## WESTERN PROVINCE.

COLOMBO DISTRICT.

[Report not received.]

KALUTARA DISTRICT.

Paddy: the maha cultivation is now in ear. The preliminary preparations for the yala are in progress.

Dry grain: nothing worth reporting.

Other products: the supply of fruits and vegetables was scanty, but there was a fair supply of jak. (a) The flowering of coconuts is still unsatisfactory; (b) the month's crop is estimated at 1,695,000 nuts.

Prices of staple products: rice, Rs. 4 to Rs. 7 per bushel; coconuts, Rs. 60 to Rs. 80 per thousand nuts.

Remarks on harvest prospects generally: fair.
Rainfall at Kalutara: total, 8:16 in.; mean, .26 in.

Health of people: good, except for a few cases of chickenpox and dysentery.
