ABSTRACTS OF SEASON REPORTS,

SEASON REPORTS FOR THE MONTH OF JANUARY, 1910.

WESTERN PROVINCE.

COLOMBO DISTRICT.

Paddy: the maha harvest has opened, and preparation is being made for yala cultivation in some villages.

Dry grain: no cultivation worth reporting.

Other products: the supply of vegetables was good and prices were fair, but fruit was scarce and dear.

The flowering and prospects of coconuts were not good during the month. The crop for the month is reported at 8,607,389 coconuts approximately.

Prices of staple products: rice, Rs. 4 to Rs. 6.50 a bushel; coconuts, Rs. 45 to Rs. 70 a thousand.

Rainfall: there was no rain during the month.

Remarks on harvest prospects generally: a fairly good maha crop may be generally expected.

Observations on the health of the inhabitants: there were in some villages cases of malarial fever, typhoid fever, dysentery, and chickenpox, otherwise the health of the inhabitants was generally good.

Health of cattle: with the exception of a few cases of rinderpest and of hoof-and-mouth disease, the health of cattle was generally good.

KALUTARA DISTRICT.

Paddy: the maha plants are now in ear, and preparations are being made for the yala cultivation.

Dry grain: no cultivation worth reporting.

Other products: (a) vegetables and fruits were scarce during the month, but there was a limited supply of jak and breadfruit, especially in the totamunes; (b) there was no change noticeable in the flowering of coconuts, but what effect the few showers of rain which fell during the month will have cannot be predicted; (c) the crop of coconuts for the month is estimated at 1,928,500 nuts.

Prices of staple products: rice, Rs. 4.25 to Rs. 7 per bushel; coconuts, Rs. 40 to Rs. 80 per thousand.

Remarks on harvest prospects: generally fair.

Rainfall at Kalutara: total 4.40 in.; mean, .14 in.

Health of people: satisfactory. There were only a few cases of dysentery, contagious fever, and chickenpox.

Health of cattle: rinderpest still exists in some parts of the district in spite of vigorous measures adopted to stamp it out. It is hoped that before long the disease will totally disappear from the district.

CENTRAL PROVINCE.

KANDY DISTRICT.

Paddy, maha: paddy in crop. Yala: nil.

Dry grain, maha: hill paddy and amu in crop. Yala: chenas are being cleared for kurakkan cultivation.

Rainfall: sufficient in Pata Hewaheta and Udapalata; insufficient in other divisions.

Prospects of coconut crop: flowering fair. Estimated produce for the month of January, 1910: Udunuwara, 607,200; Yatinuwara, 11,000; Tumpane, 16,000; Harispattu, 900; Uda Dumbara, 1,400; Pata Hewaheta, 6,900; Udapalata, 800.

Prices of staple articles: paddy, Rs. 2 per bushel; kurakkan, Re. 1.50 per bushel; rice, Rs. 5.50 per bushel; salt, Rs. 3 per bushel; coconuts, Rs. 5.50 per 100.

Health of people: good. There were a few cases of measles and chickenpox in Udapalata.

Health of cattle: foot-and-mouth disease prevailed in Tumpane, Harispattu, and Uda Dumbara, and a case of rinderpest reported from New Peacock estate in Pussellawa.

NUWARA ELIYA DISTRICT.

Paddy, maha cultivation: fields ploughing and sowing are being carried on.

Dry grain, chena cultivation: some are earing, others are ripening.

Health of population: good.

Health of cattle: hoof-and-mouth disease is prevailing in some villages of Uda Hewaheta and Walapane.

Prices of staple articles: paddy, Rs. 2 and Rs. 2.50 per bushel; kurakkan, Re. 1.50 to Rs. 2.50 per bushel; Indian corn, Rs. 3 per bushel; rice (Coast), Rs. 5 to Rs. 7.50 per bushel; rice (country), Rs. 5 to Rs. 5.50 per bushel; coconuts, Rs. 8 to Rs. 10 per 100.

MATALE DISTRICT.

Rainfall: 4.92 in.

Paddy: yala fields in bud and in ear promising.

Dry grain: kurakkan plants are ripening.

Coconut: (a) flowering promising; (b) 111,800 nuts approximate crop.

Tanks in Matale North are dry.

Health of people: good.

Health of cattle: good.

Prices: moderate.

NORTHERN PROVINCE.

JAFFNA DISTRICT.

Paddy: harvest begun; crops poor.

Dry grain: varagu and payaru harvest begun; crops moderate.

Other products—coconuts: condition of flowers and nuts moderate. Palmyras: condition of trees good.

Tobacco: transplanting in progress.

Direction of wind: mainly from the north-east.

Harvest prospects: poor.

Health of people: normal.

Health of cattle: good.

MANNAR DISTRICT.

Rainfall: 2.44 in. Maximum temperature, 86.9°; minimum temperature, 70.0°. Direction of wind: north-east.

Health of people: the usual malarial fever prevailed.

Health of cattle: satisfactory.

Agriculture: paddy in various stages of growth. The early sowings are being reaped. Large areas of cultivation have been abandoned for want of water to mature the crop.

Coconuts: condition of trees and nuts good.

Tobacco: in plant.

Dry grains: the crops have been reaped, but the yield has been much diminished by the poor rainfall.

Palmyras: conditions of spathes fair.

Prices of food stuffs: rice, Rs. 5 per bushel; paddy, Re. 1.75 per bushel; coconuts, Rs. 6.50 per 100.

