Order under Section 4, Sub-section (1), of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897. 1899, 1900, and 1903," declaring Land to be Crown Property.

In the matter of the land commonly called or known as Waraketiyaudumulla or Horamandiyahena, situate in the village of Akurugoda, in the Weligam korale of the Matara District, in the Southern Province, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."


