APPOINTMENTS, &c., BY THE GOVERNOR.

No. 183 of 1911.

THE Hon. Sir CHRISTOFFEL OBEVESEKERE having been granted leave of absence from the Island, HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR, by an Instrument dated May 15, 1911, under the Public Seal of this Island, by virtue of the powers in him vested by clause XVIII. of the Instructions of His late Majesty EDWARD VII., dated February 19, 1907, has been pleased to appoint the Hon. Mr. SOLOMON SENEVIRATNE to be provisionally, subject to His Majesty's confirmation or disallowance, an Unofficial Member of the Legislative Council of the Island, during the absence of the Hon. Sir CHRISTOFFEL OBEVESEKERE from Ceylon, or until the said Sir CHRISTOFFEL OBEVESE-KERE shall vacate his seat, or until the issue of new Letters Patent, or during His Majesty's pleasure.
