ABSTRACTS OF SEASON REPORTS.

SEASON REPORTS FOR THE MONTH OF JULY, 1910.

WESTERN PROVINCE.

COLOMBO DISTRICT.

Paddy : yala plants are thriving well. Sowing for maha has commenced in some villages.

Dry grain : no cultivation worth reporting.

Other products : the supply of vegetables and fruits was scarce. The flowering and prospects of coconuts were good. The crop for the month is reported at 7,110,999 coconuts approximately.

Prices of staple products : rice, Rs. 4 to Rs. 6 a bushel ; coconuts, Rs. 40 to Rs. 60 a thousand.

Rainfall : the rainfall during the month was sufficient for the purposes of cultivation.

Remarks on harvest prospects generally : a good yala harvest may be generally expected.

Observations on the health of the inhabitants : there were in some villages cases of chickenpox, dysentery, malarial fever, and a few cases of enteric fever, otherwise the health of the inhabitants was generally good.

Health of cattle : with the exception of a few cases of rinderpest and of hoof-and-mouth disease in some villages, the health of the cattle was generally good.

KALUTARA DISTRICT.

Paddy : the paddy plants of the yala cultivation are now in ear in some places.

Dry grain : nothing worth reporting.

Other products : (a) the supply of vegetables and fruits was very poor, except breadfruit, of which there was a good supply ; (b) there was no change noticeable in the flowering of coconuts during the month. What effect the July rains will have on the next flowering cannot be said at present. The estimated crop of coconuts for the month is 2,692,000.

Prices of staple products : rice, Rs. 4.25 to Rs. 7 per bushel ; coconuts, Rs. 50 to Rs. 75 per thousand nuts.

Remarks on harvest prospects generally : a good harvest cannot be expected as the plants have not come up well, owing to deficiency of water at the time of sowing.

Rainfall at Kalutara : total, 8.83 in.; mean, .28 in.

Health of people : good. There were only a few cases of contagious fever, chickenpox, and dysentery during the month.

Health of cattle : there were a few cases of rinderpest and hoof-and-mouth disease in Pasdun Korale East, and a few cases of hoof-and-mouth disease in the totamunes. The district is now entirely free from cattle disease.

CENTRAL PROVINCE.

KANDY DISTRICT.

Maha : ploughing in progress. Yala : transplanting in progress.

Dry grain, maha : sowing in progress.

Rainfall : insufficient.

Prospect of coconut crop : flowering fair.

Rainfall : there were few good showers in Katugampola hatpattu, five days' rain in Dambadeni hatpattu, nine days' rain in Wannī hatpattu. Only a few small showers in Hiriyala, Dewamedī, and Weudawīli hatpattus.

Tanks : many tanks are dried up.

PUTTALAM AND CHILAW DISTRICT.

Paddy : the yala collection has commenced. The drought has in some parts of the district affected the plants.

Dry grains : the crops have failed owing to drought.

Other products, including coconuts : the blossoming of hemp in Pitigal Korale South is over, and a fair crop is expected. Galas are being manured for tobacco cultivation. Flowering and prospects of coconuts are not satisfactory owing to drought. The estimated crop for the month in the two districts is 11,817,530.

Prices of staple products : rice, Rs. 4·50 to Rs. 6 per bushel ; paddy, Re. 1·75 to Rs. 2 per bushel ; mun, Rs. 4 per bushel ; kurakkan, Re. 1·25 to Rs. 2 per bushel ; cassava, Re. 1·25 per cwt. ; coconuts, 5 to 8 cents per nut.

Rainfall during the month : rainfall of the Puttalam District is 3·02 in. There were some slight showers of rain in the Chilaw District.

Harvest prospects : bad in Puttalam District ; fair in Chilaw District.

Health of inhabitants : fever and sore-eyes are prevalent in the two districts. Usual parangi in Demala hatpattu.

Health of cattle : rinderpest still exists in Pitigal Korale North and Pitigal Korale Central in Chilaw District, and Demala hatpattu and Kalpitiya in the Puttalam District.

NORTH-CENTRAL PROVINCE.

ANURADHAPURA DISTRICT.

Weather : several thunderstorms occurred during the month, which caused the rainfall to be above the average.

Rainfall : the registered rainfall at Anuradhapura during the month was 8·19 in. There have been a few showers in all the divisions of the Province.

Cultivation, paddy : there has been very little cultivation in Nuwaragam palata, and the few fields sown are ripening. In Kalagam palata some fields are being harvested. There is no cultivation in Hurulu palata. In Taman-kaduwa fields are being reaped under Minneriya, and crops have been reaped in other parts. Gingelly crops have been threshed in Nuwaragam palata.

Other products : coconut trees did not flower satisfactorily. The estimated crop gathered is about 30,500 nuts.

Health of people : satisfactory.

Health of cattle : rinderpest is prevailing in some villages of Nuwaragam palata, in Ulagalla and Matombuwa korales in Hurulu palata, in several villages in Kalagam palata, and in Anuradhapura town.

Village tanks : many tanks have not sufficient water for cultivation purposes.

PROVINCE OF UVA.

BADULLA DISTRICT.

Weather : dry and windy, with occasional showers.

Paddy : early sown paddy fields are being reaped and threshed.

Chenas : chenas are being cleared in some divisions.

Fruits and vegetables : a moderate supply is available.

Other products : flowering and prospects of the coconut are fair.

Health of people : satisfactory, except for a few cases of fever and sore-eyes.

Cattle disease : eight cases of rinderpest were reported from Madipallammulla in Wellassa division, out of these seven proved fatal.

Other products, coconuts : in Kuruwiti korale flowering prospects are good ; crop is estimated at 35,000 nuts. In Nawadun and Atakalan korales there is no season for flowering, and the actual crop is not ascertainable. In Kolonna korale flowering prospects are not good owing to drought ; crop is estimated at 420 nuts. In Kadawata and Meda korales coconut crop was not satisfactory owing to dry weather. In Kukul korale flowering prospects are good ; crop is estimated at 200 nuts.

Health of people generally is not satisfactory owing to fever prevailing in the district.

Cattle enjoy immunity from murrain.

Rainfall : satisfactory, except in Kolonna korale.
