MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information:—

An Ordinance to amend "The Estate Roads Ordinance, 1902."

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend "The Estate Roads Ordinance, 1902" (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Ordinance"): Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Estate Roads (Amendment) Ordinance, 1910," and the principal Ordinance and this Ordinance and the Ordinance amending the principal Ordinance shall be read and construed as one, and may be cited collectively as "The Estate Roads Ordinances, 1902 and 1910."

Substitution of a new section.

2 For section 39 of the principal Ordinance there shall be substituted the following section:

Bridges and roads may be brought under the provisions of this Ordinance.

39. (1) The Governor in Executive Council may by Proclamation extend the application of this Ordinance or of any specified provisions thereof to the construction, maintenance, and improvement, or to the maintenance and improvement only, of any road or bridge to which this Ordinance would not, but for such Proclamation, be applicable.

(2) Nothing in this Ordinance shall be held to preclude the Governor in Executive Council from extending the application of this Ordinance to the maintenance and improvement of roads and bridges which have previously

been maintained or partially maintained by means of money or labour provided by any District Road Committee or Village Committee, or to the construction, maintenance, and improvement of roads or bridges which connect, or will, when completed, connect two principal thoroughfares.

(3) Every road towards the construction or repair of which any money shall be issued from the Colonial Treasury under the authority of this Ordinance shall be deemed and taken to be a public thoroughfare to all intents and purposes.

Addition of
further proviso
to section 24.

3 The following further proviso shall be added to section 24 of the principal Ordinance :

Provided further, that when the Provincial Committee is satisfied that a portion of any estate not being less than one quarter of its total area is unfit for cultivation, such portion shall not be taken into account in assessing the contribution towards the cost of repairs and improvements to which such estate is liable under this section.

Statement of Objects and Reasons.

THE main object of this Ordinance is to give the Governor in Executive Council power to extend its provisions to roads and bridges other than those to which it now applies, and to make it clear that such provisions may be extended to even roads and bridges now maintained, wholly or partially, by District Road Committees and Village Committees and to roads and bridges connecting principal thoroughfares.

2. It is also provided that roads for the construction or repair of which money is issued from the Colonial Treasury under the authority of the Ordinance should be deemed to be public thoroughfares, and that where a portion of an estate not less than a quarter of its total area is unfit for cultivation, such portion should not be taken into account in assessing the contribution towards the cost of repairs and improvements to which the estate would be liable under the Ordinance.
