ABSTRACTS OF SEASON REPORTS.

SEASON REPORTS FOR THE MONTH OF MARCH, 1911.

WESTERN PROVINCE.

COLOMBO DISTRICT.

Paddy : preparations are being made for the yala cultivation.

Dry grain : no cultivation worth reporting.

Other products : fruits and vegetables were scarce and dear. The flowering and the general prospects of coconuts were not satisfactory. The crop for the month is reported at 5,372,950 coconuts approximately.

Prices of staple products : rice, Rs. 3·50 to Rs. 5 a bushel ; coconuts, Rs. 40 to Rs. 75 a thousand.

Rainfall : there was no rain during the month.

Remarks on harvest prospects generally : owing to the dry weather the harvest prospects are unsatisfactory.

Observations on the health of the inhabitants : there were in some villages cases of fever, chickenpox, and dysentery.

Health of cattle : there were several cases of rinderpest and hoof-and-mouth disease in the district.

KALUTARA DISTRICT.

Paddy : the reaping of the maha harvest was brought to a close during the month, and the yala cultivation commenced.

Dry grain : nil.

Other products : (a) there was a fair supply of vegetables and of jak and breadfruit, but dessert fruits were scarce ; (b) the flowering of coconuts was poor owing to the continued drought ; (c) the crop of coconuts for the month is estimated at 1,835,000.

Prices of staple products : rice, Rs. 4·25 to Rs. 7 per bushel ; coconuts, Rs. 55 to Rs. 80 per thousand nuts.

Remarks on harvest prospects generally : there is no harvest in the near future.

Rainfall at Kalutara : total, 6·77 in. ; mean, ·22 in.

Health of people : good, except for a few cases of chickenpox, dysentery, and contagious fever.

Health of cattle : a few isolated cases of rinderpest still exist in some parts of the district. Every endeavour is being made to stamp it out. There have been a few cases of hoof-and-mouth disease also, but it is disappearing.

CENTRAL PROVINCE.

KANDY DISTRICT.

Paddy, maha : harvesting in progress ; prospect of crop good. Yala : fields are being ploughed.

Dry grain, maha : chenas are being cleared.

Rainfall : insufficient.

Prospect of coconut crop : flowering fair. Estimated produce for the month of March, 1911 : Udu Nuwara, 60,720 ; Yatinuwara, 10,000 ; Tunpane, 16,000 ; Harispattu, 25,799 ; Uda Dumbara, 1,100. In other divisions crop not ascertainable.

Prices of staple articles : paddy, Rs. 2 per bushel ; kurakkan, Re. 1·50 per bushel ; rice, Rs. 4 per bushel ; salt, Rs. 3 per bushel ; coconut, Rs. 6 per 100.

Health of people : good.

Health of cattle : good. There was a case of rinderpest at Marlborough estate in Dikoya.

MATALE DISTRICT.

Rainfall : ·66 in.

Paddy : maha fields are being reaped.

Dry grain : kurakkan crops gathered.

Coconut : (a) flowering not satisfactory ; (b) 114,900 nuts approximate crop.

Tanks : some tanks in Matale North are dry.

Health of people : good.

Health of cattle : good.

Prices : high.

NUWARA ELIYA DISTRICT.

Paddy, maha cultivation fields : young plants.

Dry grains, chena cultivation : harvesting.

Health of population : good. There are a few cases of fever in Gangapalata korale and some cases of chickenpox in Gamuwa korale, Uda Hewaheta.

Health of cattle : at the beginning of the month rinderpest prevailed at Reepaha in Walapane, and at the latter part of the month hoof-and-mouth disease broke out in Gamuwa korale of Uda Hewaheta. Rinderpest is also prevailing on Abbotsford and Maha Eliya estates.
