WESTERN PROVINCE.

COLOMBO DISTRICT.

Paddy : sowing for yala has almost completed. The paddy plants in some fields look promising at present.
 Dry grain : no cultivation worth reporting.
 Other products : the supply of vegetables and fruit was good, and prices were fair. The flowering and prospects of coconuts were good. The crop for the month is reported at 7,110,999 coconuts, approximately.
 Prices of staple products : rice, Rs. 4 to Rs. 6 a bushel ; coconuts, Rs. 50 to Rs. 70 a thousand.
 Rainfall : the rainfall during the month was a good deal below the average.
 Remarks on harvest prospects generally : a good yala harvest may be generally expected.
 Observations on the health of the inhabitants : there were in some villages cases of chickenpox, dysentery, malarial fever, and one case of smallpox, otherwise the health of the inhabitants was generally good.

PUTTALAM AND CHILAW DISTRICTS.

Paddy : cultivation for the yala has commenced.

Dry grain : there was no chena cultivation in the districts, except in the Demala hatpattu and portion of Pitigal Korale North.

Other products, including coconuts : the tobacco crop has been gathered : prices good. Fruits are plentiful in Pitigal Korale South. Flowering and prospects of coconut are fair in Puttalam District, and good in Chilaw District. The estimated crop for the month in the two districts is 19,296,393.

Prices of staple products : rice, Rs. 4 to Rs. 6.50 per bushel ; paddy, Re. 1.50 to Rs. 2 per bushel ; dry grain, Re. 1 to Rs. 2 per bushel ; mun, Rs. 4 per bushel ; cassava, Re. 1.25 per cwt. ; coconut, 6 to 10 cents per nut.

Rainfall of the month : at Puttalam, 59 in. ; in the Chilaw District there were two slight showers.

Harvest prospects generally : bad in Puttalam District, and fair in Chilaw District.

Health of inhabitants and cattle—of inhabitants : generally fair. There were a few cases of chickenpox in the Chilaw District. Usual parangi in the Demala hatpattu. Of cattle : rinderpest still exists in some villages.

NORTH-CENTRAL PROVINCE.

ANURADHAPURA DISTRICT.

Weather : the early part of the month was wet and the latter part dry.

Rainfall : the registered rainfall at Anuradhapura during the month was 4.21 in. Rainfall was unequally distributed throughout the Province, and it rained only during the early part of the month. There was no rain in Tamankaduwa district, save a slight shower on the last day of the month.

Cultivation : paddy cultivation is in progress under those tanks where there is sufficient water for the purpose. The crops on the gingelly chenas in Kalagam palata are reported to be dying.

Other products : coconut trees flowered satisfactorily during the month. The estimated crop gathered was 15,000 nuts.

Health of people : satisfactory. Stray cases of fever and a few cases of chickenpox were reported from Tamankaduwa district.

Health of cattle : rinderpest is prevailing among cattle at Kebitigollewa in Kunchuttu korale and at Parangiya-wadiya in Mahapotana korale and at Galkulama and Madatugama on the Central road, and in a few villages in Nogaampaha, Nuwaragam, and Kanadara korales. Tamankaduwa district is free from disease now.

Village tanks : many tanks have not sufficient water for cultivation purposes.

PROVINCE OF UVA.

BADULLA DISTRICT.

Weather : dry with occasional showers.

Paddy : sowing for maha harvest is over, except in Hambegamuwa in Wellawaya, where the fields have not yet been ploughed owing to insufficiency of water in the tank.

Chenas : crops have been gathered.

Fruits and vegetables : a moderate supply of fruits and vegetables is available, except in Bintenna and Wellawaya, where they are scarce and dear.

Other products : the flowering and prospects of the coconut are fair.

Rainfall : 3.54 in. as registered at the observatory.

PROVINCE OF SABARAGAMUWA.

RATNAPURA DISTRICT.

Paddy : yala cultivation proceeding ; prospects are unfavourable owing to drought. In Kuruwiti korale mutteleh crop has been reaped ; returns are favourable.

Dry grain : in Kuruwiti korale perayala crops are flowering ; maha chenas have been cleared, and owita crops are young. In Nawadun korale yala chenas are sown ; weather is not favourable. In Atakalan korale yala chenas are being cleared for cultivation. In Kukul korale yala chenas are about a month old. In Kukul, Kadawata, and Meda korales peramaha crops are sown ; prospects are unfavourable owing to drought.

Other products—coconuts : in Kuruwiti korale prospects good. In Nawadun and Atakalan korales crops not known. In Kolonna korale prospects are favourable. In Kadawata and Meda korales prospects not satisfactory : price 10 to 12 cents a nut. In Kukul korale prospects good.

(1) The purchaser of a license to sell opium by retail shall, immediately on his being declared by the proper authority to be the purchaser, pay in cash one-third of his bid, which sum shall be held by the proper authority as security, but cannot be used for payment of any of the instalments of the amount of the bid, except those for the last four months. He shall pay the amount of the bid in twelve equal monthly instalments on the last day of every month during the currency of his rent, the first instalment to be paid on January 31, 1910, and shall pay interest at 9 per cent. per annum for every day for which an instalment is in arrear. (7) No opium kept on the premises hereby licensed shall be adulterated or deteriorated in any way.

(8) No disorderly conduct shall be permitted on the premises hereby licensed.

If a new book is required it must be purchased by the licensee from the proper authority, to whom the previous book must be delivered.

(13) It shall be the duty of the licensee to see that all receipts and disposals of opium are regularly entered in the Stock Book immediately the transaction takes place, all the columns in the book being correctly filled in and the quantity in stock at the beginning and end of the day being clearly shown.

(14) It shall also be the duty of the licensee to see that on or before the second of each month there is transmitted to the Inspector-General of Police a correct copy of the Stock Book.

(15) It shall be the duty of the Inspector-General of Police to issue to the licensee a receipt for such correct copy when it has been received. In the event of the licensee not receiving such receipt within a week of his posting the correct copy, it shall be his duty to communicate with the Inspector-General of Police and ascertain whether such correct copy has been received, and if it has miscarried to supply a duplicate.
