PROCLAMATIONS BY THE LIEUTENANT-GOVERNOR.

IN the Name of Her Majesty VICTORIA, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland Queen, Defender of the Faith.

PROCLAMATION.

By His Excellency Sir EDWARD NOEL WALKER, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Lieutenant-Governor of the Island of Ceylon, with the Dependencies thereof.

E. NOEL WALKER.

WHEREAS by the 19th section of the Ordinance No. 10 of 1885 it is enacted that whenever the following events have occurred, namely:—

- The period under section 7 for preferring claims has elapsed, and all claims (if any) within such period have been disposed of by the Forest Settlement Officer; and
- If such claims have been made, the periods fixed for appealing from the orders passed on such claims have elapsed, and all appeals (if any) presented within such periods have been disposed of by the Supreme Court; and
- All lands (if any) to be included in the proposed forest which may be acquired under section 13 have become vested in the Crown—

the Governor shall, by Proclamation to be published in the *Government Gazette*, specify the limits of the forest which it is intended to reserve, and declare the same to be reserved from a date fixed by such Proclamation:

And whereas all things necessary for declaring the forest hereunder mentioned to be a reserved forest have been fulfilled, and all times herein before recited have elapsed, and it is expedient to specify the limits of such forest:

Now know all Men that We, the said Lieutenant-Governor, do by this Our Proclamation proclaim the forest, the limits of which are set forth in the schedule hereto subjoined, to be a reserved forest as from and after the 1st June, 1893 :

And We do hereby further specify the limits of the said reserved forest to be those set forth in the said schedule, nevertheless—

- (i.) To the public the right to use the three-foot footpath running from east to west and north-west through lot 9,586 and along the northern boundary of lots 9,589 and 9,590, described in preliminary plan 4,265.
- (ii.) The three-foot footpath running from east to west through the northern corner of lot 9,592, described in preliminary plan 4,265.
- (iii.) The three-foot footpath running from north-east to south-west through the north-western portion of lot 9,585, described in preliminary plan 4,265.
- (iv.) The three-foot footpath running from east to south-west between lots 9,595 and 9,596, and thence through the latter lot to the boundary of Kukulú kóralé, described in preliminary plan 4,265.

Given at Nuwara Eliya, in the Island of Ceylon, this Eighth day of May, in the year of our Lord One thousand Eight hundred and Ninety-three.

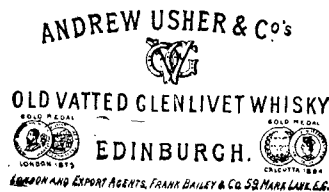

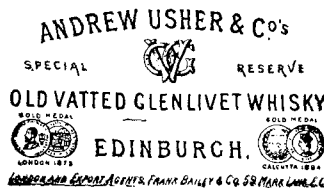

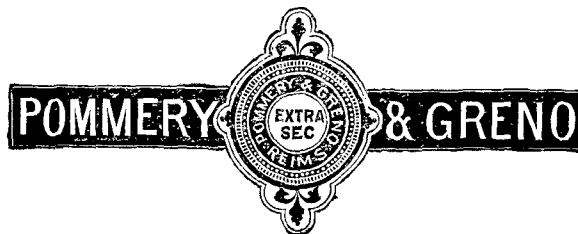

MUNICIPAL COUNCIL NOTICES.

**Minutes of Proceedings of a Meeting of the Municipal Council of Kandy held in the Kacheheri
on Thursday, March 9, 1893, at 3.30 o'clock p.m.**

Present:—Hon. P. A. Templer, Chairman; J. B. Siebel, Esq.; J. H. Sproule, Esq.; E. Beven, Esq.; F. van Langenberg, Esq.

