ABSTRACTS OF SEASON REPORTS.

SEASON REPORTS FOR THE MONTH OF MAY, 1910.

WESTERN PROVINCE.

Colombo District.

Paddy: sowing for yala has almost completed. The paddy plants in some fields look promising at present.

Dry grain: no cultivation worth reporting.

Other products: the supply of vegetables and fruit was good, and prices were fair. The flowering and prospects of coconuts were good. The crop for the month is reported at 7,110,999 ecconuts, approximately.

Prices of staple products: rice, Rs. 4 to Rs. 6 a bushel; coconuts, Rs. 50 to Rs. 70 a thousand.

Rainfall: the rainfall during the month was a good deal below the average.

Remarks on harvest prospects generally: a good yala harvest may be generally expected.

Observations on the health of the inhabitants: there were in some villages cases of chickenpox, dysentery, malarial fever, and one case of smallpox, otherwise the health of the inhabitants was generally good.

Health of cattle: with the exception of some cases of rinderpest and of hoof-and-mouth disease in some villages, the health of cattle was generally good.

KALUTARA DISTRICT.

Paddy: the yala cultivation suffered from the recent drought.

Dry grain: only a very small extent has been sown with kurakkan, and the plants are not thriving.

Other products: the supply of vegetables and fruits has been fair. There was a large supply of jak. (2) The flowering of coconuts was slow and uncertain. (3) The crop of coconuts is estimated at 2,503,600.

Prices of staple products: rice, Rs. 4 to Rs. 6 per bushel; coconuts, Rs. 60 to Rs. 70 per thousand nuts.

Remarks on harvest prospects generally: the yala crop is likely to be very poor. Rainfall at Kalutara: total, 8:43 in.; mean, '27 in.

Health of people: generally good.

Health of cattle: good.

CENTRAL PROVINCE.

KANDY DISTRICT.

Paddy, yala: transplanting in progress. Dry grain, yala,: kurakkan being sown.

Rainfall: insufficient.

7. Prospect of coconut crop: flowering fair. Estimated produce for the month of May, 1910: Yatinuwara, 9,000; Tumpane, 16,000; Harispattu, 800; Uda Dumbara, 1,150. In other divisions crop not ascertainable.

Prices of staple articles: paddy, Rs. 2 per bushel; kurakkan, Re. 1.50 per bushel; rice, Rs. 5 per bushel; salt, Rs. 3 per bushel; coconuts, Rs. 6 per 100.

Health of people: good.

Health of cattle: good.

NUWARA ELIYA DISTRICT.

Paddy, maha cultivation: some are ripening, others are being reaped. In Uda Hewaheta crops are failing owing to the drought.

Dry grains: no chena cultivation. Health of population: good. In Uda Hewaheta there are some cases of chickenpox in Gannewa and Pallegampaha korales, and cholera at Seaton estate.

Health of cattle: good. There are a few cases of hoof disease in Walapane and Kotmale. The outbreak is not of

a serious type.

Prices of staple articles: paddy, Rs. 2 per bushel; kurakkan, Re. 1.50 to Rs. 2 per bushel; Indian corn, Rs. 2 per bushel; rice (country), Rs. 5 to Rs. 5.50 per bushel; rice (Coast), Rs. 5 to Rs. 7.50 per bushel; coconuts, Rs. 8.50 to Rs. 9.50 per 100 nuts.

MATALE DISTRICT.

Rainfall: 3.59 inches.

(6) No opium shall be consumed on the premises hereby licensed.

(7) No opium kept on the premises hereby licensed shall be adulterated or deteriorated in any way.

(8) No disorderly conduct shall be permitted on the premises hereby licensed.

(9) No opium shall be delivered on the premises hereby licensed to any person who is under the influence of liquor or opium, or who is apparently under the age of fifteen years.

(10) The quantity to be sold at any one time to any individual, except to the licensed retail vendor, shall not exceed 180 grains.

(11) No opium shall be delivered on, or from, or received into, the premises hereby licensed between the hours of eight at night and six in the morning.

(12) There shall be kept on the premises hereby licensed a bound Stock Book with numbered pages. A copy of such book for the premises hereby licensed will be delivered free by the proper authority to the licensee when he takes out his license. If a new book is required it must be purchased by the licensee from the proper authority, to whom the previous book must be delivered.

(13) It shall be the duty of the licensee to see that all receipts and disposals of opium are regularly entered in the Stock Book immediately the transaction takes place, all the columns in the book being correctly filled in and the quantity in stock at the beginning and end of the day being clearly shown.

(14) It shall also be the duty of the licensee to see that on or before the second of each month there is transmitted

to the Inspector-General of Police a correct copy of the Stock Book.

(15) It shall be the duty of the Inspector-General of Police to issue to the licensee a receipt for such correct copy when it has been received. In the event of the licensee not receiving such receipt within a week of his posting the correct copy, it shall be his duty to communicate with the Inspector-General of Police and ascertain whether such correct copy, has been received, and if it has miscarried to supply a duplicate.
