CENTRAL PROVINCE.

MATALE DISTRICT.

Rainfall : 17.43 in.

Paddy : yala fields are now in plant.

Dry grain : only chenas in Matale South are sown.

Coconut : (a) flowering poor ; (b) 117,000 nuts approximate crop.

Tanks : nearly all the tanks in Matale North are dry.

Health of people : fever, chickenpox, sore-eyes, and dysentery prevalent all over the district. There were two cases of smallpox in Matale North.

Health of cattle : good.

Prices : moderate.

NORTHERN PROVINCE.

MULLAITTIVU DISTRICT.

Paddy : paddy stacks of kalapokam cultivation is being threshed. Idaipokam cultivation not satisfactory.

Dry grain : nil.

Other products—Coconut : condition of trees good. The crop for the month is estimated to be 104,000 nuts.

Prices of staple articles of food : paddy, Rs. 2 per bushel ; rice, Rs. 4.50 per bushel ; kurakkan, Re. 1.50 per bushel ; ellu, Rs. 7.50 per bushel ; uluntu, Rs. 5 per bushel ; coconuts, Rs. 6 per 100.
