Transfer diets may, in the discretion of the Superintendent, be issued instead of the diets of their class to all prisoners in the course of transfer by land from one prison to another. Provided that transfer diet shall not be issued to any prisoner for a longer period than fifty-four hours.

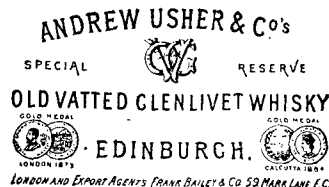

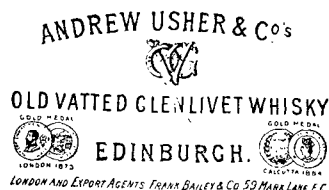

THE CEYLON MEDICAL COLLEGE.

THE Twenty-third Session (1893-94) of the Ceylon Medical College will commence on Tuesday, May 2 next.

Cambridge Junior Local Examinations: the certificate must include Latin, Mathematics, and one of the optional subjects (Greek, French, German, Logie). *Senior Local Examinations*: the certificate must include Latin and Mathematics.

University of Calcutta, Entrance Examination: the certificate must include Latin.

University of Madras, First Examination in Arts: the certificate must include Latin.

University of London, Matriculation Examination.

(3) Every person desirous of being registered as a Medical Student shall apply to the Principal of the Ceylon Medical College, and shall produce a certificate of general education recognised by the General Medical Council of Great Britain, and shall pay a matriculation fee of Rs. 10-50.

Danno-ura Lighthouse—East Entrance of Shimonoseki Straits.

Notice is hereby given that on and after April 1, 1893, a fixed white light with a green sector will be exhibited from a hexagonal wooden tower erected at Maida, north side of the east entrance to Shimonoseki straits, Province of Nagato, and that the lighthouse will be called Danno-ura lighthouse.

The light will be visible through an arc of 173 degrees 44 minutes between the bearings of N. 52° 40' E. and S. 46° 20' W. The green sector will extend from S. 36° 10' W. to S. 36° 20' W., and will cover the fairway course leading clear of the shoal in Moji bay. The bearings are true, and as observed from the lighthouse.

The light in line with Kanabuse beacon (fixed white) light will indicate the fairway between west Nakanosu (red) buoy and Tobigasu (black and red) buoy.

The tower is painted with red and white horizontal bands, and is 44 ft. high from the base to the centre of the lantern.
