ABSTRACTS OF SEASON REPORTS.

SEASON REPORTS FOR THE MONTH OF JUNE, 1910.

WESTERN PROVINCE.

COLOMBO DISTRICT.

Paddy : yala cultivations are in fair condition generally. Ploughing for maha has begun in some villages.

Dry grain : no cultivation worth reporting.

Other products : the supply of vegetables and fruit was good and prices were fair. The flowering and prospects of coconuts were good. The crop for the month is reported at 8,715,617 coconuts approximately.

Prices of staple products : rice, from Rs. 4 to Rs. 6 a bushel ; coconuts, Rs. 50 to Rs. 65 a thousand.

Rainfall : the rainfall during the month, though sufficient for the purposes of cultivation, was below the average.

Remarks on harvest prospects generally : a good yala harvest may be generally expected.

Observations on the health of the inhabitants : there were in some villages cases of chickenpox, dysentery, malarial fever, otherwise the health of the inhabitants was generally good.

Health of cattle : with the exception of some cases of rinderpest and hoof-and-mouth disease in some villages, the health of the cattle was generally good.

KALUTARA DISTRICT.

Paddy : the yala cultivation which had suffered from the drought is doing fairly well.

Dry grain : nothing worth reporting.

Other products : (a) the supply of vegetables and fruits was limited, except jak and mangoes, the latter being unusually plentiful ; (b) there was nothing special noticeable in the flowering of coconuts. The crop of coconuts for the month is estimated to be 3,184,000.

Prices of staple products : rice, Rs. 4 to Rs. 7 per bushel ; coconuts, Rs. 50 to Rs. 75 per thousand.

Remarks on harvest prospects generally : no opinion can be expressed for the present.

Rainfall at Kalutara : total, 8'62 in. ; mean, '29 in.

Health of people : satisfactory.

Health of cattle : rinderpest broke out at Pahala Karannagoda in Pasdun Korale East, and 46 head of cattle have so far been attacked. The strictest precautions have been adopted from the outset.
