SEASON REPORTS FOR THE MONTH OF APRIL, 1910.

WESTERN PROVINCE.

COLOMBO DISTRICT.

Paddy: the yala paddy plants are thriving fairly.

Dry grain: no cultivation worth reporting.

Other products: the supply of vegetables was fair, and prices were reasonable; but fruit was scarce and dear. The flowering and the general prospects of coconuts were not satisfactory during the month. The crop for the month is reported at 6,235,420 coconuts approximately.

Prices of staple products: rice, Rs. 4 to Rs. 6 a bushel; coconuts, Rs. 50 to Rs. 70 a thousand.

Rainfall: there were a few showers of rain during the month.

Remarks on harvest prospects generally: a good yala harvest may be generally expected.

Observations on the health of the inhabitants: there were in some villages chickenpox and fever; otherwise the health of the inhabitants was generally good.

Health of cattle: with the exception of a few cases of rinderpest and hoof-and-mouth disease, the health of the cattle was generally good.

Weather : no rain, except few showers in Wannī, Katugampola, and Dambadeni hatpattus.

Health of people : fair.

Health of cattle : fair, except a few cases of cattle murrain in northern divisions of Katugampola hatpattu.

PUTTALAM AND CHILAW DISTRICTS.

Paddy : maha crop is being harvested.

Dry grain : maha crops have been reaped, and chenas are being cleared for yala cultivation.

Other products, including coconuts : tobacco has been cured. Flowering and prospects of coconut are fair to good in Chilaw District and bad to fair in Puttalam District. The estimated crop for the month in the two districts is 11,703,916 nuts.

Prices of staple products : rice, Rs. 4 to Rs. 6 per bushel ; paddy, Re. 1·50 to Rs. 2 per bushel ; dry grain, Re. 1 to Rs. 2 per bushel ; cassava, Re. 1·25 per cwt. ; coconut, 4 cents to 8 cents per nut.

Rainfall of the month : at Puttalam 5·29 in., in Pitigal Korale Central and Chilaw District 10·62 in.

Harvest prospects generally : fair in Puttalam District and good in Chilaw District.

Health of inhabitants and cattle—of inhabitants : generally fair. There were a few cases of chickenpox and measles in Chilaw District. Usual parangi in Dewamedī hatpattu. Of cattle : rinderpest still exists in a few villages.

NORTH-CENTRAL PROVINCE.

ANURADHAPURA DISTRICT

Weather : the early part of the month was dry and the latter part wet.

Rainfall : the registered rainfall at Anuradhapura was 4·80 in. during the month. Rainfall was unequally distributed throughout the Province. There was sufficient rain in some parts of the Province, whilst there was no rain in other parts.

Cultivation : paddy cultivation is in progress under those tanks where there is sufficient water for the purpose. The crops on tavalu chenas are reaching maturity. Gingelly chenas have young crops.

Other products : coconut trees flowered satisfactorily during the month. The estimated crop gathered was 8,000 nuts.

Health of people : satisfactory.

Health of cattle : rinderpest is prevailing among cattle in a few villages in Kalpe, Kunchuttu, and Mahapotana korales of Hurulu palata and in Nuwaragam korale of Nuwaragam palata and Negampaha korale of Kalagam palata. The epidemic is subsiding. A few cases of hoof-and-mouth disease were also reported during the month.

Village tanks : some tanks have a sufficient supply of water, but many have only a very small supply, not sufficient for cultivation purposes.

PROVINCE OF UVA.

BADULLA DISTRICT.

Weather : dry with occasional showers.

Paddy : sowing for maha harvest is over.

Chenas : crops have been gathered.

Fruits and vegetables : a moderate supply of fruits and vegetables is available.

Other products : the flowering and prospects of coconut are fair.

Health : satisfactory, although there were a few cases of fever and chickenpox.

Health of cattle : There were 46 cases of rinderpest in Buttala and Wellawaya divisions. Hoof-and-mouth disease still exists in the divisions of Yatikinda, Wiyaluwa, and Buttala.

Price of staple products : rice, varies from Rs. 5·50 to Rs. 8·40 per bushel ; kurakkan, Re. 1 to Re. 1·50 per bushel ; coconut, Rs. 4 to Rs. 10 per 100 nuts.

Rainfall : 7·37 in. as registered at the observatory.

PROVINCE OF SABARAGAMUWA.

RATNAPURA DISTRICT.

Paddy : the operations for sowing yala fields throughout the district are carried on, except in Kadawata and Meda korales, where owing to want of rain the fields have been abandoned. In Kuruwiti korale mutteha crops are ripening, prospects are favourable. In Nawadun korale the second maha crops have been gathered.

Fine grain : in Kuruwiti korale perayala chenas are being sown. In Kuruwiti, Nawadun, and Atakalan korales yala chenas are being cleared, and in Kukul korale yala chenas are being sown. The weather is favourable for sowing operations. In Kuruwiti korale owiti lands have been sown. In Kadawata and Meda korales chenas for peramaha have been cleared.

Other products, coconuts : in Kuruwiti korale flowering prospects are poor ; the crop is estimated at 30,000 nuts. In Nawadun and Atakalan there is no particular season for flowering, and the crop cannot be ascertained. In Kolonna korale the flowering prospects are somewhat favourable, and the crop is estimated at 425 nuts. In Kadawata and Meda korales coconut crop was not satisfactory ; weather is unfavourable. In Kukul korale flowering prospects are good, the crop is estimated at 250 nuts.

The health of the people throughout the district is satisfactory. Cattle are free from disease, except in Kolonna korale, where hoof-and-mouth disease prevail. There has not been much rain throughout the district.

The prices of food products are : rice, Rs. 4.50 to Rs. 6 per bushel ; paddy, Rs. 2 to Rs. 2.50 per bushel ; kurakkan, Re. 1 to Rs. 2.50 per bushel ; amu, 60 cents to Re. 1 per bushel ; coconuts, Rs. 5 to Rs. 12 per 100 ; salt, 10 cents to 25 cents per measure.

KEGALLA DISTRICT.

Paddy : fields are being ploughed and some have already been sown for the yala season.

Dry grain : chenas are being cleared.

Prices : paddy, Re. 1.50 to Rs. 2 per bushel ; hill paddy, Re. 1.25 per bushel ; kurakkan, Re. 1 per bushel ; amu, 75 cents per bushel.

Rainfall : Kegalla, 6.71 in.

Health of people : fever and chickenpox are prevailing in some parts of the district.

Cattle disease : foot-and-mouth disease is still prevailing in Dehigampal korale.

Other products : (a) the flowering and prospects of coconuts good ; (b) the actual crop for the month 985,800 nuts.
