Order under Section 4, Sub-section (1), of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903," declaring Lands to be Crown Property.

In the matter of the lands commonly called or known as Unagahapihillapatanahena, Illukmandiahena, Komarikagalalangahena, Hinnapitahena, and Morangatennahena, situate in the village of Kalaganwatta, in the Medapalata korale of the Walapane division, in the Nuwara Eliya District, Central Province, and of "The Waste Lande Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."


