Matara S. O. No. 1,563.

Order under Section 4, Sub-section (1), of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903," declaring Land to be Crown Property.

In the matter of the land commonly called or known as Mahahena, situate in the village of Dematapitiya, in the Kandaboda pattu of the Matara District, in the Southern Province, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."

Whereas in pursuance of section 1 of the said Ordinances it was duly notified on November 27, 1908, that if no claim to the land commonly called or known as Mahahena, situate in the village of Dematapitiya, in the Kandaboda pattu of the Matara District, in the Southern Province, containing in extent 1 acre 2 roods and 24 perches, and shown as lot 7n in preliminary. 


