No. 14 of 1911.

An Ordinance to amend "The Destitute Immigrants Regulation Ordinance, 1907."

HUGH CLIFFORD.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend in certain particulars "The Destitute Immigrants Regulation Ordinance, 1907" (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Ordinance"): Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Short title and construction.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Destitute Immigrants Regulation (Amendment) Ordinance, 1911," and shall be read and construed as one with the principal Ordinance.

Amendment of the definition of "costs and charges" in section 2.

2 For the definition of the expression "costs and charges" in section 2 of the principal Ordinance the following definition shall be substituted, namely:

"Costs and charges" means—

- (1) Any money expended out of the public funds of the Colony for the relief, maintenance, care, or treatment of any destitute immigrant or stowaway.

- (2) The expenses of any such relief, maintenance, care, or treatment in any hospital, almshouse, or other institution for the relief of sick or destitute persons—
- (a) Which is maintained out of public funds; or
 - (b) Which is maintained by any charitable institution to the support of which the Government contributes.
- (3) In the case of a stowaway any money expended out of public funds—
- (a) For his maintenance, care, or treatment during imprisonment on conviction of any offence under this Ordinance or of any other offence.
 - (b) For his deportation from the Colony.

Substitution of new section 12.

3 The following section is hereby substituted for section 12 of the principal Ordinance, as amended by section 3 of "The Destitute Immigrants Regulation (Amendment) Ordinance, 1910":

12. In the following cases, that is to say—

- (a) Where any destitute immigrant lands in Ceylon from any vessel contrary to the provisions of this Ordinance;
- (b) Where any stowaway is landed from any vessel at any place in Ceylon—

the master of the vessel shall be liable to pay to the Government of Ceylon—

- (1) All costs and charges incurred by the Government in connection with such immigrant during a period of two months from his landing;
- (2) All costs and charges incurred by the Government in connection with such stowaway until he shall have been placed on board a vessel on which a passage has been provided for him to some place at which he can lawfully be landed.

Provided that in the case of a destitute immigrant the master shall incur no liability to repay the said costs and charges, if he proves that the destitute immigrant was at the time of landing under an engagement of service, or in possession of a sum of money of not less than one hundred and fifty rupees.

Provided further, that in the case of a stowaway, if no such arrangement for his deportation shall have been made by the master, owner, agent, or charterer of the vessel within two months of his landing, such arrangement may be made by the Government.

Amendment of section 13.

4 In section 13 of the principal Ordinance after the word "immigrant" there shall be inserted the words "or stowaway."

Amendment of section 14.

5 In section 14 of the principal Ordinance after the word "immigrant" there shall be inserted the words "or stowaway."

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend in certain particulars "The Kandy Waterworks Loan Ordinance, 1884" (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Ordinance"): Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Short title and construction.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Kandy Waterworks Loan (Amendment) Ordinance, 1911," and shall be read and construed as one with the principal Ordinance and the Ordinances amending the same.

Substitution of a new schedule.

2 For the schedule mentioned in the section which by section 5 of "The Kandy Waterworks Loan (Amendment) Ordinance, 1895," was substituted for section 6 of the principal Ordinance, the schedule given hereunder shall be substituted. Provided that it shall be lawful for the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, from time to time to alter or re-define the limits of the Municipality of Kandy as set forth and defined in the said schedule:

SCHEDULE.

North-east.—A straight line from the first milepost on the Katugastota road to the Municipal limits at the end of Malabar street near the first milestone.

East and South.—The limits of the Municipality as fixed by the Proclamation of March 27, 1877, up to the culvert on the railway line over the storm water channel that crosses the Peradeniya road 55 feet short of the 69½ milestone.

West.—From the said culvert on the railway line along the said storm water channel to a point 100 yards to the north of the Peradeniya road, and from thence parallel to the Peradeniya road and 100 yards from it to a point opposite the Peradeniya road at its junction with the path to Falmouth Lodge (now known as "Wilhelm's Ruhe"), and thence in a straight line to the gap near the boundary of the Primrose Hill estate on the Halloluwa road.

North-west.—A straight line from the gap on the Halloluwa road to the western redoubt, and thence to the first milestone on the Katugastota road.
