# DRAFT ORDINANCES.

# MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information:—

An Ordinance to amend in certain particulars "The Destitute Immigrants' Regulation Ordinance, 1907."

Preamble. .

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend in certain particulars "The Destitute Immigrants' Regulation Ordinance, 1907" (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Ordinance"): Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Short title.

- 1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Destitute Immigrants' Regulation (Amendment) Ordinance, 191," and shall be read and construed as one with the principal Ordinance.
- Substitution of new section 6.
- Punishment of stowaways.
- 2 For section 6 of the principal Ordinance the following section shall be substituted:
  - 6. (1) Any person arriving at any port or place in Ceylon on board any British or foreign sea-going vessel who, by secreting himself on board or getting or remaining on board without the consent of either the owner, consignee, or master, or of a mate, or of the person in charge of the vessel or of any

other person entitled to give that consent, has obtained a passage without having paid for the same, shall be deemed to be a stowaway and shall on summary conviction be liable to imprisonment of either description for any term not exceeding six months.

(2) Where any person has been convicted under this section, it shall be the duty of the Police Magistrate, on being satisfied that a passage has been provided for the convict in accordance with section 12, and that the vessel wherein such passage has been provided is ready to proceed to sea, to order the convict to be taken from jail and conducted in custody aboard such vessel.

Substitut on of new proviso to section 12.

3 For the proviso to section 12 of the principal Ordinance the following proviso shall be substituted:

#### Provided that-

- (a) The master of such vessel shall incur no liability to repay the said costs and charges if he proves that the destitute immigrant so landed was at the time of landing under an engagement of service or in possession of a sum of money of not less than fifty rupees.
- (b) Where the destitute immigrant came on board as a stowaway, and the master, owner, agent, or charterer of the vessel is willing to provide him with a passage to some place where he can be lawfully landed, the master, owner, agent, or charterer shall not be liable under this section to pay any costs and charges in respect of such immigrant after he has been placed on board the vessel by which such passage has been provided.

#### Statement of Objects and Reasons.

- The Destitute Immigrants' Regulation Ordinance, 1907," by section 12 (a), relieved shipowners and masters from responsibility as regards stowaways in cases where stowaways are promptly handed over to the police.
- 2. This exemption having enabled stowaways to be landed in Ceylon without liability for their maintenance on the part of the owners of the vessels by which they were imported, a Bill was introduced in 1909 which provided for the repeal of section 12 (a). The Bill was not proceeded with, in view of the possibility of dealing with the question in a manner which would be more acceptable to the shipping interest.
- 3. The present Bill proposes (1) to discourage stowaways from coming into Ceylon by increasing the penalty to which they are liable from one month to six months, (2) to enable the master or agent of the vessel by which a stowaway is imported to free himself from liability for the stowaway maintenance by providing him with a passage to some place where he can be lawfully landed, and (3) to empower Police Magistrates to place convicted stowaways on board vessels by which their passage from the Colony has been provided.