MULLATTIVU DISTRICT.

Prospects of paddy crop : kalapokam crop fair in the Maritime pattus and portions of Melpattu East, bad in other parts of the district. There is little or no water in most of the village tanks in Vavuniya North and South.

Dry grains : the cultivation in the Maritime pattus is partly ripe and ready to be gathered, and partly in ears. In the other parts of the district no dry grain is cultivated.

Other products—coconut : the trees are thriving well, and the crop for the month is estimated to be 83,500 nuts.

Paddy : the paddy plants of the maha cultivation are in blossom in some places and earing in others.

Dry grain : maha crops are being gathered in Puttalam District. No harvest is expected in Chilaw District owing to drought.

Other products, including coconut : tobacco plants are growing well. Flowering and prospects of coconuts bad to fair in Puttalam District and good in Chilaw District. The crop for the month in the two districts is estimated at 13,633,800 nuts.

Prices of staple products : rice, Rs. 5.50 to Rs. 6.50 per bushel ; paddy, Rs. 2 per bushel ; kurakkan, Re 1 to Rs. 2.50 per bushel ; mun, Re. 1 to Rs. 4 per bushel ; cassava, 62 cents per cwt. ; coconuts, $4\frac{1}{2}$ to 7 cents per nut.

Rainfall of the month : at Puttalam, 1.50 in. ; in Pitigal Korale Central, .22 in. There was no rain in the other places.

Harvest prospects generally : prospects varied. Fair in Chilaw District, and unsatisfactory in the Puttalam District.

Health of inhabitants and cattle : fever is prevailing in some villages of the two districts. There is rinderpest in Pitigal Korale North, Pitigal Korale South, and Puttalam pattu.

NORTH-CENTRAL PROVINCE.

ANURADHAPURA DISTRICT.

Weather : dry.

Rainfall : the registered rainfall at Anuradhapura during the month was 2.62 in.

Cultivation, paddy : cultivation for the meda harvest has started in some, villages where the tanks hold sufficient water for the purpose. Kurakkan chenas : the crops on kurakkan chenas are reaching maturity. In some villages the crops have already been reaped. Tavalu chenas : the crops on tavalu chenas are reported to be dying for want of rain.

Other products : the coconut trees did not flower satisfactorily during the month. The estimated crop gathered during the month is 10,000 nuts.

Health of people : satisfactory.

Health of cattle : fair. Hoof-and-mouth disease is prevailing in Kalagam tulana in Kiralowa korale, and rinderpest is prevailing at Tirappane in Ulagalle korale and in Mutugalle tulane in Tamankaduwa.

Village tanks : the tanks are half to quarter full, but in some villages almost dry.

PROVINCE OF UVA.

BADULLA DISTRICT.

Weather : generally wet.

Paddy : ploughing operations for maha harvest are over.

Chenas : crops are being gathered.

Fruits and vegetables : a moderate supply of fruits and vegetables is available.

Other products : the flowering and the prospects of coconuts are fair.

Health of people : satisfactory, although there were a few cases of fever, sore-eyes, and dysentery.

Health of cattle : there were 11 cases of rinderpest at Egalle in Buttala division, all of which proved fatal.

Hoof-and-mouth disease is existing in all the Chief Headmen's divisions, save Bintenna.

Prices of staple products : rice varies from Rs. 5.50 to 8.40 per bushel ; kurakkan, varies from Re. 1.75 to Rs. 2 per bushel ; coconuts, varies from Rs. 6 to Rs. 10 per 100 nuts.

Rainfall : 10.33 in. as registered at the observatory.

PROVINCE OF SABARAGAMUWA.

RATNAPURA DISTRICT.

Paddy : the maha crops in Kuruwiti and Nawadun korales are ripening ; in Kadawata, Meda, and Kukul korales they are two months old. In Kuruwiti korale muttetu crops are young. In Nawadun korale second maha crops are three months old, and in Atakalan korale peramaha crops are blossoming and in some parts ripening. In Atakalan and Kolonna korales yala fields are being prepared for sowing.

Dry grain : in Kuruwiti, Nawadun, and Kolonna korales the maha chenas are being reaped and harvested. In Kukul korale maha chenas are still young, and crops on owitas a month old. In Kuruwiti korale owitas are being prepared for sowing, and in Nawadun korale crops on owitas are ripening and being reaped. In Atakalan korale el-wi crops are ripening. In Kandawel and Tambagam pattus of Atakalan korale kurakkan crops are ripening. In Kadawata and Meda korales kurakkan crops are in flower.

Other products, coconuts : in Kuruwiti korale flowering prospects are not satisfactory, the crop is estimated at 30,000 nuts. In Nawadun and Atakalan korales there is no particular season for flowering, the actual crop is not ascertainable. In Kolonna korale flowering prospects are somewhat favourable, the crop is estimated at 480 nuts. In Kadawata and Meda korales flowering prospects are fair. In Kukul korale flowering prospects are good, crop is estimated at 250 nuts.

The health of the people is satisfactory. Cattle enjoy immunity from murrain. Hoof-and-mouth disease prevail in some parts of the district.

Prices of food products are : rice, Rs. 5 to Rs. 6.75 per bushel ; paddy, Rs. 2 to Rs. 2.50 per bushel ; kurakkan, Re. 1 to Rs. 2.50 per bushel ; amu, 60 cents to Re. 1 per bushel ; coconuts, Rs. 5 to Rs. 12 per 100 nuts ; salt, 10 to 25 cents per measure.
