SEASON REPORTS FOR THE MONTH OF MARCH, 1910.

WESTERN PROVINCE.

COLOMBO DISTRICT.

Paddy : preparations are being made for yala cultivation.

Dry grain : no cultivation worth reporting.

Other products : the supply of vegetables was fair and prices were reasonable ; but fruit was scarce and dear. The flowering and the general prospects of coconuts were not satisfactory during the month. The crop for the month is reported at 9,733,830 coconuts, approximately.

Prices of staple products : rice, Rs. 4 to Rs. 5.50 a bushel ; coconuts, Rs. 45 to Rs. 68 a thousand.

Rainfall : there was no rain during the month.

Remarks on harvest prospects generally : the dry weather has to some extent hindered preparations for the yala.

Observations on the health of the inhabitants : there were in some villages cases of chickenpox and dysentery ; otherwise the health of the inhabitants was generally good.

Health of cattle : with the exception of four cases of rinderpest in two villages and of a few cases of hoof-and-mouth disease in one village, the health of cattle was generally good.

KALUTARA DISTRICT.

Paddy : the harvesting of the maha crops was brought to an end during the month, and cultivation for the yala commenced.

Dry grain : nothing worth reporting.

Other products : (a) vegetables and fruits were scarce, but there was a fair supply of jak and breadfruit ; (b) the flowering of coconuts was poor owing to the drought that prevailed during the last few months. The crop of coconuts for the month is estimated at 1,746,000 nuts.