1. The Minutes of Proceedings of the Meeting held on December 23 were read and confirmed.

2. The following documents were laid on the table:—General Statements of Receipts and Disbursements on account of the Municipal Fund, also separate Statements of Receipts and Disbursements in respect of the General Revenue, Police Assessment, and Water-rate Accounts from close of 1891 to December 31 and from close of 1892 to January 31; Progress Reports of Works done brought up to the same dates; Statements of Work done by the Municipal Magistrate during the months of December and January; and of Cases instituted by the several Inspectors during the same period; also Report by the Health Officer for January.

Resolved,—That the General Statements of Receipts and Disbursements and Progress Report of Work done, together with the Minutes of Proceedings of this Meeting, be forwarded to Government, as required by section 90 of the Ordinance No. 7 of 1887, as well as the Health Officer's report.

3. List of burials in the Mahaiyawa General Cemetery during the half-year ended December 31 was laid on the table.

4. Under section 88 of the Ordinance No. 7 of 1887, the Council proceeded to appoint a Standing Committee.

On the motion of the Chairman, it was unanimously resolved that the Standing Committee consist as hitherto of four members in addition to the Chairman.

The Meeting then proceeded to ballot for Members of the Standing Committee. On the votes being scrutinised, the Chairman declared the following Members to have been elected:—Messrs. R. D. Ormsby, J. B. Siebel, J. H. Sproule, and E. Beven.

Mr. F. van Langenberg had an equal number of votes with Messrs. J. H. Sproule and E. Beven, but with leave of the Council his name was withdrawn.

5. Read circular letter dated February 4, from the Agent of the Mercantile Bank, intimating that the scheme for the reconstruction of the Chartered Mercantile Bank of India and China had now been completed, and that the name of the Bank will now be known as "The Mercantile Bank of India, Limited."

After a short discussion it was proposed by Mr. F. van Langenberg and seconded by Mr. J. H. Sproule, "that as the Bank prescribed by by-law chapter VIII., section 2, is no longer in existence, the Mercantile Bank of India, Limited, be selected under section 79 of the Ordinance No. 7 of 1887, as the Bank with which the moneys received by the Municipal Council in respect of the 'Municipal Fund' shall be lodged, and that the sanction of the Governor in Executive Council be applied for."

On the motion being put to the Meeting the Chairman declared it carried.

6. The Chairman mentioned to the Meeting, that as a means for disposing of the silt at the head of the lake it had been suggested that an island be formed with a broad channel between it and the main land. The island to be of irregular shape, and to be hereafter planted with trees and palms. The suggestion met with the approval of the Members, and the Secretary was instructed to have it carried out.

Health Officer's Report for January, 1893.

General Health.—During the last month the general health has been good. There has been no cases of serious infectious disease reported. The number and cause of deaths and the number of births I cannot give, as I am not supplied with this information. I should like to be furnished with these details, if practicable.

Infectious Diseases.—A few cases of chickenpox have been reported. They occurred at 51, Castle Hill street, and at 166, Pérádeniya road. In both instances the friends were warned to isolate the patients, and to have the rooms cleansed and whitewashed. Two of the cases from the former address were sent to hospital, as being suspicious of smallpox. They have proved not to be this disease.

Insanitary Closet at 51, Castle Hill Street.—At the former address a most insanitary latrine exists. A wooden floor (with a series of holes) and a space underneath is the closet. The holes appear to be seldom used for the purpose intended, and in consequence the floor is in a filthy condition. When the holes are used, excrement is deposited in a cess-pit, and I should think this is never emptied. I must ask that this cess-pit be emptied of filth and filled up with earth at once, and a proper system of earth pail closet be substituted.

Conservancy.—The conservancy arrangements appear to be well carried out. I am of opinion that during this dry weather the watering of the streets should be more frequent and embrace a larger area. The first watering should take place before the sweeping of the roads. As the work is now done, the women sweep in an aimless manner, disturbing volumes of dust, which is a well-known means of spreading any existing disease germs.

Standpipes.—The standpipes generally at the sides of streets are in good order. I regret to see so much carelessness on the part of the natives to turn off the water after use. The surrounding condition of a stand-pipe about the middle of Trincomalee street, on the left going from the Queen's Hotel, urgently requires repair.

