, and every such dog may be destroyed or otherwise disposed of as the Government Agent shall think fit.

9. It shall be lawful for the officer appointed by the Government Agent to seize all stray dogs and deal with them in terms of sub-sections (1) and (2) of section 10 of the Ordinance No. 25 of 1901.

The person whose tender is accepted by the Government will be required to bear the expenses of having the security bond prepared for the due performance of the contract, which bond will be subject to the approval of the Attorney-General, but may be drawn by the tenderer's own lawyers, the name or stamp of whom should be affixed to the document.

Every alteration should bear the initials of the tenderer, and all tenders containing alterations not

bearing the tenderers' initials will be treated as informal and rejected.

Before tender forms are supplied to persons wishing to tender, they will have to satisfy the General Manager or person delegated by him that they are in a position to execute the contract in a satisfactory manner, and for this purpose they must be prepared to produce documentary or other evidence if called for.

VITAL STATISTICS.

Registrar-General's Weekly Health Report of the City of Colombo for the Week ended January 1, 1910.

Births.—The total births registered in the city of Colombo in the week were 79 (3 Europeans, 8 Burghers, 39 Sinhalese, 8 Tamils, 15 Moors, 4 Malays, and 2 Others). The birth-rate per 1,000 per annum (calculated on the estimated population on July 1, 1909, viz., 183,872) was 22·4, as against 20·1 in the preceding week, 24·1 in the corresponding week of last year, and 25·5 the weekly average for last year.

Deaths.—The total deaths registered were 153 (3 Europeans, 7 Burghers, 82 Sinhalese, 36 Tamils, 18 Moors, 4 Malays, and 3 Others), including the death of a town resident who died in the Enteric Hospital at Kanatta. The death-rate per 1,000 per annum was 43·4, as against 35·7 in the previous week, 40·9 in the corresponding week of last year, and 36·5 the weekly average for last year.

Infantile Deaths.—Of the 153 total deaths, 47 were of infants under one year of age, as against 38 in the preceding week, 33 in the corresponding week of the previous year, and 31 the average for last year.

Still Births.—The number of still births registered during the week was 4.

Selected Causes of Death.—Sixteen deaths were registered from *Pneumonia* (against 12 in the previous week, which was also the weekly average for last year), of which 4 were in Maradana hospitals, 3 in Maradana (exclusive of hospitals), 2 each in New Bazaar and Slave Island, and 1 each in Pettah, San Sebastian, St. Paul's, Kotahena, and Kollupitiya. Seven deaths were registered from *Bronchitis*.

2. Eleven deaths were registered from *Phthisis* (against 13 in the previous week and the weekly average for last year), of which 4 were in Maradana (exclusive of hospitals), 2 each in St. Paul's and New Bazaar, and 1 each in Pettah, Maradana hospitals, and Kollupitiya.

3. As many as nineteen deaths were registered from *Enteritis* (including 8 infants), 16 from *Debility* (12 infants), 14 from *Infantile Convulsions*, 8 *Diarrhoea* (1 infant), 7 *Dysentery* (1 infant), 5 *Worms*, 5 *Old Age*, and 43 from *Other Causes*.

4. Two deaths were registered from *Enteric Fever* (against 5 in the previous week and 8 the weekly average for last year), 1 each in New Bazaar and Maradana (exclusive of hospitals). Eight cases of *Enteric Fever* were reported, against 13 in the previous week.

5. Six cases of *Chickenpox* were reported, against 14 in the previous week; and 11 of *Measles*, against 3 in the previous week.

State of the Weather.—The mean temperature of air was 78·9°, against 79·4° in the preceding week and 78·5° in the corresponding week of the previous year. The mean atmospheric pressure was 29·968 in., against 30·003 in. in the preceding week and 29·884 in. in the corresponding week of the previous year. The total rainfall in the week was 0·02 in., against 0·35 in. in the preceding week, and 0·13 in. in the corresponding week of the previous year.
