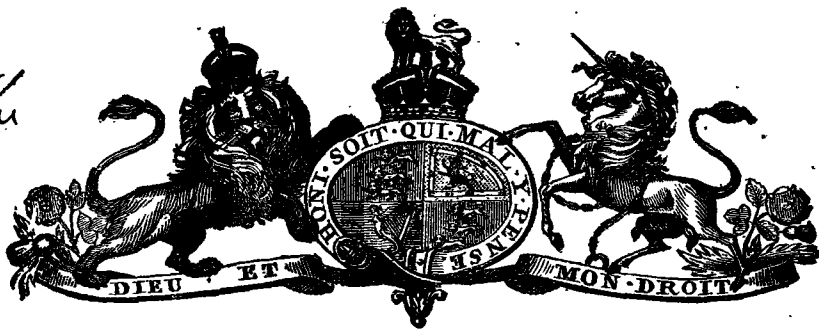

## PROCLAMATIONS BY THE GOVERNOR.

IN the Name of His Majesty EDWARD THE SEVENTH, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland and of the British Dominions beyond the Seas, King, Defender of the Faith.

### PROCLAMATION.

By His Excellency Sir HENRY EDWARD MCCALLUM, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Island of Ceylon, with the Dependencies thereof.  
 HENRY MCCALLUM.

WHEREAS by section 28 of "The Courts Ordinance, 1889," it is amongst other things enacted that Criminal Sessions of the Supreme Court shall be holden by one of the Judges thereof, or by a Commissioner of Assize duly appointed under the provisions of the said Ordinance, for each of the Circuits into which the Island is divided for the hearing, trying, and determining all prosecutions which shall be commenced against any person for or in respect of any crime or offence or alleged crime or offence:

For the Southern Circuit, twice at least in each year at Galle, and such other places in such Circuit as the Governor, after previous consultation with the Judges, shall appoint; such Sessions commencing at Galle on April 25 and on September 15 in every year:

And whereas it appears to Us expedient to order that a Criminal Session of the Supreme Court shall be holden, on the day hereinafter mentioned, at Tangalla, a place included within the said Southern Circuit:

Now therefore know Ye that We, the Governor, for sufficient reasons to Us appearing, and after previous consultation with the Judges of the Supreme Court, do order and appoint that a Criminal Session of the Supreme Court shall be holden at Tangalla, in the said Southern Circuit, on or about Monday, May 9, 1910.

Given at Nuwara Eliya, in the said Island of Ceylon, this Second day of April, in the year of our Lord One thousand Nine hundred and Ten.

### SCHEDULE.

By substituting for rule 285 the following rule :—

The penal stage shall last two months. Prisoners in the penal stage shall be employed within the prison walls at stone breaking or coconut husk beating. They shall be allowed to write one letter within one month of admission on making application to the Jailer for that purpose. They shall receive penal diet for the period passed in the penal stage, and shall be entitled to promotion to Class IV. on completing two months in the penal stage.

(2) By substituting the word "ten" for the word "nine" in the penultimate line of rule 286.

## VITAL STATISTICS.

### Registrar-General's Weekly Health Report of the City of Colombo for the Week ended April 2, 1910.

*Births.*—The total births registered were 87 (1 European, 6 Burghers, 54 Sinhalese, 10 Tamils, 11 Moors, 4 Malays, and 1 Other). The birth-rate per 1,000 per annum (calculated on the estimated population on January 1, 1910, viz., 185,704) was 24·4, as against 20·5 in the preceding week, 25·8 in the corresponding week of last year, and 25·1 the weekly average for last year.

*Deaths.*—The total deaths registered were 86 (0 Europeans, 6 Burghers, 37 Sinhalese, 25 Tamils, 11 Moors, 6 Malays, and 1 Other), including two deaths of town residents who died in the Enteric hospital at Kanatta. The death-rate per 1,000 per annum was 24·1, as against 21·9 in the previous week, 27·8 in the corresponding week of last year, and 33·7 the weekly average for last year.

*Infantile Deaths.*—Of the 86 total deaths, 22 were of infants under one year of age, as against 21 in the preceding week, 27 in the corresponding week of the previous year, and the average for last year.

*Still Births.*—The number of still births registered during the week was 3.

*Selected Causes of Death.*—Ten deaths were registered from *Pneumonia* (against 12 in the previous week and 15 the weekly average for last year), of which 2 each were in Kotahena, Maradana hospitals, and Kollupitiya, and 1 each in San Sebastian, St. Paul's, Maradana (exclusive of hospitals), and Slave Island. Five deaths were registered from *Bronchitis*.

2. Seven deaths were registered from *Phthisis* (against 9 in the previous week and 15 the weekly average for last year), of which 2 each were in San Sebastian and Maradana (exclusive of hospitals), and 1 each in Kotahena, New Bazaar, and Maradana hospitals.

3. Six deaths were registered from *Enteritis* (including 1 infant), 5 from *Debility* (4 infants), 4 *Infantile Convulsions*, 4 *Tetanus* (3 infants), 4 *Dysentery*, 4 *Diarrhoea* (1 infant), 4 *Old Age*, and 30 from *Other Causes*.

4. Three deaths were registered from *Enteric Fever* (against 6 in the previous week and the weekly average for last year), 2 in Kollupitiya and 1 in Pettah. There were 12 cases reported during the week, against 10 in the previous week.

5. Two cases of *Measles* were reported, against 3 in the previous week; and 76 of *Chickenpox*, against 27 in the previous week.

*State of the Weather.*—The mean temperature of air was 81·2°, against 81·5° in the preceding week, and 82·6° in the corresponding week of the previous year. The mean atmospheric pressure was 29·902 in. against 29·942 in. in the preceding week and 29·929 in. in the corresponding week of the previous year. The total rainfall in the week was 2·66 in., against nil in the preceding week and 1·96 in. in the corresponding week of the previous year.