Drains.—The condition of the street side drains is very defective. The catch-pits should be emptied more frequently—many of the covers of the latter are in bad repair. I notice that all the rain-water pipes from the roofs of the houses appear to lead straight into the drain. This a very bad system, and I would suggest that as new pipes are put up they be made to discharge over an open grating which must be trapped.

There is urgently needed an open brick drain from the outlet at the Military hospital in the Lake road to the catch-pit. As things now are the surface drains from the hospital stagnates at the side of the road, causing much unpleasantness to passers by.

I have noticed that towards the "tennis court" end of the Upper Lake road persons have dammed up the side drains, so that water may collect on one side for their use. In the event of a heavy shower the water would be divided from the side drain over the roadway, causing damage to the latter.

Market.—The market has been kept in an excellent sanitary condition.

Public Latrine.—The same applies to the public latrines.

Slaughter-house.—The slaughter-house and cattle shed are well kept. A few cattle have been rejected, but on the whole the cattle have been healthy and in fair condition.

ABSTRACT OF SEASON REPORTS FOR APRIL, 1893.

WESTERN PROVINCE.

Paddy.—A fair mottes crop is being harvested in some districts. Sowing for yala has been completed throughout the Province, but the over-abundance of the recent rains has interfered with later cultivation to some degree. The yala paddy plants are, at present, thriving.

CENTRAL PROVINCE.

KANDY DISTRICT.

Paddy and Dry Grain.—Udunuwara : yala paddy being sown ; dry grain sowing nearly over. Yatinuwara : late maha paddy being reaped, poor crop ; dry grain chenas being cleared. Tumpane : maha paddy harvest over, fair crop ; yala being ploughed ; dry grain chenas being cleared and sown. Harispattu : maha paddy threshed, good crop ; dry grain chenas being cleared. Uda Dumbara : maha paddy harvest in progress, fair crop ; dry grain chenas cleared. Pata Dumbara : maha paddy threshed, poor crop ; maha dry grain threshed, poor crop ; yala chenas being cleared. Pata Héwáheta : maha paddy reaped, good crop. Udalapata : yala paddy being sown, good prospects.

MÁTALÉ DISTRICT.

Paddy.—Maha reaping over ; crop only fairly satisfactory on the whole, but poor in Kohonsiyapattu, Wagapanaha Pallesiyapattu, and Kandapalla. Yala cultivation has begun. Rainfall middling.

NUWARA ELIYA DISTRICT.

Paddy and Dry Grain.—Kotmalé : maha paddy harvest nearly over, crop good ; chenas were cleared for kurakkan. Uda Héwáheta : paddy in young plants. Walapané : paddy in ear. No dry grain cultivation during this month in either of the latter divisions.

NORTHERN PROVINCE.

JAFFNA DISTRICT.

Paddy.—Threshing continued in Karachi and Punakari divisions. There were partial showers of rain in the Peninsula division accompanied by thunder and lightning almost every day between the 7th and 26th, heavy in some parts and light in others ; notwithstanding the rains the heat during the month, more especially the second fortnight, was exceedingly oppressive. Wind variable till the 26th, when it set in from the south-west. Weather still unsettled.

Dry Grain.—Payaru, ellu, and kurakkan extensively sown in March much benefited by the rain. Tobacco is being cut and cured ; crop reported indifferent.

MANNÁR DISTRICT.

Paddy and Dry Grain.—No paddy at this season. A small extent of dry grain in Muchaipattu is in plant. A little gingelly in flower in Mannár island.

MULLAITÍVU DISTRICT.

[Report not received.]

VAVUNIYA DISTRICT.

Paddy and Dry Grain.—No paddy cultivation except under Vavuniya and Mamadu, where the crop is fair. Prospects of gingelly crop fair. Great distress in Ubeddikulam and Panankmam ; generally tanks empty and distress increasing. Prices rising. Relief works urgently required. Some rain after the 22nd.

