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DRAFT ORDINANCES.

MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information:—

An Ordinance further to amend "The Kandy Waterworks Loan Ordinance, 1884."

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend in certain particulars "The Kandy Waterworks Loan Ordinance, 1884" (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Ordinance"): Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Short title and construction.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Kandy Waterworks Loan (Amendment) Ordinance, 1911" and shall be read and construed as one with the principal Ordinance and the Ordinances amending the same.

Substitution of a new schedule.

2 For the schedule mentioned in the section which by section 5 of "The Kandy Waterworks Loan (Amendment) Ordinance, 1895," was substituted for section 6 of the principal Ordinance, the schedule given hereunder shall be substituted. Provided that it shall be lawful for the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, from time to time to alter or re-define the limits of the Municipality of Kandy as set forth and defined in the said schedule:

SCHEDULE.

North-east.—A straight line from the first milepost on the Katugastota road to the Municipal limits at the end of Malabar street near the first milestone.

East and South.—The limits of the Municipality as fixed by the Proclamation of March 27, 1877, up to the culvert on the railway line over the storm water channel that crosses the Peradeniya road 55 feet short of the 69½ milestone.

West.—From the said culvert on the railway line along the said storm water channel to a point 100 yards to the north of the Peradeniya road, and from thence parallel to the Peradeniya road and 100 yards from it to a point opposite the Peradeniya road at its junction with the path to Falmouth Lodge (now known as "Wilhelm's Ruhe"), and thence in a straight line to the gap near the boundary of the Primrose Hill estate on the Halloluwa road.

North-west.—A straight line from the gap on the Halloluwa road to the western redoubt, and thence to the first milestone on the Katugastota road.

Statement of Objects and Reasons.

THE object of this Ordinance is to enlarge the Municipal limits of Kandy as defined for the purposes of water-rate by "The Kandy Waterworks Loan Amendment Ordinance, 1895."

The effect of the Ordinance is to bring within the Municipal water limits a strip of land extending along either side of the Peradeniya road for a distance of about 800 yards.

To relieve the Municipality from the necessity of subsequent applications to the Legislature of a similar nature, power is given to the Governor in Executive Council to authorize any variation of limits that may be found necessary in future.
