MUNICIPALITY OF GALLE.

Minutes of Proceedings of a Meeting of the Municipal Council of Galle held at the Municipal Office on February 14, 1903, at 2 p.m.

Present:—The Chairman; C. P. Hayley, Esq.; Dr. E. Ludovici; N. Dias Abeysinfia, Esq.; D. G. Goonawardana, Esq.; F. Abeysundara, Esq.; and F. Perera, Esq.

- 1. Read and confirmed Minutes of Meeting held on January 10, 1903.
- 2. Pursuant to notice Mr. C. P. Hayley moved—That a portion of the verandahs in certain properties in Lighthouse street be acquired by the Municipality for the purpose of widening the street.

Seconded by Dr. Ludovici.

The proposer of the motion explained that the properties he referred to were Nos. 51, 52, 53 in Lighthouse street.

Resolved—That the mover and seconder of the motion be requested to arrange with the owners of these houses as to the terms on which they agree to let the Council have such portions of their verandahs as are necessary for widening the street, and that this motion lie over until this is ascertained.

3. Submitted a statement from the Manager, Health Department, of the number of additional buckets required for latrine work.

Resolved—That twenty-five dozen buckets be ordered, and that provision be made in a Supplemental Budget for the charge.

4. Submitted a letter from the Manager, Health Department, on arrangements required to be made for supplying day latrine coolies to householders requiring them.

Resolved-That the Secretary frame a scale of charges for day coolies being supplied to householders.

- 7. Submitted petition dated December 12, 1902, from the fish market renters asking for compensation for loss sustained by them by renewal of the roof of the market, and report of the Superintendent of Works.
