ABSTRACTS OF SEASON REPORTS.

SEASON REPORTS FOR THE MONTH OF OCTOBER, 1910.

WESTERN PROVINCE.

COLOMBO DISTRICT.

Paddy: yala crops have been harvested. Maha paddy plants are generally thriving.

Dry grain: no cultivation worth reporting.

Other products: the supply of fruits and vegetables was good. The flowering and prospects of coconuts were not encouraging in consequence of the continued drought. The crop for the month is reported at 6,983,470 approximately.

Prices of staple products: rice, Rs. 4 to Rs. 6.50 a bushel; coconuts, Rs. 48 to Rs. 70 per thousand.

Rainfall: the rainfall was abundant. In consequence there were floods in some villages

Remarks on harvest prospects generally: the yala harvest was good, and a fairly good maha crop may be expected, provided the paddy plants are not damaged by the recent rains.

Observations on the health of the inhabitants: there were in some villages a few cases of malarial fever, entering

fever, dysentery, and chickenpox, otherwise the health of the inhabitants was generally good.

Health of cattle: there were a few cases of rinderpest at Malwana, Walgama, and Pahala Mapitigama in Siyane korale, and at Pallidora and Karagampitiya in Colombo Mudaliyar's division. Precautionary measures were promptly taken to prevent their spreading. They are on the decline now.

KALUTARA DISTRICT.

Paddy: the maha cultivation is still continuing. The plants of the earlier sowings are growing well.

Dry grain: ml.

Conditions of Sale.

- 1. All timber sold must be removed from the depôt within ten days from date of sale.
- 2. All lots will be at the risk of the purchasers from the time of purchase.
- 3. Timber will be put up in lots to suit buyers at a rate per cubic foot, and bids of not less than 10 cents per cubic foot at a time will be accepted.
- 4. If the balance of purchase money is not paid within ten days from date of sale, the timber will be re-sold at the risk of the original purchasers after auction.
- 5. Depôt measurements must be accepted, but previous to date of auction any prospective purchaser is at liberty to check measurements recorded in notice and to represent any differences promptly.
 - 6. No timber shall be removed before payment of full value-
- 7. Any person to whom a lot is knocked down should he refuse to take over his lot to the full amount bid for the lot will again be put up to auction, and he will be liable for any difference in the price realized.
- 8. Purchasers if called upon shall sign the sale book kept for the purpose, and pay 25 per cent of the value of the timber purchased on day of sale.
- 9. Flowered logs, if not so advertised, shall be excluded from lots in the lists advertised, and shall be put up separately, consulting the wishes of purchasers.
