## ABSTRACTS OF SEASON REPORTS.

#### SEASON REPORTS FOR THE MONTH OF FEBRUARY, 1911.

#### WESTERN PROVINCE.

COLOMBO DISTRICT.

Paddy: the maha harvest is being reaped and threshed. Fields are being prepared for the vala.

Dry grain: nil.

Other products: vegetables and fruits were scarce. The flowering and prospects of coconuts were not satisfactory. The crop for the month is reported at 6,012,502 approximately.

Prices of staple products: rice, Rs. 4 to Rs. 6 per bushel; coconuts, Rs. 48 to Rs. 75 per thousand.

Rainfall: there was no rain during the month.

Remarks on harvest prospects generally: the maha harvest gathered is considered to be good.

Observations on the health of the inhabitants: there were in some villages cases of enteric, chickenpox, and dysentery, otherwise the health of the inhabitants was generally good.

Health of cattle: there were a few eases of rinderpest and hoof-and-mouth disease.

#### KALUTARA DISTRICT.

Paddy: the reaping of the maha paddy commenced during the month. Preparations for the yala cultivation are continuing.

Dry grain: nil.

Other products: (a) The supply of vegetables and fruits has been scarce. There was however a fair supply of jak and breadfruit. (b) The flowering of coconuts during the month was not good. The continued drought may affect the young nuts. The crop of coconuts for the month is estimated at 1,605;000 nuts.

Prices of staple products: rice, Rs. 4.25 to Rs. 7 per bushel; coconuts, Rs. 50 to Rs. 80 per thousand nuts. Remarks on harvest prospects generally: fair. Rainfall at Kalutara: total, 6.54 in.; mean, 23 in. Health of people: satisfactory.
