Order under Section 4, Sub-section (1), of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903," declaring Lands to be Crown Property.

In the matter of the lands commonly called or known as Nagollekele, Nagollehenyaya, &c., situate in the village of Timbiriya, in the Medagam pattu korale of the Wellassa division, in the Province of Uva, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances, 1897, 1899, 1900, 1903."

Whereas in pursuance of section 1 of the said Ordinances it was duly notified on February 7, 1908, that if no claim to the lands commonly called or known as Nagollekele, Nagollehenyaya, &c., situate in the village of Timbiriya, in the Medagam pattu korale, in the Wellassa division, in the Province of Uva, containing in extent 620 acres and 38 perches, and shown as lots 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 6e, 6f, 6h, 9, 10, 11, 25, 32, 37, 39, 40, 41, 42, 43, 44, 33a, 33b, 6k, 6l in preliminary plan 167, and in the annexed diagram, was made to John George Fraser, Special Officer appointed under section 28 of the said Ordinances, within the period of three months from the date specified in such notice, such lands would be declared the property of the Crown, and dealt with on account of the Crown (vide Notice No. 2,949):


