

Order under Section 4, Sub-section (1), of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903," declaring Land to be Crown Property.

In the matter of the land commonly called or known as Migahawatta (bund reservation), situate in the village of Ihala Talawa, in the Ihala Medagandahe tulana of the Nuwaragam korale of the Nuwaragam palata, in the North-Central Province, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."

WHEREAS in pursuance of section 1 of the said Ordinances it was duly notified on March 11, 1910, that if no claim to the land commonly called or known as Migahawatta (bund reservation), situate in the village of Ihala Talawa, in the Ihala Medagandahe tulana of the Nuwaragam korale of the Nuwaragam palata, in the North-Central Province, containing in extent 9.6 perches, and shown as lot 11d2 in preliminary plan 302, and in the annexed diagram, was made to Howard Orme Fox, Special Officer appointed under section 28 of the said Ordinances, within the period of three months from the date specified in such notice, such land would be declared the property of the Crown, and dealt with on account of the Crown (vide Notice No. 3,727):

And whereas (1) Naikaluge Arlis de Silva of Anuradhapura made claim thereto, and whereas the said claimant has withdrawn his claim to the said land, I, Howard Orme Fox, Special Officer appointed under section 28 of the said Ordinances, under and by virtue of the powers vested in me in that behalf by section 4 of the said Ordinances, do hereby on February 11, 1911, order and declare under section 4, sub-section (1), of the said Ordinances, that the said land, as more fully described herein below, is the property of the Crown.

Description of the Land referred to.

The land commonly called or known as Migahawatta (bund reservation), situate in the village of Ihala Talawa, in the Ihala Medagandahe tulana of the Nuwaragam korale of the Nuwaragam palata, in the North-Central Province, containing in extent 9.6 perches, shown as lot 11d2 in preliminary plan 302, and in the annexed diagram, and bounded as follows: on the north by Migahawatta claimed by Naikaluge Arlis Silva, Migahawatta (bund reservation) claimed by the Crown and N. K. Arlis Silva, Wewagawabima (tank bund reservation) declared to be Crown property under the Lands Ordinances; on the east by Wewagawabima (tank bund reservation) declared to be Crown property under the Waste Lands Ordinances; on the south by Talawa-ela; on the west by Migahawatta claimed by Naikaluge Arlis Silva. Migahawatta (bund reservation) claimed by the Crown and N. K. Arlis Silva.