SOUTHERN PROVINCE.

GALLE DISTRICT.

Paddy.—The sowing for the yala season is now over throughout the district. The recent rains have done considerable damage to the growing crops in the low lands, especially in Wellaboda pattu and Bentota-Walallawiti koralé, but the crops in the higher lands are doing well, and on the whole a good harvest may be looked for if there is favourable weather.

HAMBANTOTA DISTRICT.

Paddy.—Good crops reaped throughout the district for maha harvest. Ploughing and sowing for yala now going on.

MÁTARA DISTRICT.

Paddy and Fine Grain.—Fair crop expected throughout the district.

EASTERN PROVINCE.

BATTICALOA DISTRICT.

Paddy and Dry Grain.—Harvesting of early munmari is over, threshing has commenced ; later munmari crops in good condition, except small portion damaged by flood. Sowing of early pinmari is over, and of later pinmari in progress. Price of paddy gone down to Re. 1.12 ; Indian corn and fine grain to Re. 1 a bushel.

TRINCOMALEE DISTRICT.

Paddy.—Munmari paddy stacks threshed and removed, and cultivation over. Pinmari sowing almost completed. Condition of plants on lands sown is good.

NORTH-WESTERN PROVINCE.

KURUNĠGALA DISTRICT.

Paddy and Dry Grain.—Katugampola Hatpattu : ploughing for yala ; dry grain cultivation going on all over the hatpattu ; much suffering from scarcity of food, fever, and dysentery ; not much rain in April. Hiriyala Hatpattu : ploughing for yala ; young paddy crops in some palatas good ; young crops of dry grain good ; chenas being cleared. Dewamedu Hatpattu : grain prospects good. Wannu Hatpattu : tanks only half full, some less ; chenas already sown in urgent want of rain, otherwise crop will fail. Dambadeni Hatpattu : rain sufficient ; nearly two-thirds of the fields left uncultivated for want of seed paddy ; price of an amunam of seed paddy has risen to Rs. 12 ; large number of chenas cleared and sown. Weudawili Hatpattu : about 400 acres paddy and 500 acres of chena land cultivated during April.

CHILAW DISTRICT.

Paddy.—Cultivation for yala commenced in villages north of Sengal-oya in Northern Division. In Central and Southern Divisions paddy sown largely ; good rains and sufficient water. Young paddy in low tracts of Southern Division damaged to a great extent by floods.

Fine Grain.—Being sown in all divisions ; prospects good.

PUTTALAM DISTRICT.

Paddy and Dry Grain.—Preparations made for both paddy and fine grain yala cultivation generally throughout the district.

NORTH-CENTRAL PROVINCE.

Paddy.—Slight rains partially distributed ; only 4.71 inches registered at Anurādhapura during the month. Tanks, as a general rule, half or quarter full, some completely dry. Maha crops have been reaped.

Dry Grain.—There was no kurakkan cultivation during the month ; in a few villages gingelly and mederi have been sown.

Measles from many villages and want of food in some have been reported.

PROVINCE OF UVA.

Paddy.—Sowing advanced in all districts ; young plants strong and thriving. No scarcity of water. Result of crops harvested during April below an average.

Fine Grain.—In Udukinda, sowing of kollu in progress.

PROVINCE OF SABARAGAMUWA.

RATNAPURA DISTRICT.

Paddy.—Sowing completed in favourable weather, outlook good ; second maha fields in blossom, and good crop expected.

Dry Grain.—Chena cultivation commenced in all kórales except Meda kóralé.

KĠGALLA DISTRICT.

Paddy.—Ploughing and sowing for yala in progress throughout the district. Late maha fields in Galboda and Kinigoda kóralés harvested ; outturn not satisfactory.

Dry Grain.—Chena clearing and sowing in progress throughout the district ; prospects fair. General health improving ; still bad reports from Kinigoda kórale.
