## ABSTRACTS OF SEASON REPORTS.

### SEASON REPORTS FOR THE MONTH OF APRIL, 1911.

#### WESTERN PROVINCE.

##### COLOMBO DISTRICT.

Paddy: the yala plants are thriving fairly.  
Dry grain: no cultivation worth reporting.

Other products: the supply of vegetables was fair and the prices were reasonable, but fruit was scarce and dear. The flowering and the general prospects of coconuts were not satisfactory during the month. The crop for the month is reported at 7,240,779 approximately.

Prices of staple products: rice, Rs. 4 to Rs. 6 a bushel; coconuts, Rs. 35 to Rs. 70 a thousand.

Rainfall: there was no rain during the month.

Remarks on harvest prospects generally: a good yala harvest may be generally expected.

Observations on the health of the inhabitants: there were in some villages chickenpox, enteric fever, and dysentery, otherwise the health of the inhabitants was generally good.

Health of cattle: with the exception of a few cases of rinderpest in some villages, otherwise the health of cattle was generally good.

##### KALUTARA DISTRICT.

Paddy: the yala sowing was brought to a close during the month. Many fields have been left unsown for want of water resulting from the drought.

Dry grain: nil.

Other products: (a) the supply of vegetables and dessert fruits was limited, but there was a fair supply of jak and breadfruit. (b) The flowering of coconuts was not satisfactory owing to the drought: the crop for the month amounted to 1,682,000 nuts.

Prices of staple products: rice, Rs. 4.25 to Rs. 6 a bushel; coconuts, Rs. 50 to Rs. 80 per thousand.

Remarks on harvest prospects generally: there is no harvest in the near future. The present drought is unfavourable to the young paddy plants.

Rainfall at Kalutara: total, 4.14 in.; mean, .14 in.

Health of people: satisfactory.

Health of cattle: rinderpest still exists in the totamunes. Every endeavour is being made to stamp it out.

#### CENTRAL PROVINCE.

##### KANDY DISTRICT.

Paddy, maha: reaping is over; prospect of crop good. Yala: ploughing in progress.

Dry grain, maha: nil. Yala: chenas are being cleared for kurakkan cultivation.

Rainfall: insufficient.

Prospect of coconut crop: flowering fair. Estimated produce for the month of April, 1911: Udunuwara, 60,720; Yatinuwara, 12,000; Tumpane, 16,000; Harispattu, 25,790. In other divisions crop not ascertainable.

Prices of staple articles: paddy, Rs. 2 per bushel; kurakkan, Re. 1.50 per bushel; rice, Rs. 4 per bushel; salt, Rs. 3 per bushel; coconut, Rs. 6 per 100.

Health of people: good. There were a few cases of chickenpox and measles in Udunuwara and Yatinuwara.

Health of cattle: good.

## MATALE DISTRICT.

Rainfall: 0·65 in.

- Paddy: maha crops gathered, and a few fields for yala cultivation are being ploughed.
- Dry grain: some chenas cleared were not sown, and those that were sown withered in want of rain.
- Coconut: (a) flowering poor; (b) 111,500 nuts approximate crop.
- Tanks are dry.
- Health of people: fair. Cases of chickenpox, sore-eyes, and dysentery occurred everywhere.
- Health of cattle: good.
- Prices: high.

## NUWARA ELIYA DISTRICT.

- Paddy, maha cultivation fields: some are young plants, others are earing.
- Dry grains, chena cultivation: harvesting over.
- Health of population: good. There are a few cases of fever and chickenpox in Gangapalata and Gannewa korales of Uda Hewaheta respectively.
- Health of cattle: there were 11 cases of rinderpest in the town of Nuwara Eliya. Outbreaks were also reported from Abbotsford estate, Nanu-oya, and Lindula.
- Prices of staple articles: paddy, Re. 1·50 to Rs. 2·50 per bushel; kurakkan, Rs. 2 per bushel; Indian corn, Rs. 2 per bushel; rice (country), Rs. 4·50 to Rs. 5 per bushel; rice (Coast), Rs. 5·50 to Rs. 7·50 per bushel; coconuts, Rs. 9 to Rs. 15 per 100 nuts.
