# FINAL ORDERS.

#### Order under Section 2 of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903," declaring Land to be Crown Property.

In the matter of the land commonly called or known as Tekkawatta, situate in the village of Balukawela, in the Gangaboda pattu of the Matara District, in the Southern Province, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."

The notice required by section 1 of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903," having been duly published in manner prescribed by that section in respect of the above-named lands (*vide* Notice No. 3,905), and no claim having been made to the said lands or to any interest therein within the period of three months from the date specified in the said notice, I. 
