## MUNICIPAL COUNCIL NOTICES.

### MUNICIPALITY OF COLOMBO.

Minutes of Proceedings of a General Meeting of the Municipal Council of Colombo held at the Municipal Office on Friday, January 9, 1903.

The Council met this day at 3 P.M., pursuant to notice dated January 3, 1903.

*Present*:—Mr. A. S. Pagden, Chairman ; Dr. C. T. Griffin ; Mr. P. D. Khan ; Mr. F. H. Grinlinton ; Major A. W. de Wilton ; Mr. Walter Shakspeare ; Mr. Robert Davidson ; Dr. C. W. vanGeysel ; Mr. Chas. Perera ; Mr. P. Coomaraswamy ; Mr. C. P. Dias ; Mr. H. A. Jayawardene ; Dr. Solomon Fernando ; Mr. M. L. M. Zainudeen ; the Hon. Mr. Stanley Bois ; and Dr. W. H. de Silva.

The Minutes of December 12, 1902, having been printed, and a copy thereof having been sent to each Member of the Council, were taken as read.

Resolved—That the Minutes of December 12, 1902, be confirmed.

1. Pursuant to notice, the Hon. Mr. Stanley Bois moved—That a Special Committee consisting of the Members of the Standing Committee on Law and General Subjects and the Standing Committee on Finance and Assessment be appointed to consider the desirability of amending the Municipal Ordinance in regard to the qualification of Voters and Councillors and their method of election, and to report to this Council generally with a view to reform in this connection.

Mr. Robert Davidson seconded.—Carried.

2. The following extracts from Minutes of Standing Committee of December 16, 1902, were laid before the Council, having been previously printed and circulated :—

*December 16, 1902.*

- (5) Application dated November 1, 1902, from Annie Malvina Vandendriesen, widow of the late cemetery-keeper, Madampitiya, for a gratuity.  
The Committee recommend a grant of Rs. 450 in accordance with the rules, on the understanding that all accounts due from the late cemetery-keeper are first settled.
- (14) Memorandum dated December 11, 1902, from Secretary, with reference to employment of extra clerks for Vehicles and Animals Department.  
Approved. Circulate papers again.
- (53) Superintendent of Works letter No. 51,418 of December 11, 1902, asking for Rs. 1,000 extra on General Upkeep of Roads Vote.  
The Committee recommend a transfer of Rs. 1,000 from estimate 197, Dean's Road to General Upkeep of Roads, and they authorize this to be done, the matter being urgent, in anticipation of the authority of the Municipal Council. Dean's road should be repaired early next year.

Dr. Griffin moved—That the recommendations contained in the foregoing extracts from Minutes of Standing Committee of December 16, 1902, be adopted.

Mr. P. Coomaraswamy seconded.—Carried.

3. The Council then proceeded to ballot for the election of Members to form four Standing Committees for 1903, in terms of section 5 of Ordinance No. 7 of 1902. The result of the ballot was declared by the Chairman to be as follows :—

- (1) Committee on Law and General Subjects :—Mr. C. Perera, Mr. C. Coomaraswamy, and Mr. James Peiris.  
(2) Committee on the Regulation of Markets and Sanitation :—Dr. C. W. vanGeysel, Dr. Solomon Fernando, and Dr. W. H. de Silva.  
(3) Committee on Finance and Assessment :—Mr. P. D. Khan, Mr. Walter Shakspeare, and the Hon. Mr. Stanley Bois.  
(4) Committee on Municipal Works :—The Hon. Mr. F. A. Cooper, Mr. F. H. Grinlinton, and Mr. H. A. Jayawardene.

Accordingly, the above-named Members were elected to form, with the Chairman, the four Standing Committees for 1903.

4. A letter No. 175/24,087 of December 19, 1902, from the Colonial Secretary, requesting to settle from Municipal Fund the advance of Rs. 20,000 made by the Treasurer to the Resident Engineer, Drainage Works, was laid before the Council.

The Chairman moved that the money be paid.

Mr. P. Coomaraswamy seconded.—Carried.

5. A letter No. 166 of December 2, 1902, from Colonial Secretary, regarding the drainage of Colombo, was laid before the Council, having been previously printed and circulated.

The Chairman moved—That this Council do thank Mr. Tickell for his attendance to-day, and for the information furnished by him on the subject.

Mr. F. H. Grinlinton seconded.—Carried.

The Chairman further moved—That this Council do accept the proposal of Government if Mr. Mansergh considers it necessary.

Mr. F. H. Grinlinton seconded.

Mr. C. Perera moved as an amendment—That the matter be referred to a Special Committee consisting of the Chairman, the Hon. Mr. F. A. Cooper, Mr. Walter Shakspeare, Dr. Solomon Fernando, the Hon. Mr. Stanley Bois, and the mover.

Mr. C. P. Dias seconded.

6. The Chairman moved—That the Special Committees appointed in 1902 be referred to the four Standing Committees appointed for 1903, as follows, viz. :—

Committees *re* shelter near Borella cemetery, Wellawatta lane, Works Department, and acquisition of Quarry House, Mutwal, to the Standing Committee on Municipal Works.

The Committees regarding building by-laws and transport of sewage by train to the Standing Committee on the Regulation of Markets and Sanitation.

The Committee regarding amendments to new by-laws to the Standing Committee on Law and General Subjects, and the Committee regarding exemption of untenanted buildings from assessment rate to the Standing Committee on Finance and Assessment.

Dr. C. T. Griffin seconded.—Carried.

7. A petition from certain owners of licensed vehicles was laid before the Council.

The Chairman moved—That the tax on vehicles drawn by horses and licensed for hire be not levied until the new scale of fares is sanctioned.

Mr. C. Perera seconded.—Carried.

8. Papers regarding pension to officers seconded for service under the Municipality were laid before the Council, having been previously printed and circulated.

The Chairman moved—That the matter be referred to the Standing Committee on Finance and Assessment.

Mr. R. Davidson seconded.—Carried.

9. Papers regarding laying of mains for electric cranes were laid before the Council, having been previously printed and circulated.

The Chairman moved—That the proposal of Government be accepted, and that this Council do grant Messrs. Boustead Brothers the concession to lay electric mains to the cranes at the Customs premises on Messrs. Boustead Brothers' giving the guarantee they have agreed to give in their letter of October 21, 1902.

Mr. P. Coomaraswamy seconded.—Carried.

10. Papers regarding Parson's road, Kew road, and Malay street were laid before the Council, having been previously printed and circulated.

Mr. P. Coomaraswamy moved—That the Chairman's action in the matter be confirmed, and that the proposal contained in his memorandum dated December 14, 1902, be adopted.

Mr. Walter Shakspeare seconded.—Carried.

12. A letter No. 177/023141 of December 22, 1902, from the Colonial Secretary, regarding Mr. Cockerill's services as Electrical Adviser, &c., to the Municipal Council, was laid before the Council.

The Chairman moved—That the Council do authorize the Chairman to incur the necessary expenditure to provide an assistant to Mr. Cockerill so long as he continues to hold the acting appointment.

Mr. C. Perera seconded.—Carried.

13. Letter No. 1,438 of December 10, 1902, from the Superintendent of Works, requesting authority to incur expenditure not exceeding Rs. 45 for cart way-bill forms, was laid before the Council.

The Chairman moved that the Chairman's action in the matter be confirmed.

14. An application from Arnolis Soysa for a license to sell meat at No. 30, Green street, was laid before the Council.

The Chairman moved that the application be allowed.
